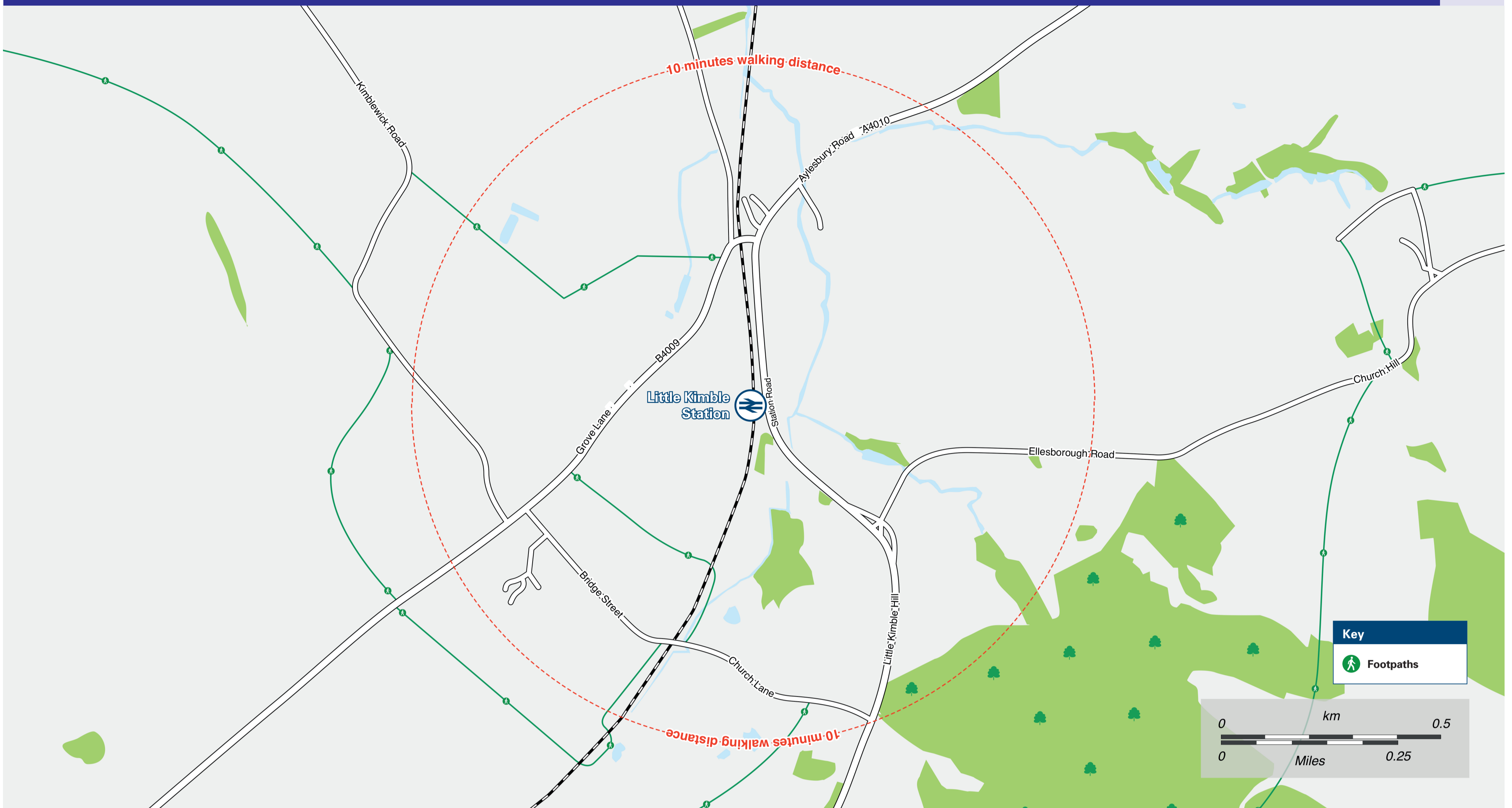




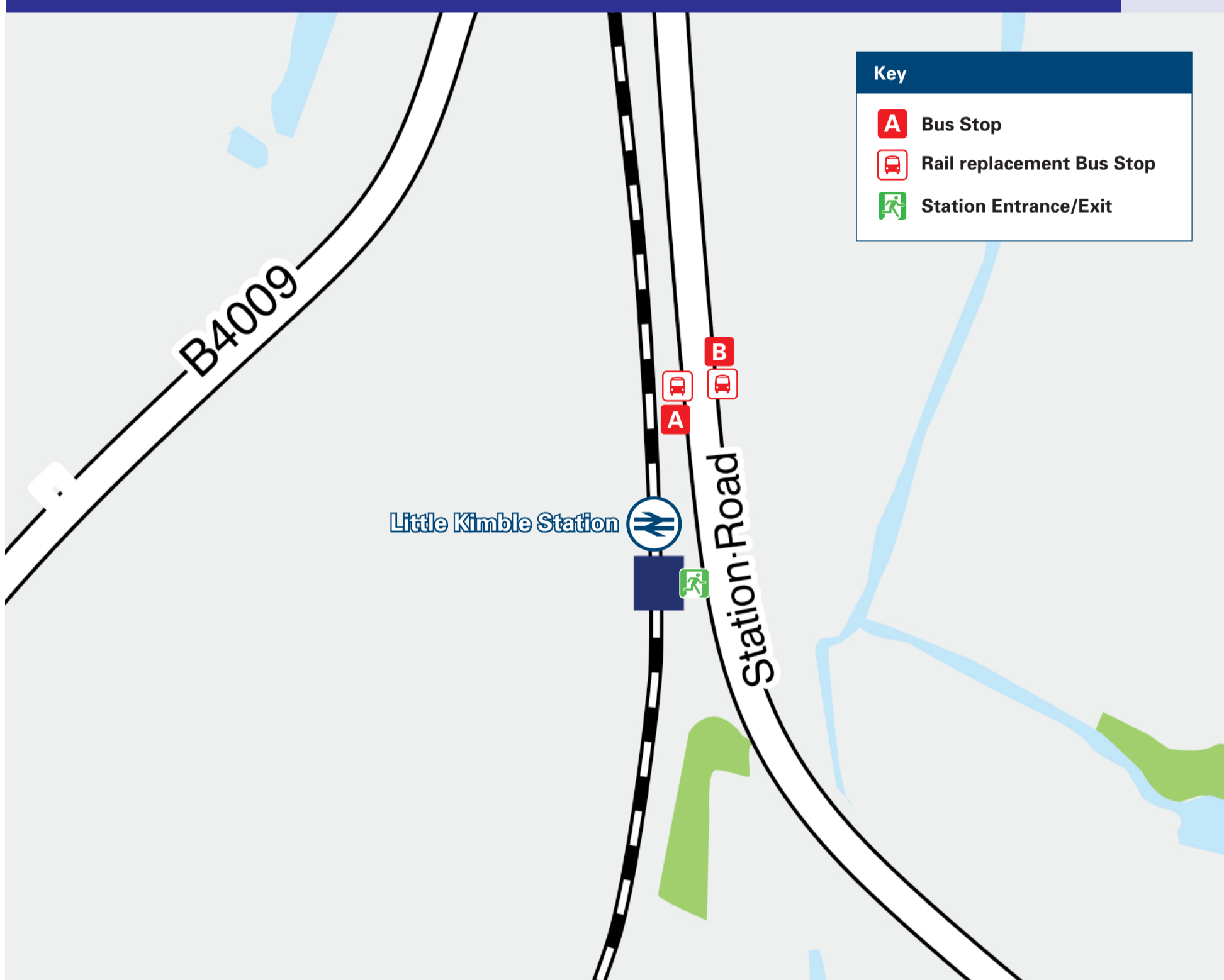
Onward Travel Information

Rail replacement buses towards Princes Risborough - Rail replacement bus services depart from bus stop B. Turn left outside the station, walk 100 metres and cross the main road. Towards Aylesbury - Rail replacement bus services depart from bus stop A. Turn left outside the station, walk 100 metres and stay on the same side of the road.
