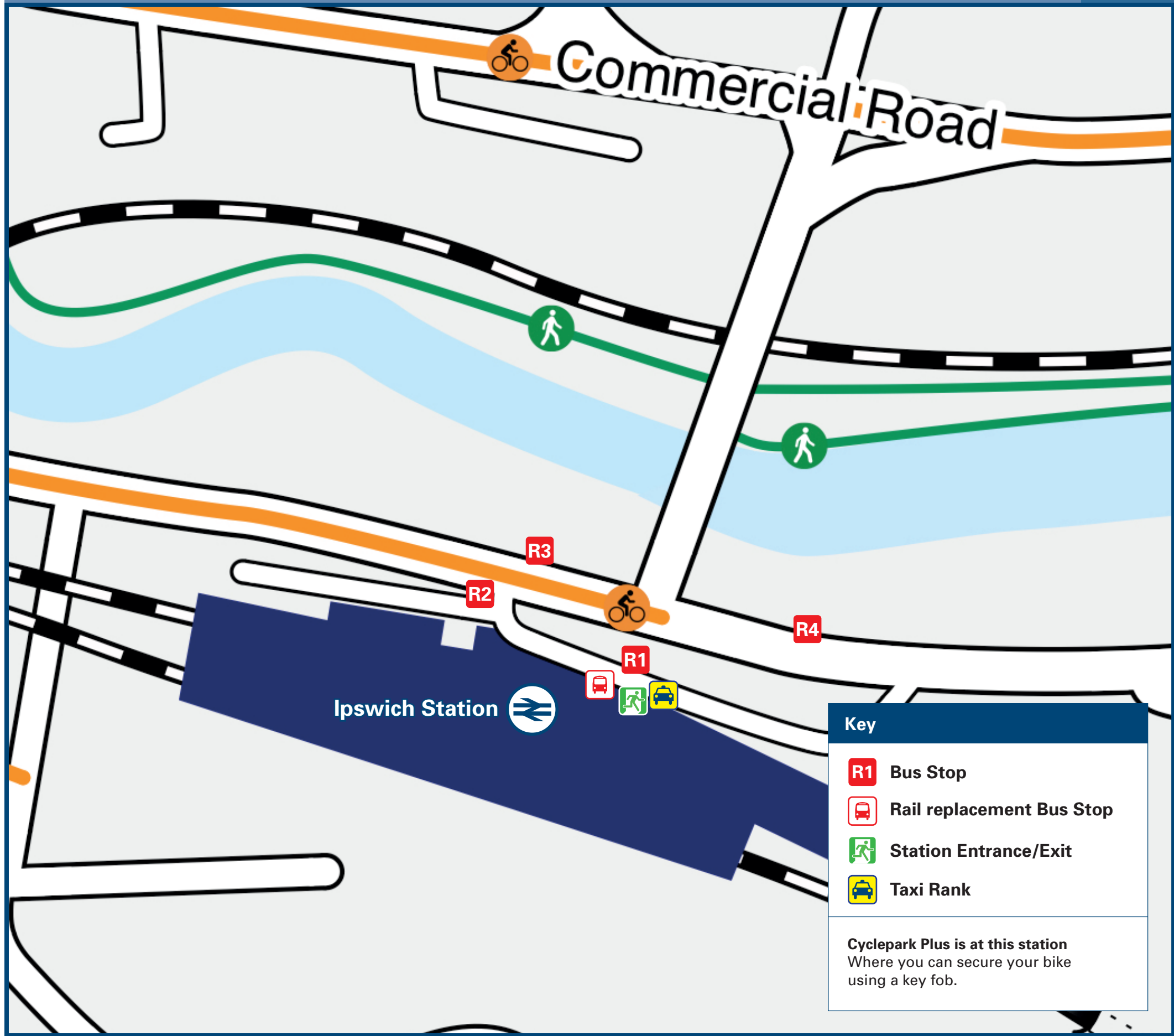

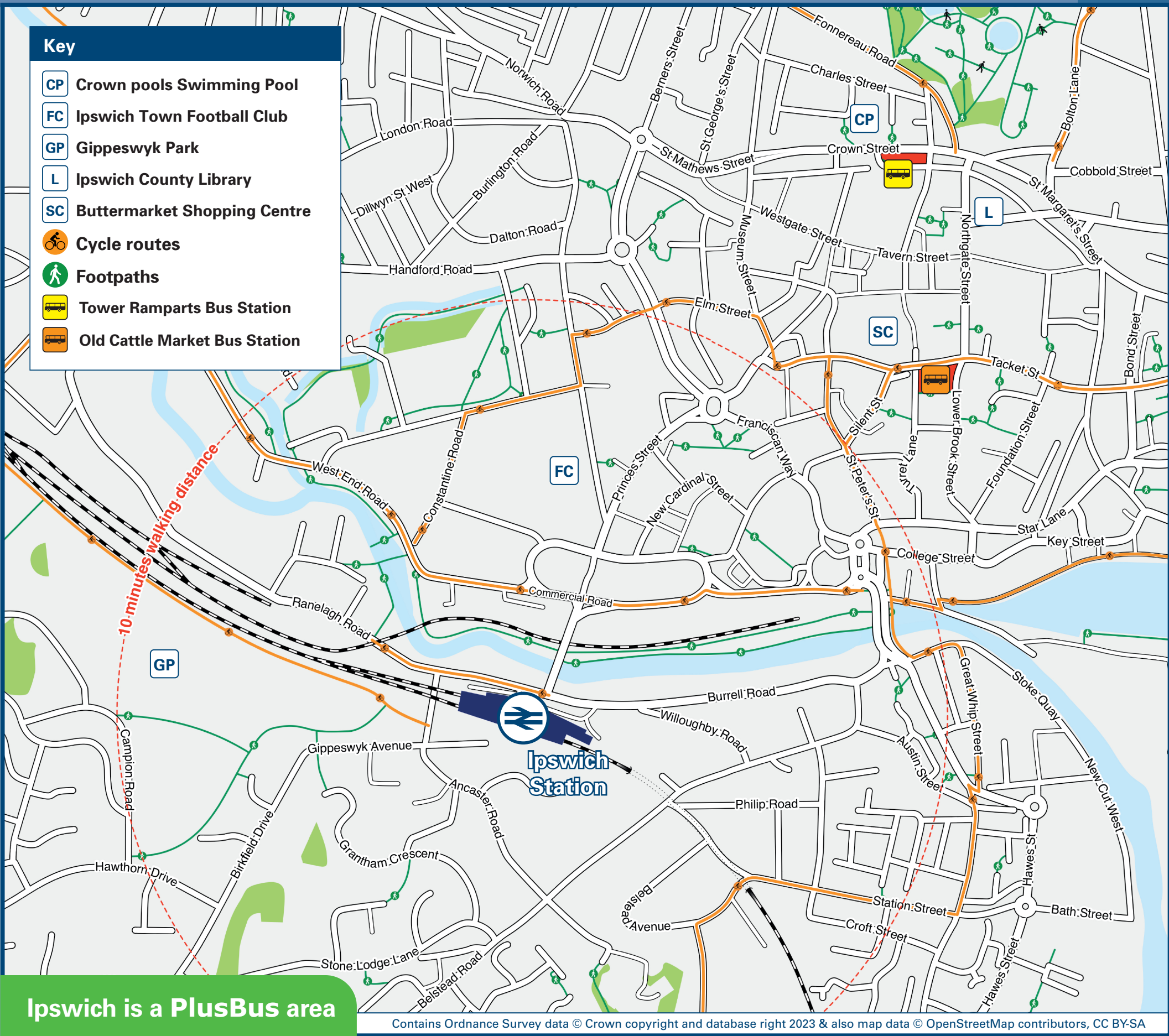

- Bus services to all parts of Ipswich and beyond operate from the Tower Ramparts Bus Station and the Old Cattle Market Bus Station
- \* Bus route 3 runs morning services on Mondays to Fridays from Ipswich Railway Station, only.
- # Bus route 14, 91, 92 and 93 run limited Mondays to Saturdays services, only. No Sunday services.
- Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.

### Taxis
