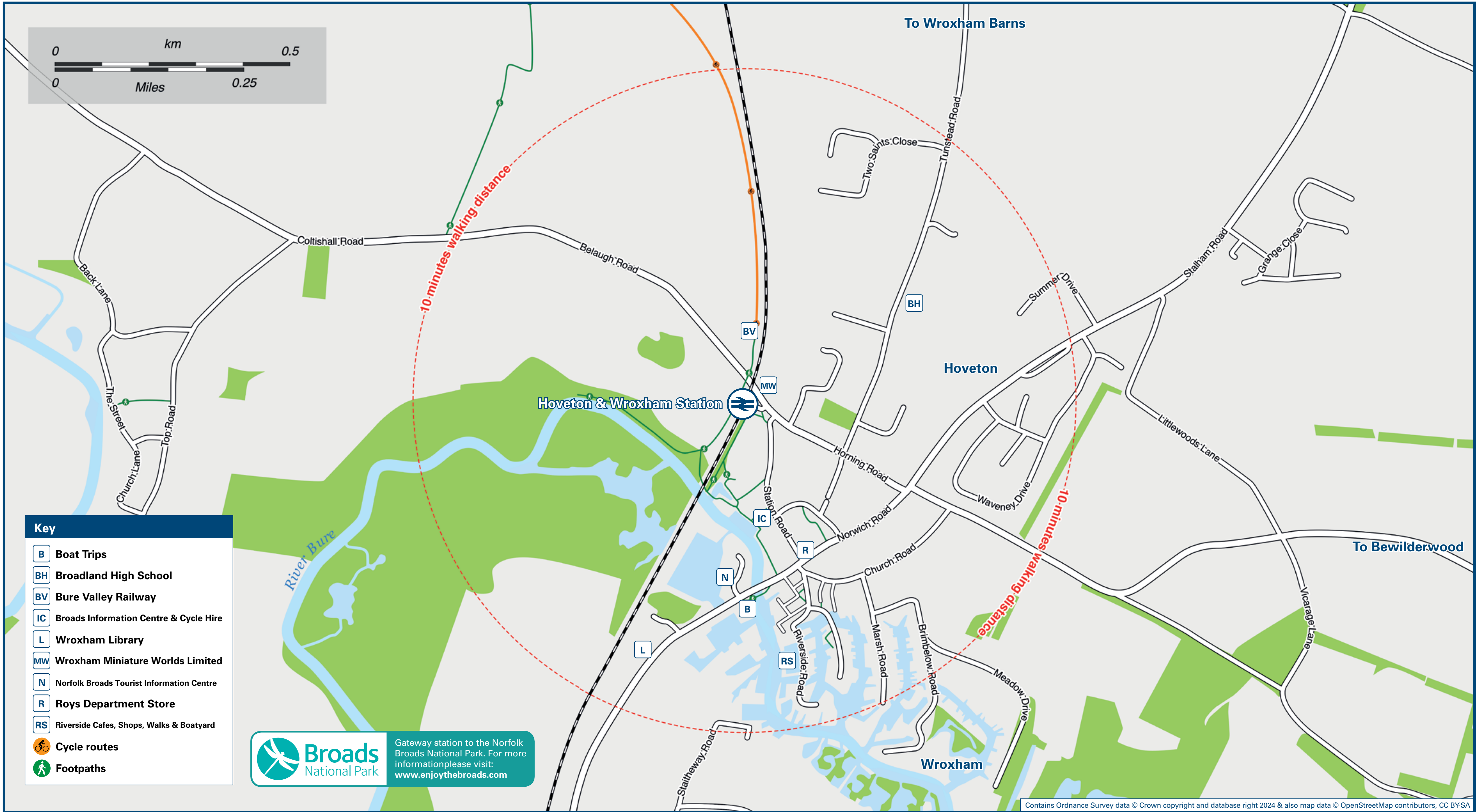




Hoveton & Wroxham Station
