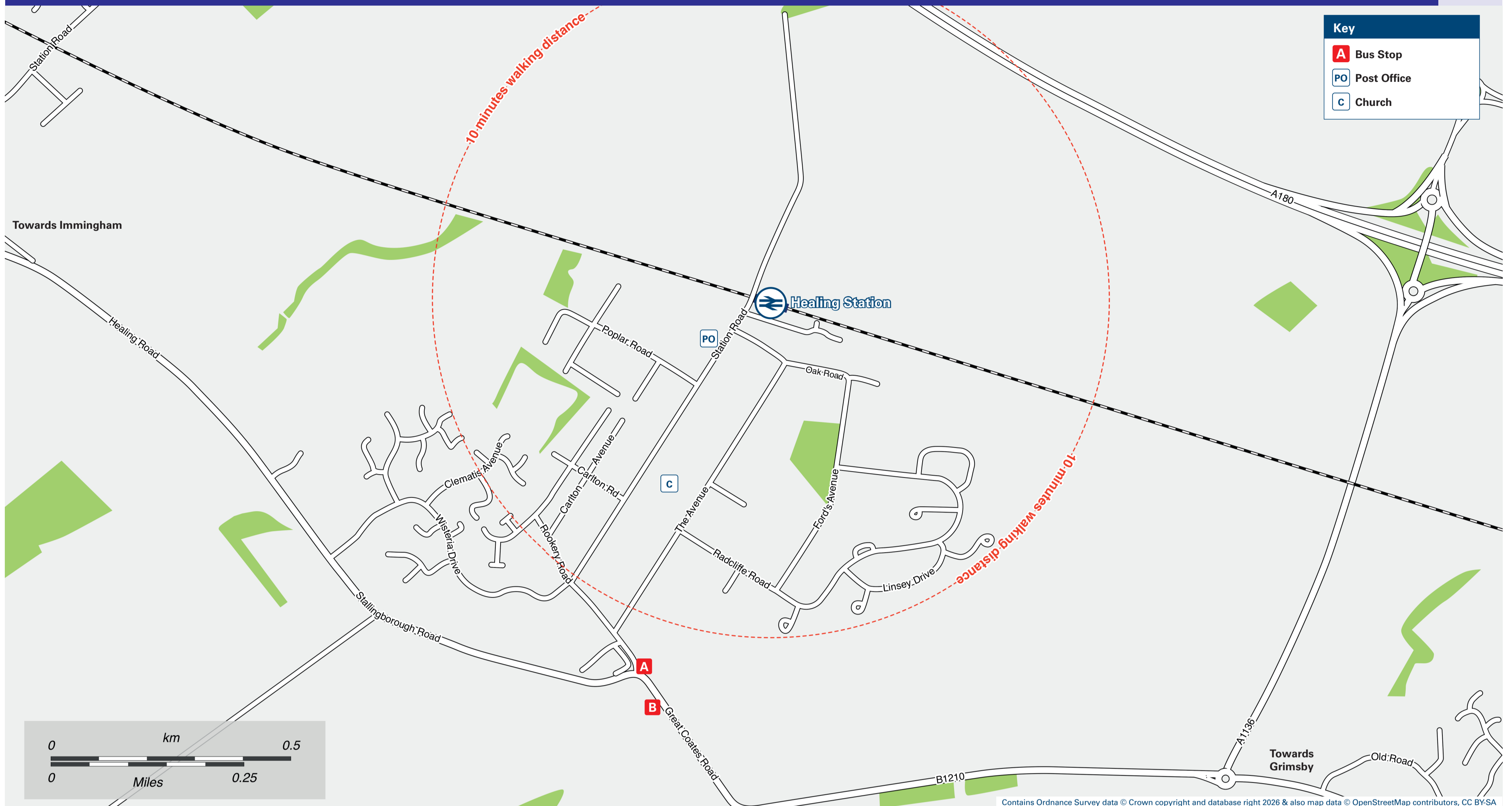




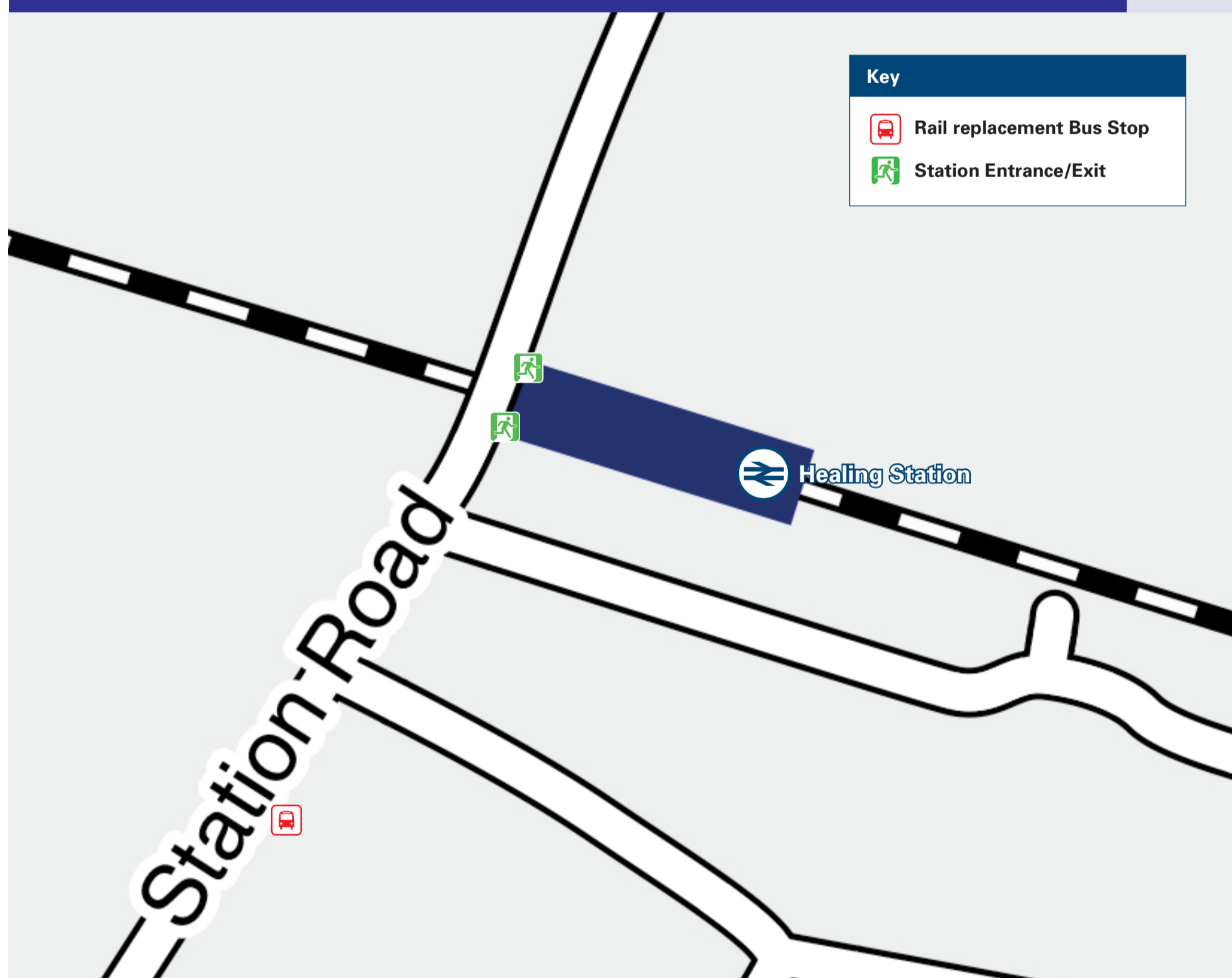

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING HEALING STATION

Regular bus services run from bus stops **A** and **B** on the Great Coates Road, 15-20 minutes walk from Healing Station, as shown on the Local area map.

From bus stop **A**: Service 5, 5M and 45 to Wybers Wood, The Willows, West Marsh and Grimsby. Service 5 runs through to Weelsby and Hewitt's Circus (from stop **A**) on Sundays, only. Service 45 runs through to Weelsby and Cleethorpes.

From bus stop **B**: Service 5, 5M and 45 to Stallingborough and Immingham.

Service 5 runs a daily service; bus 5M runs a limited peak hours service on Mondays to Fridays, only; and bus 45 runs a limited evening service on Mondays to Saturdays, and an all day service on Sundays.
