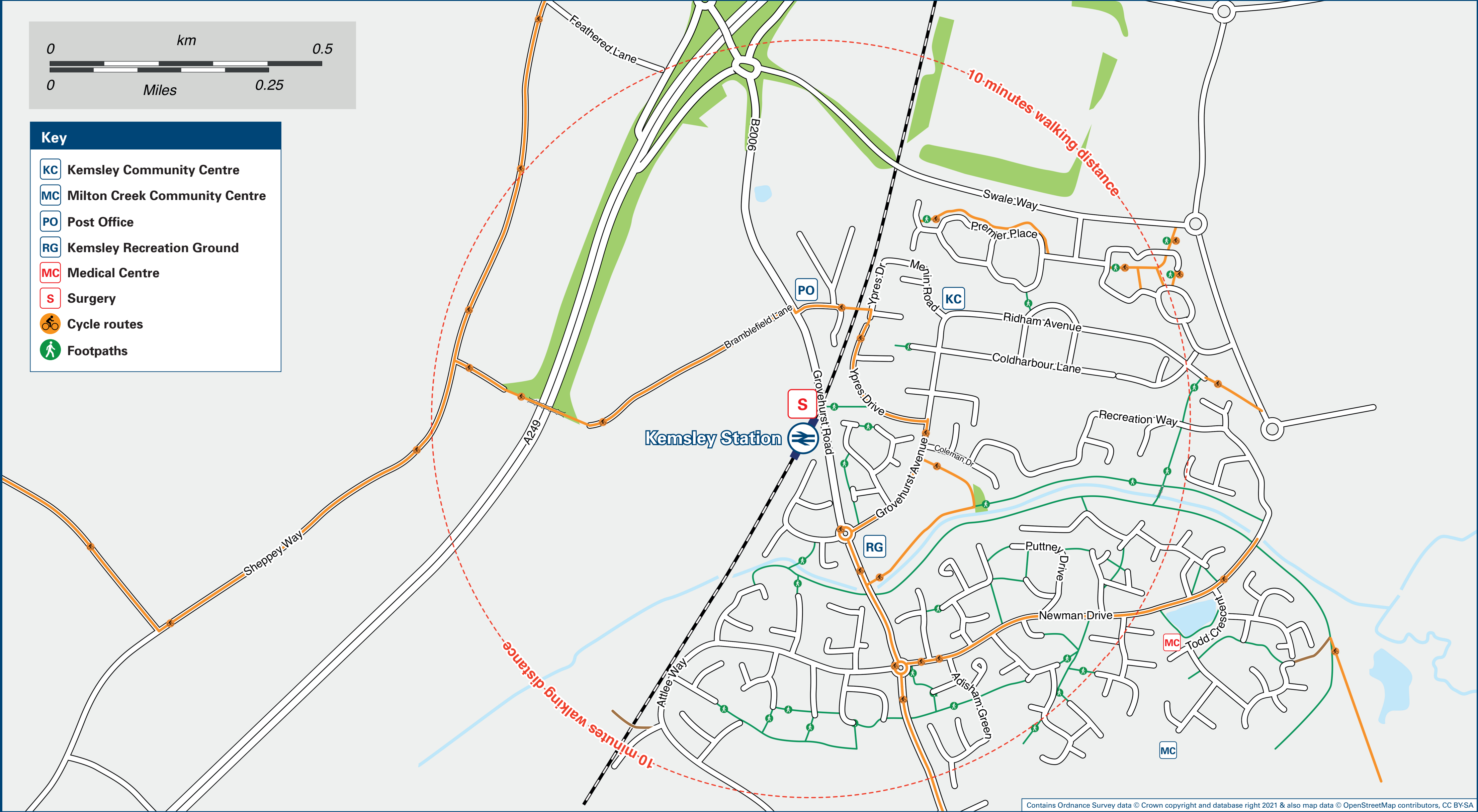




Kemsley Station
