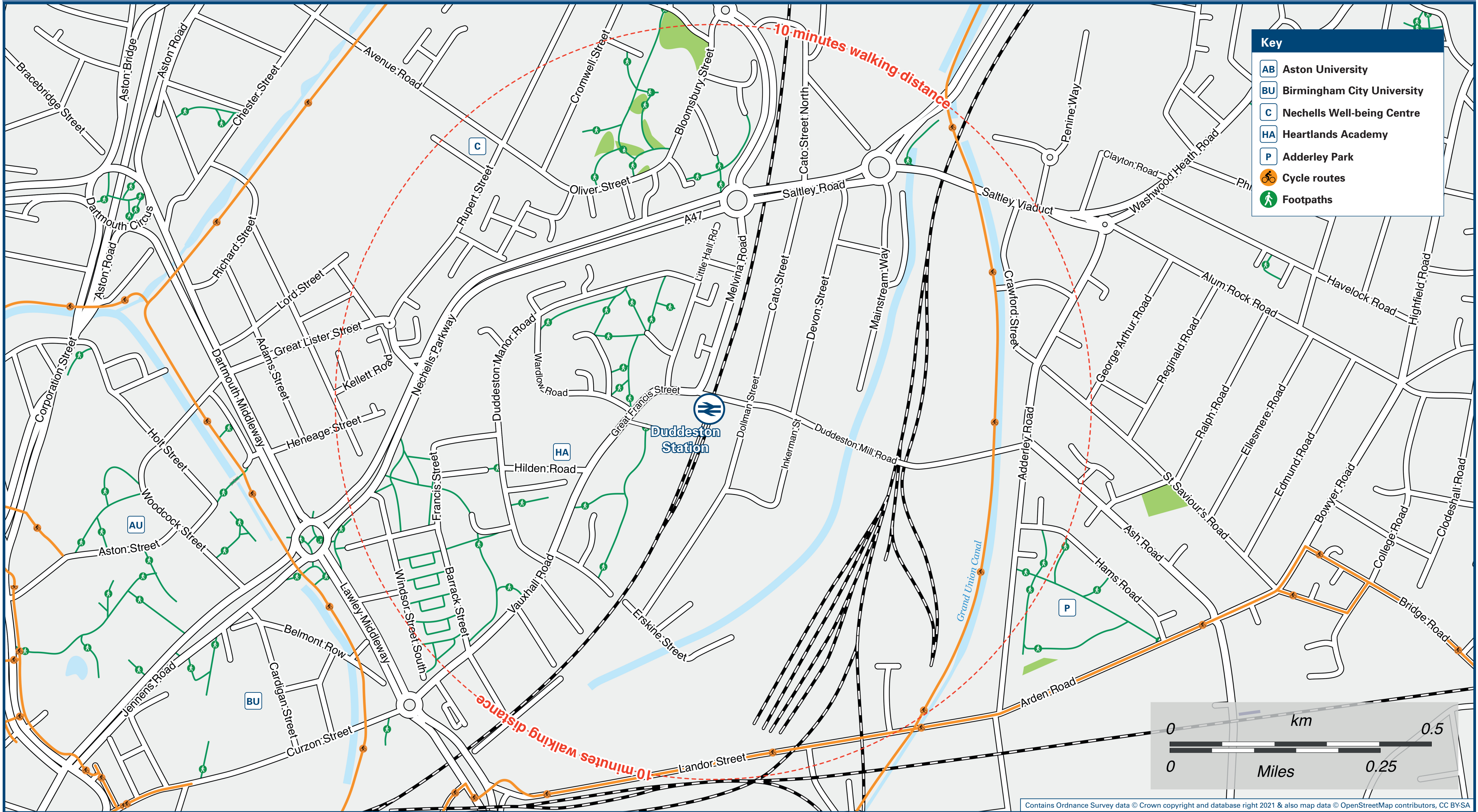




