



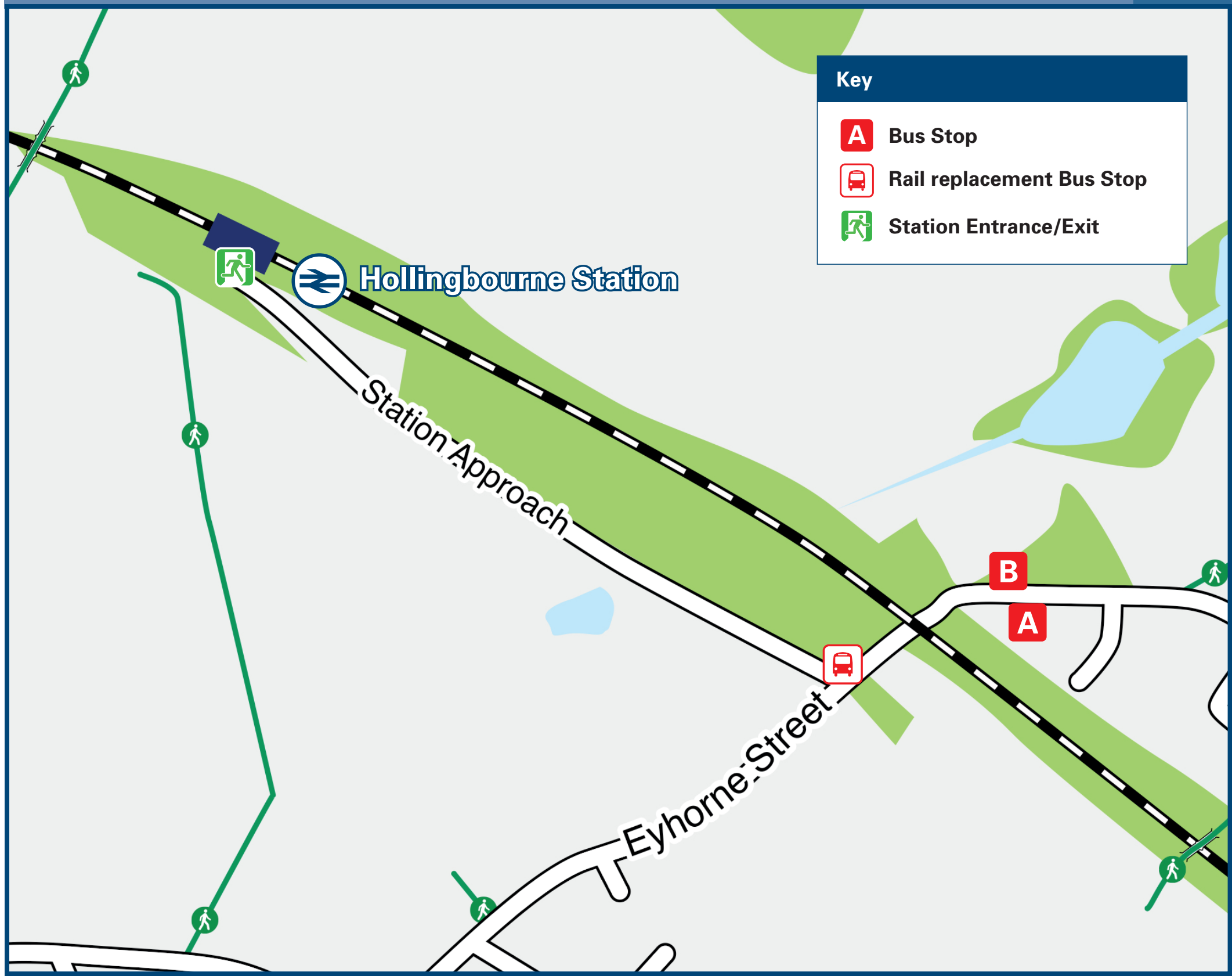
Hollingbourne Station
