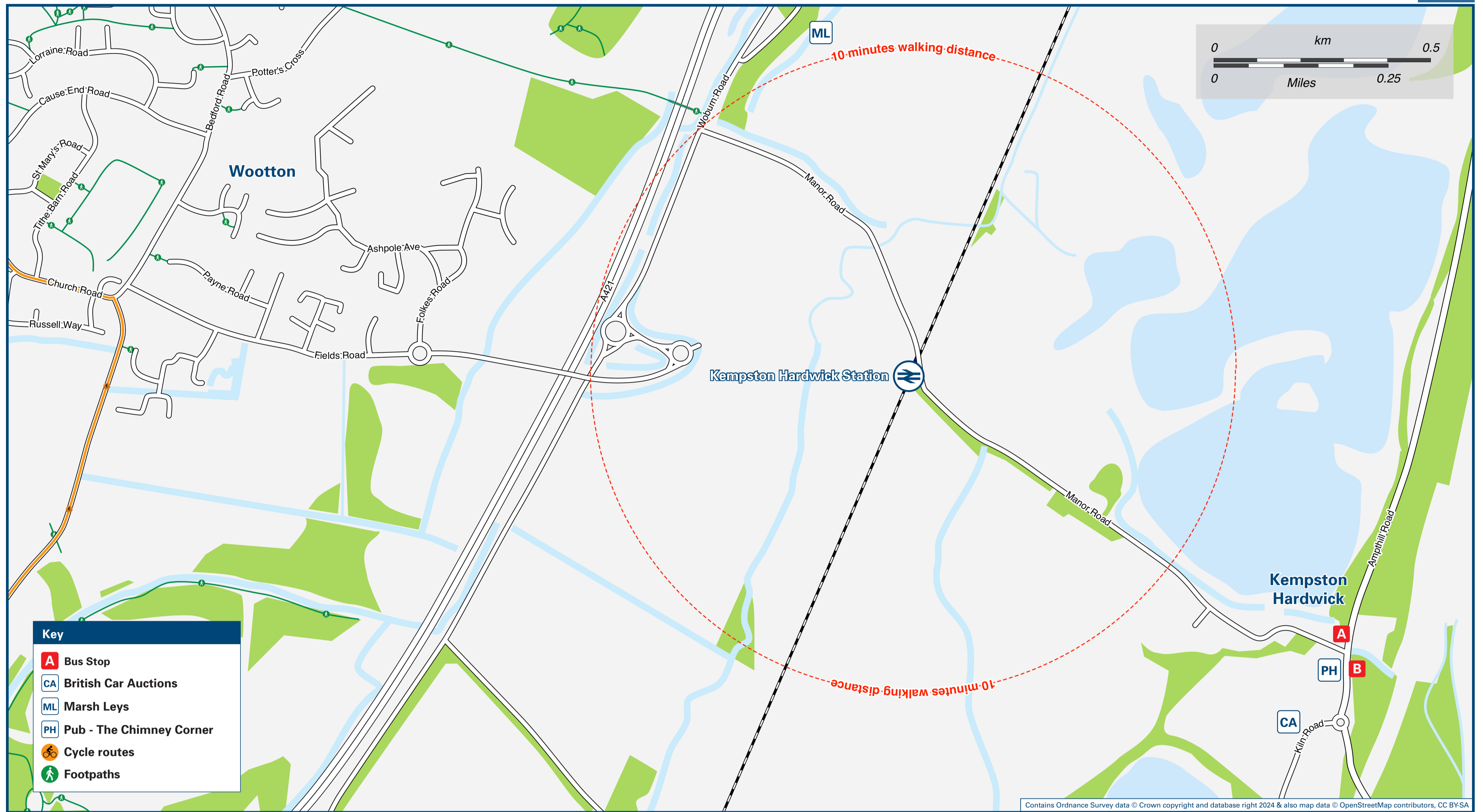




Kempston Hardwick Station
