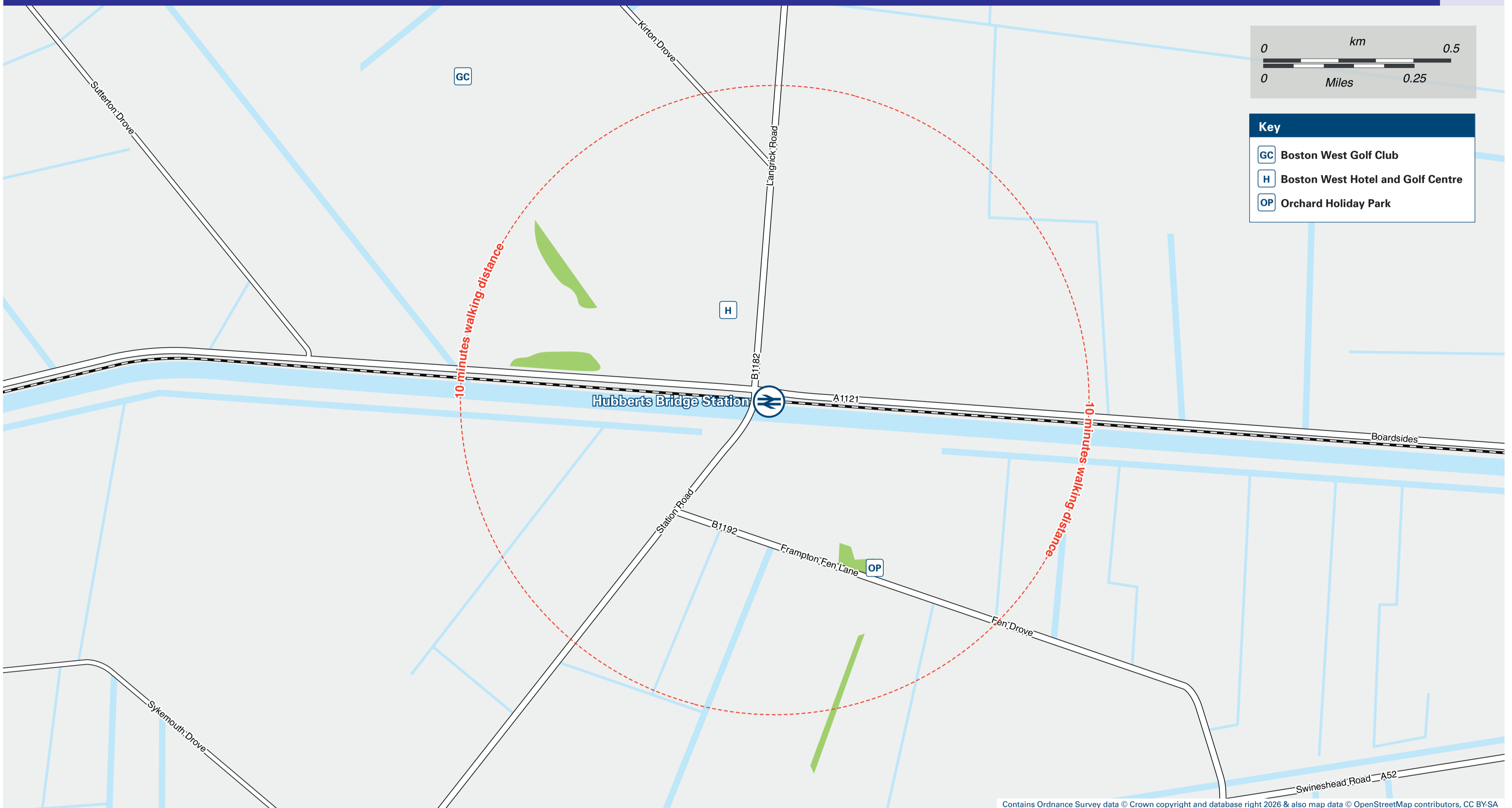

