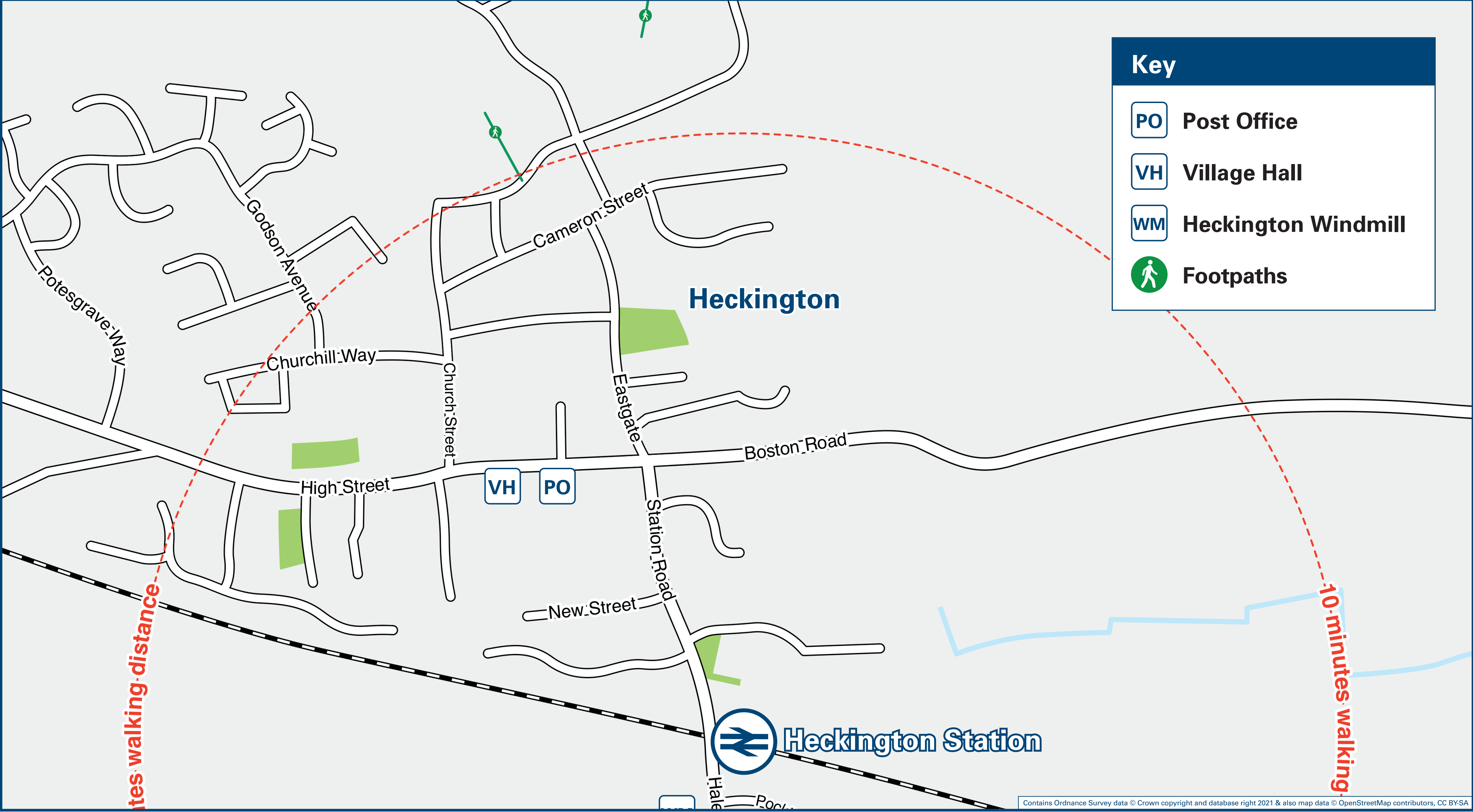




