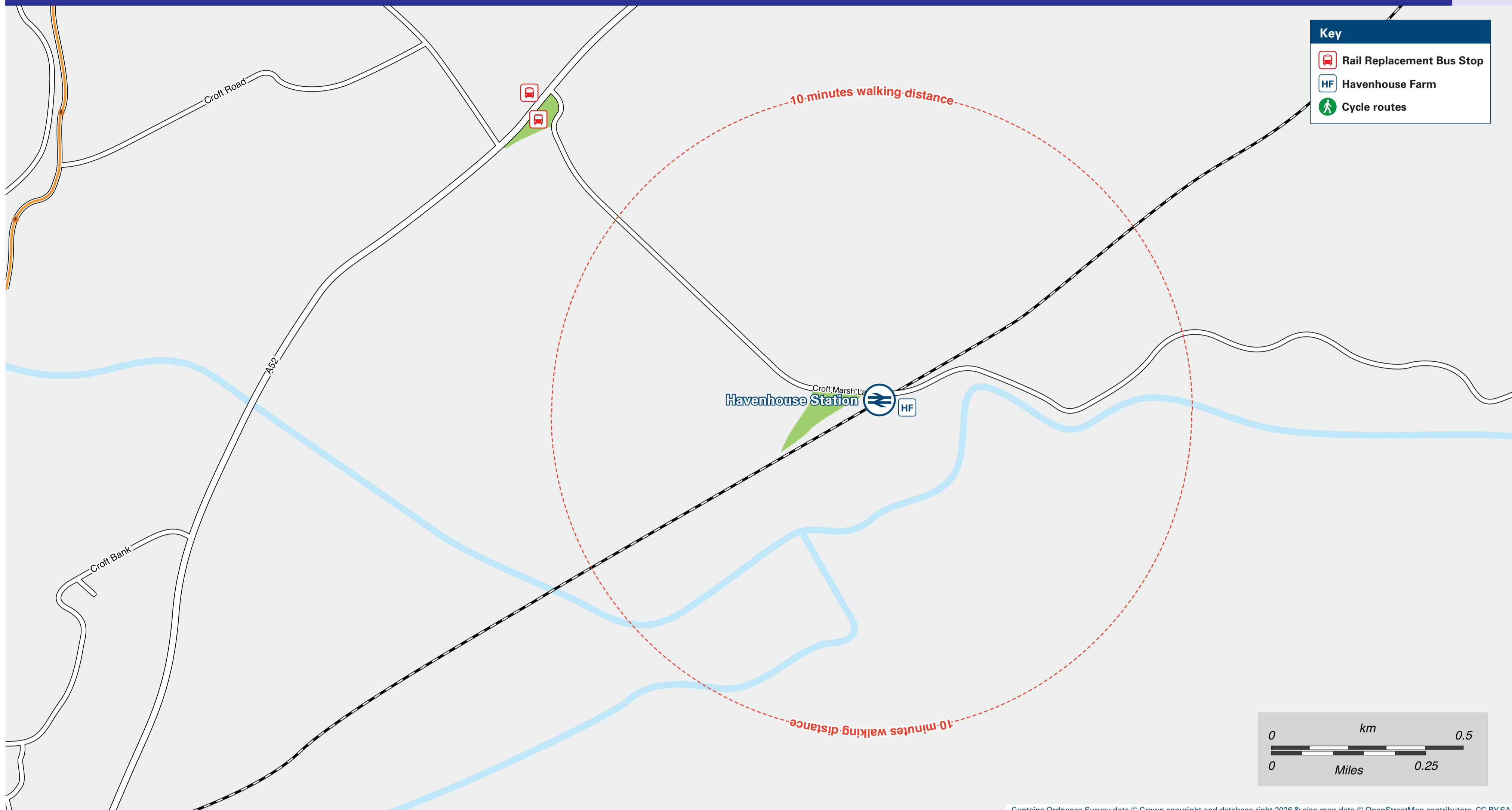




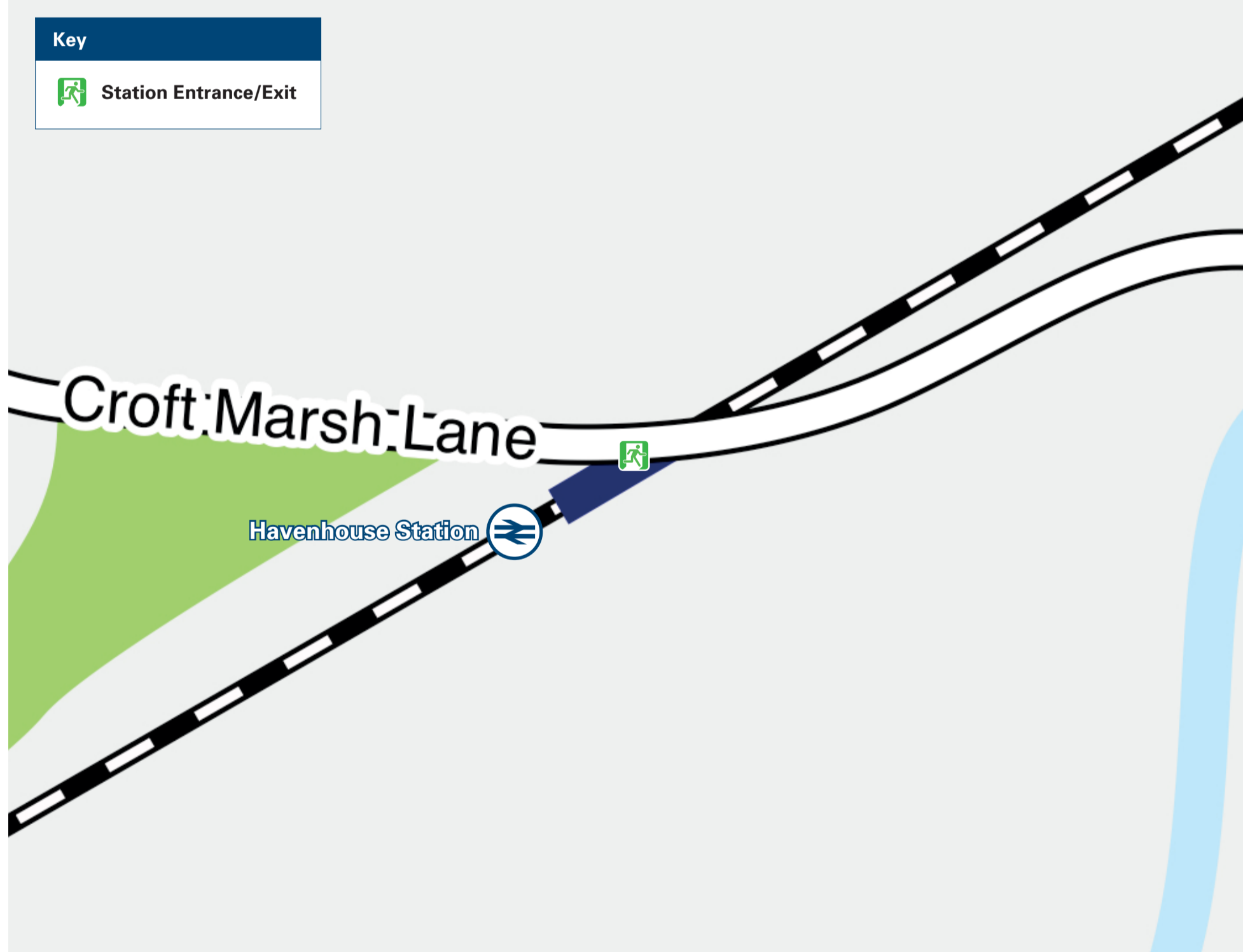

Local Bus Information:

Bus routes B7, B7X and 57 depart from bus stops on the main A52 road to Boston, Wrangle, Friskney, Wainfleet, Skegness. It's a 15-20 minutes walk from this station, see maps.

Bus route B7 operated by Brylaine Travel runs Mondays to Fridays only excluding Bank Holidays.

Bus route B7X operated by Brylaine Travel runs Mondays to Fridays only excluding Bank Holidays.

Bus route 57 operated by Stagecoach runs Mondays to Saturdays only excluding Bank Holidays.
