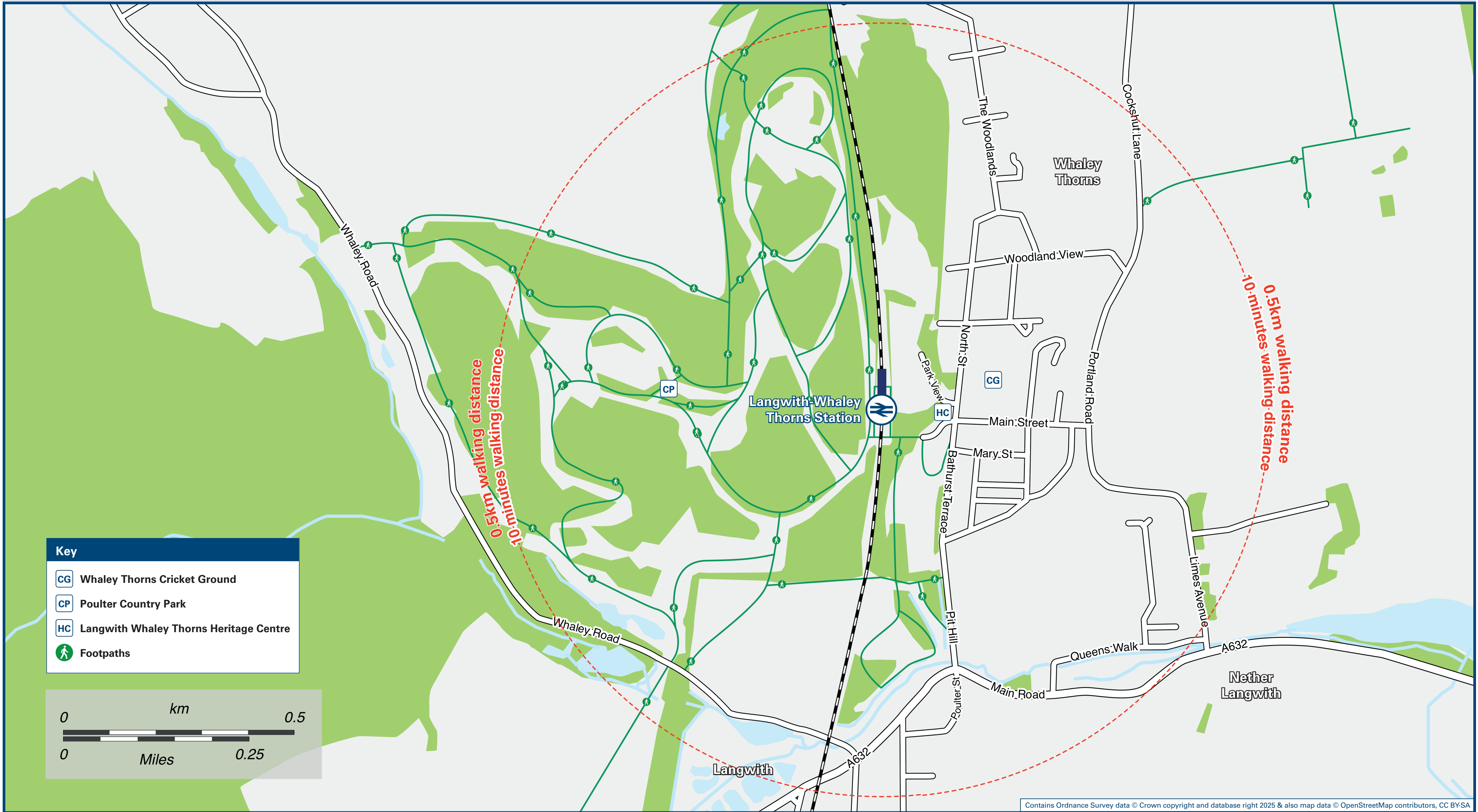




# Langwith-Whaley Thorns Station