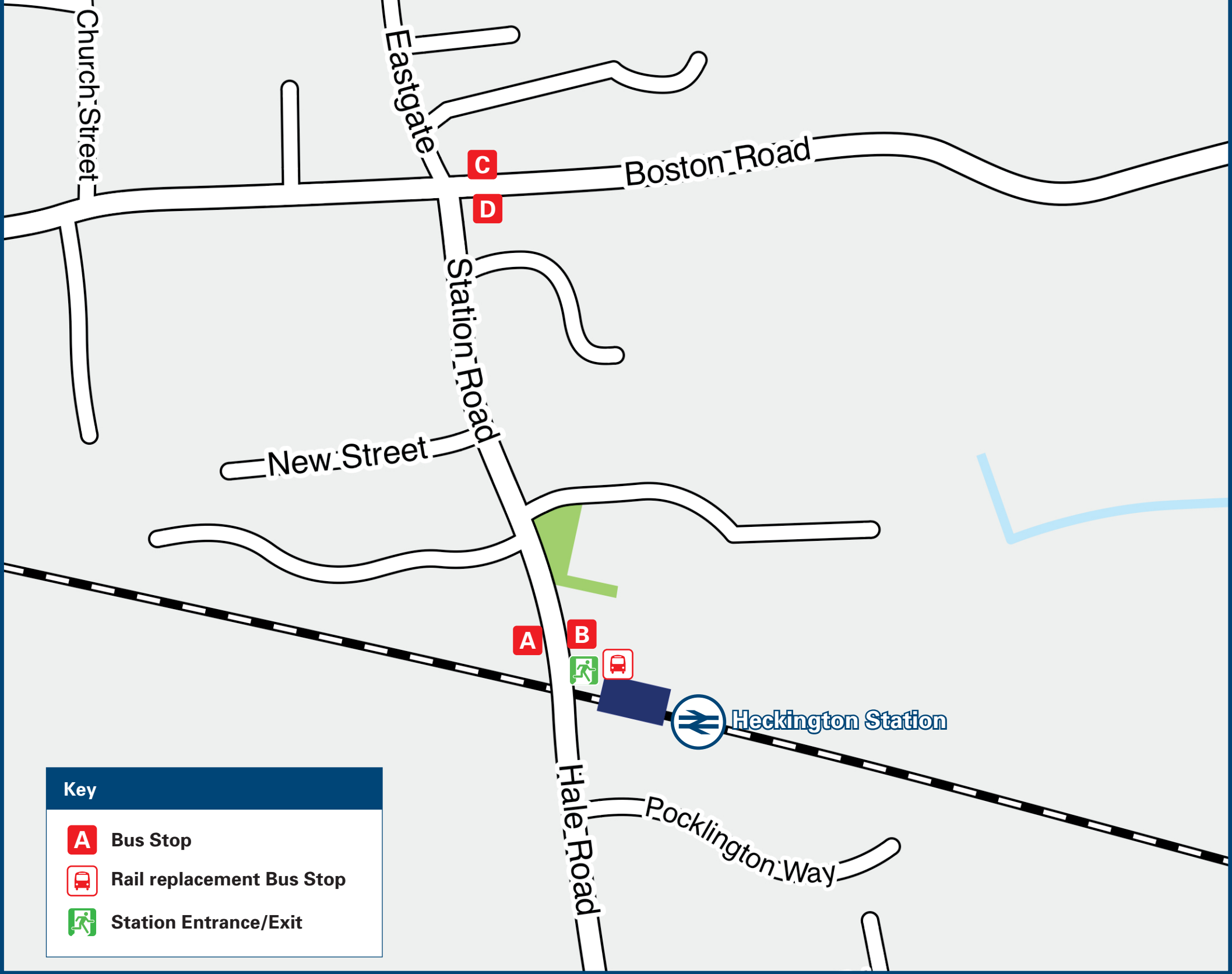
Heckington Station
