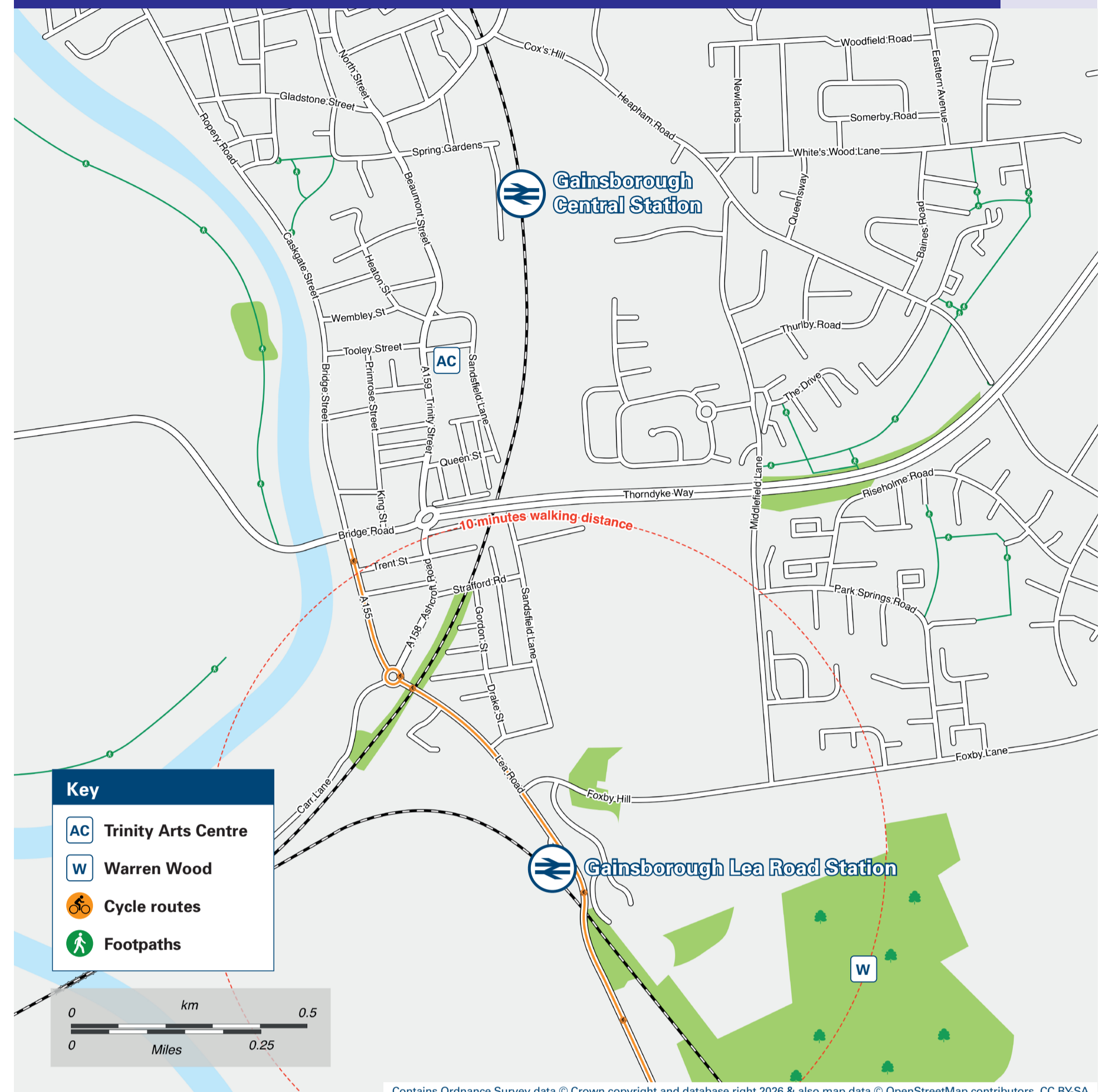
## Gainsborough Lea Road Station