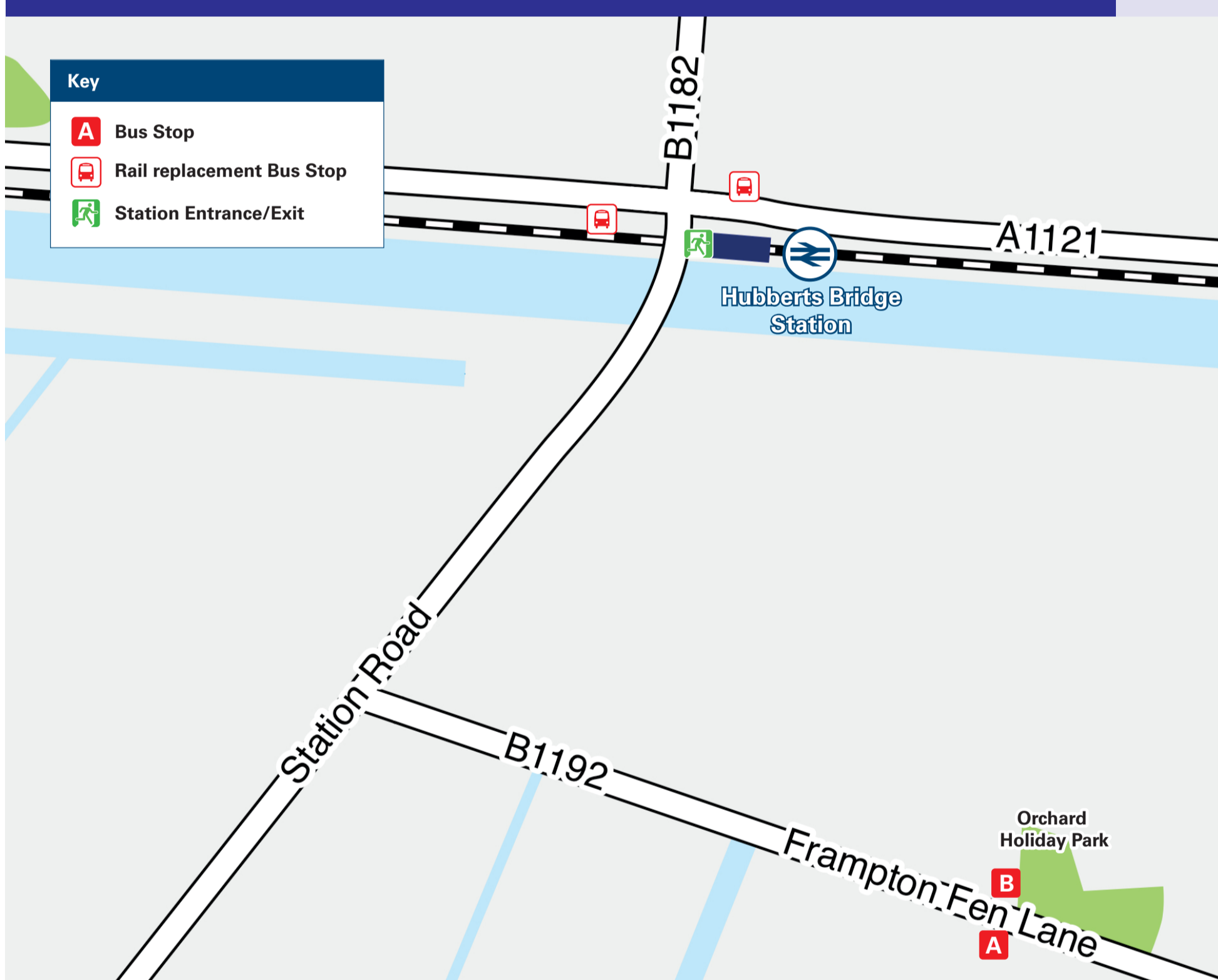
Hubberts Bridge Station