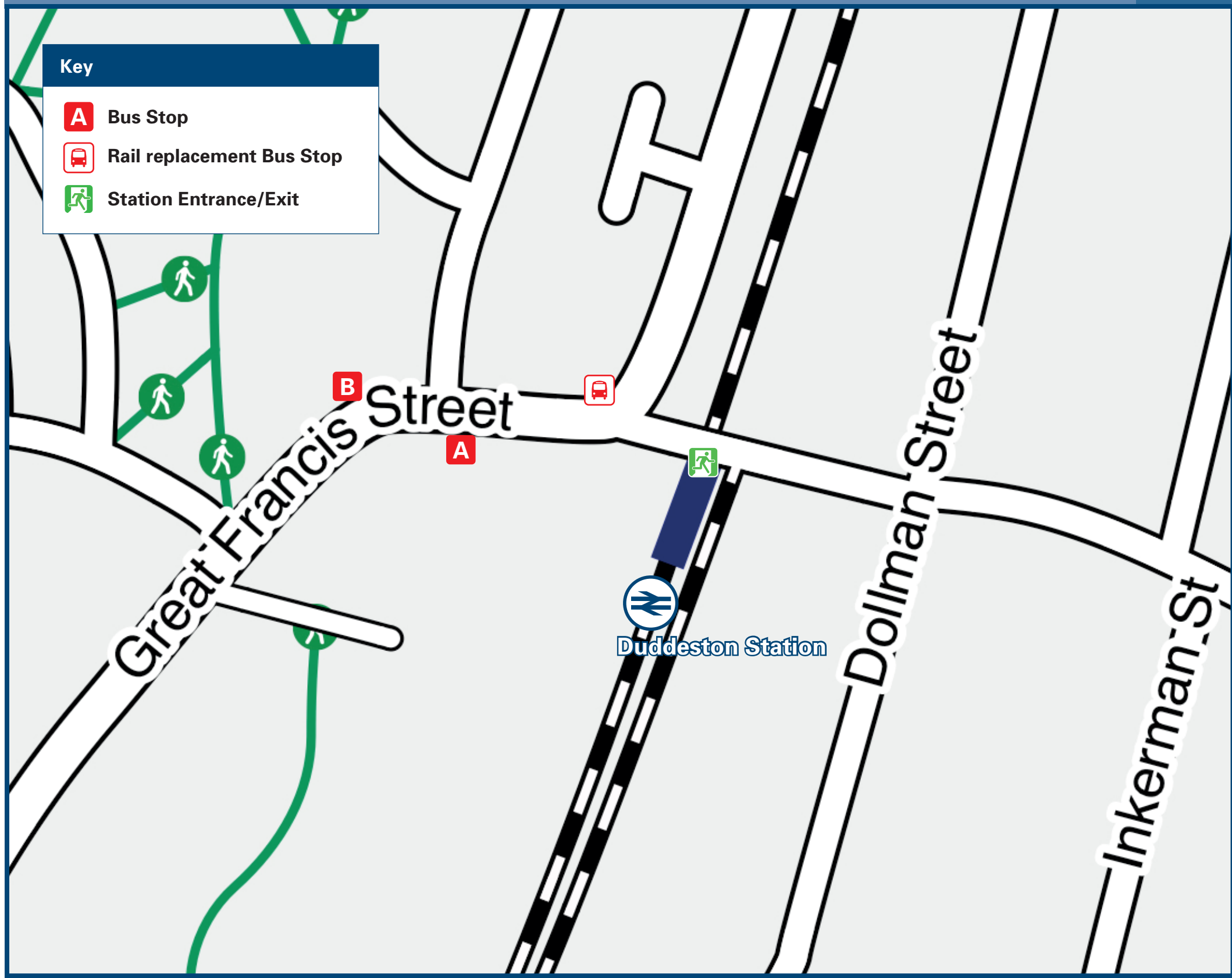
# Duddeston Station
