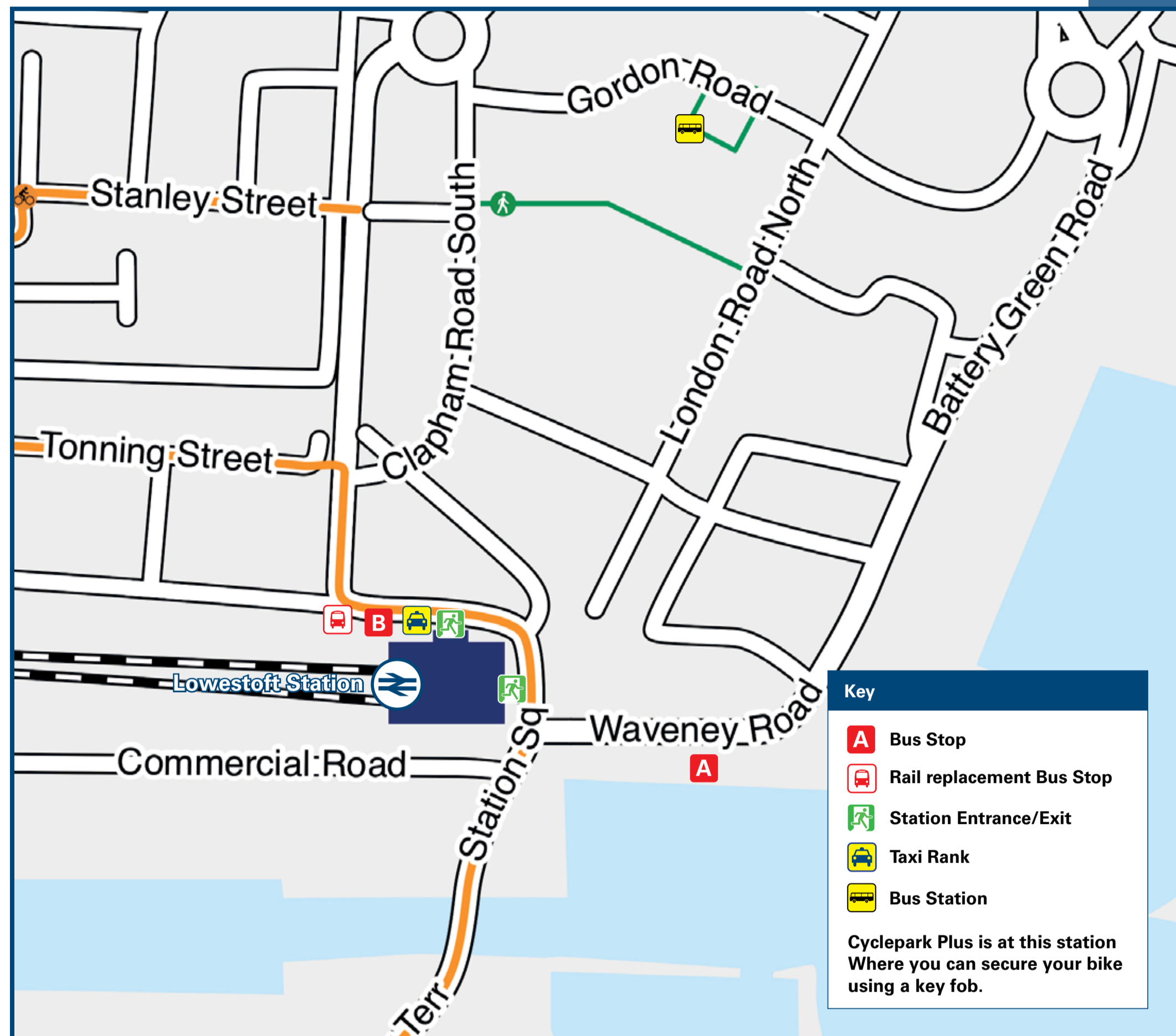




# Lowestoft Station
