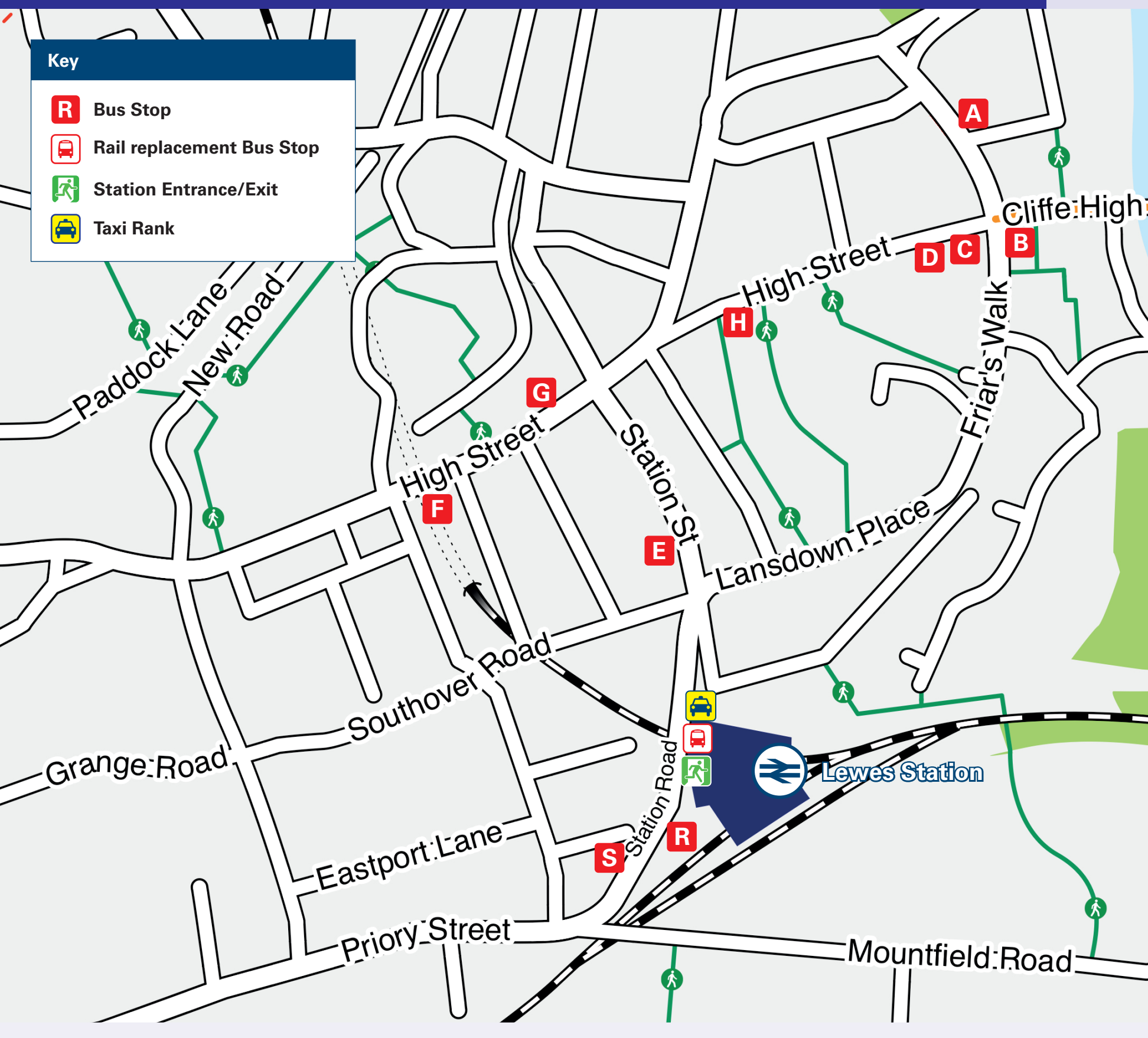

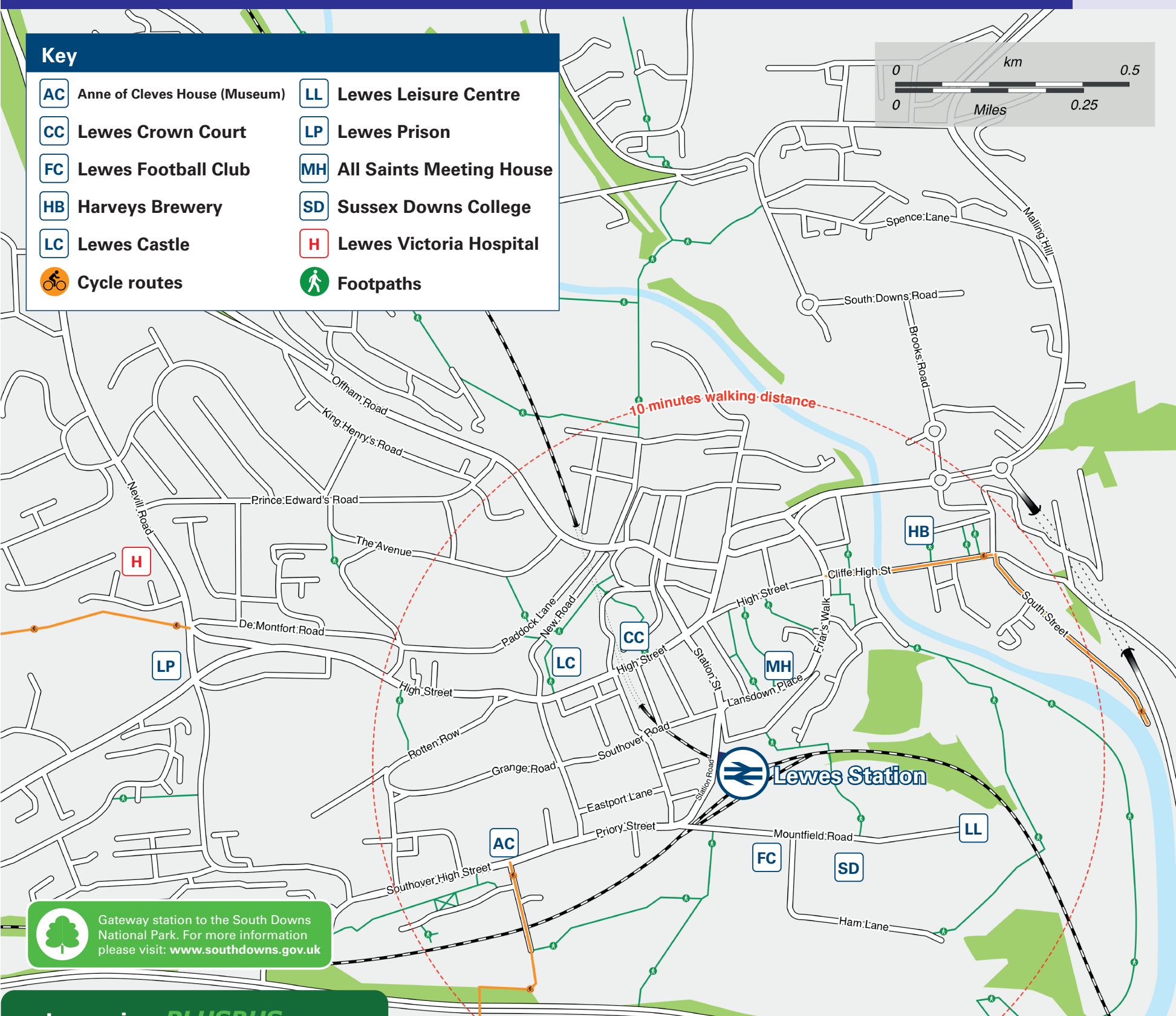
All rail replacement buses depart from the station front.

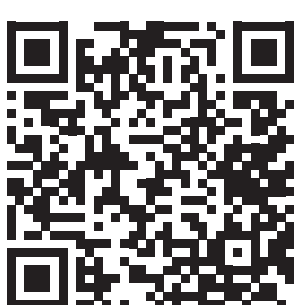
