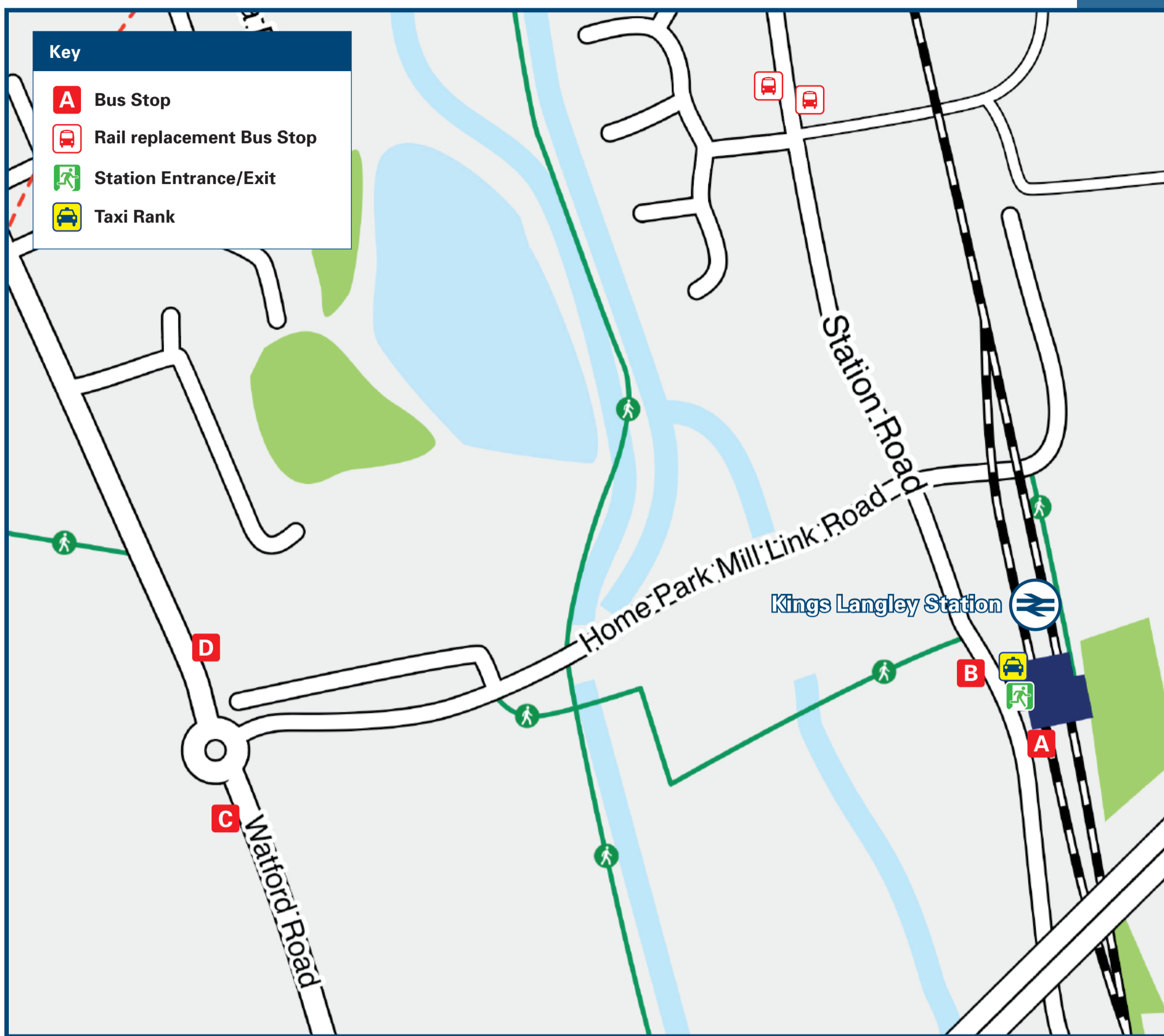

