Local area map

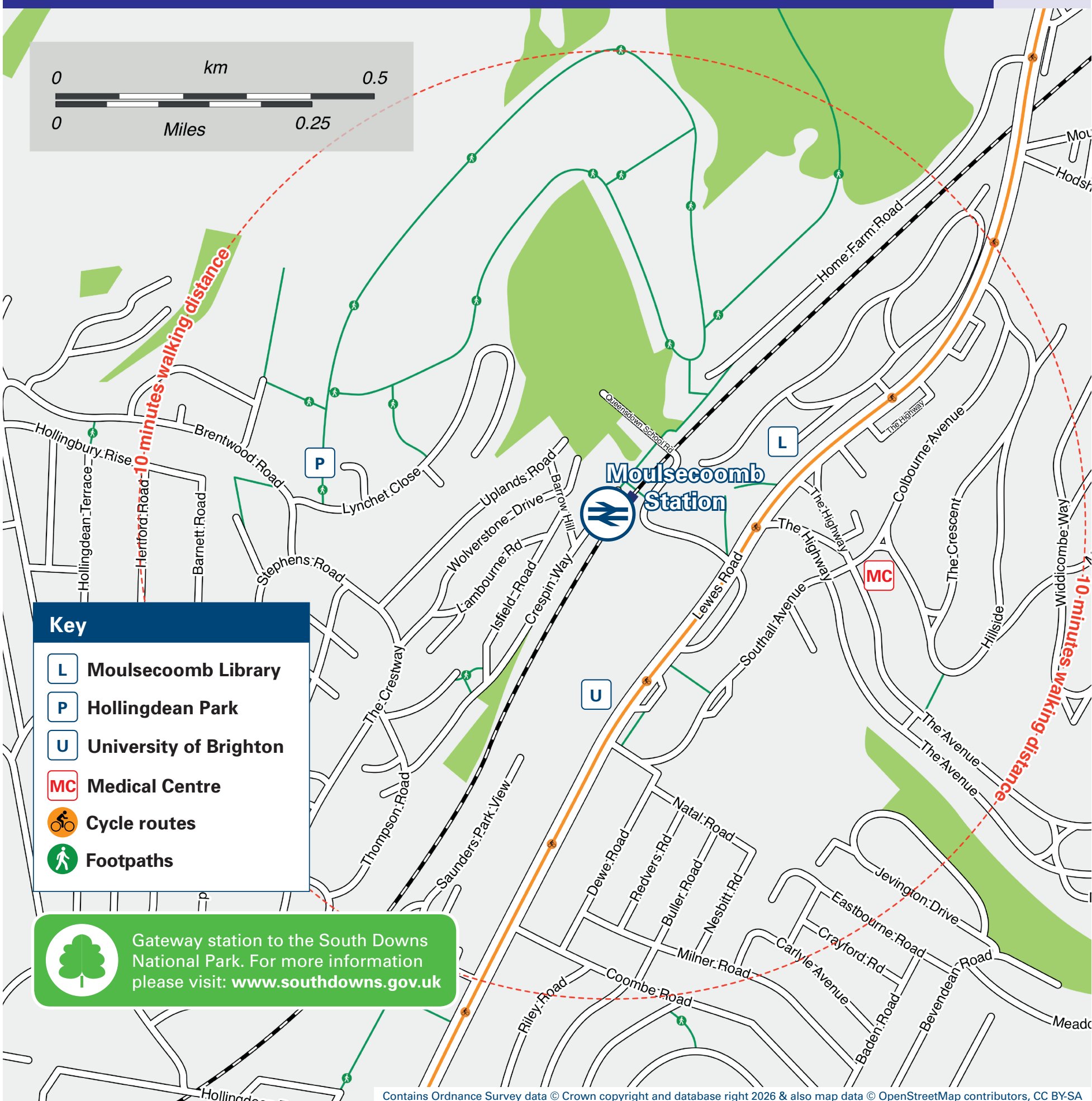
