\* Bus route 5 operates a limited evening service from this station Mondays to Saturdays only.

\*\* Bus routes R4A and X5 operate a limited service Mondays to Fridays only.

It's approximately a 10 minutes walk from this station to Melton Mowbray town centre.

Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.
