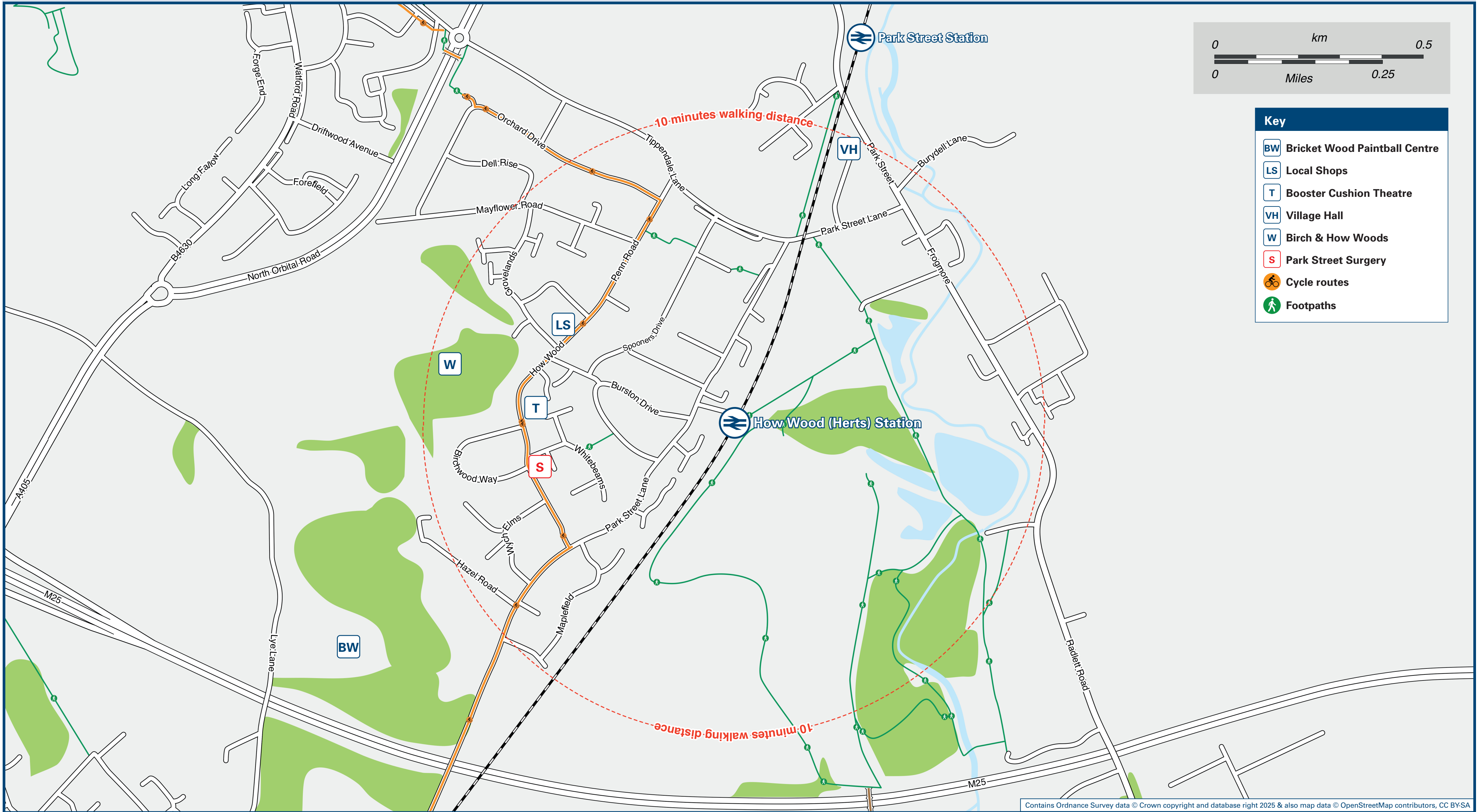




How Wood (Herts) Station