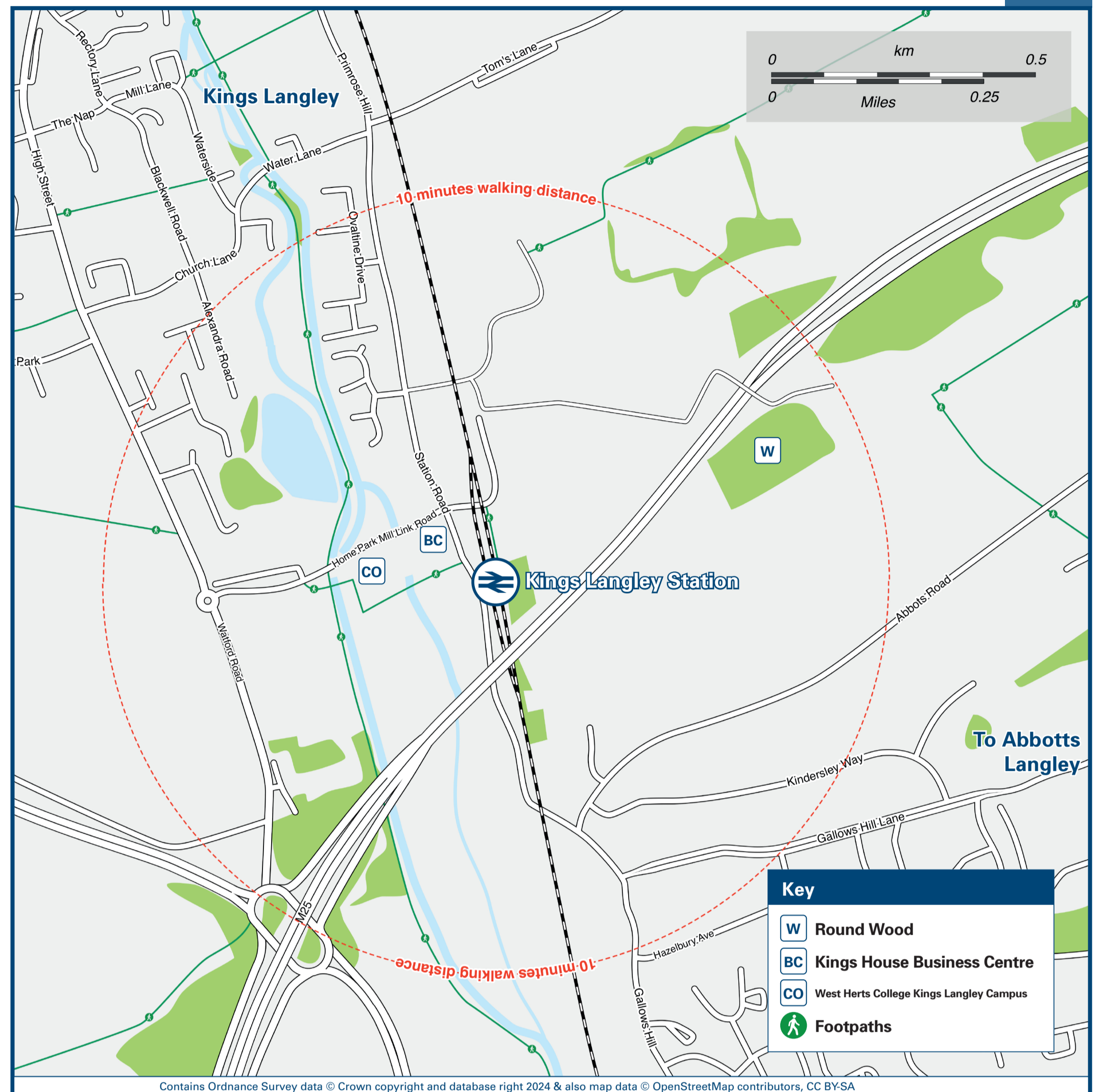
Onward Travel Information
