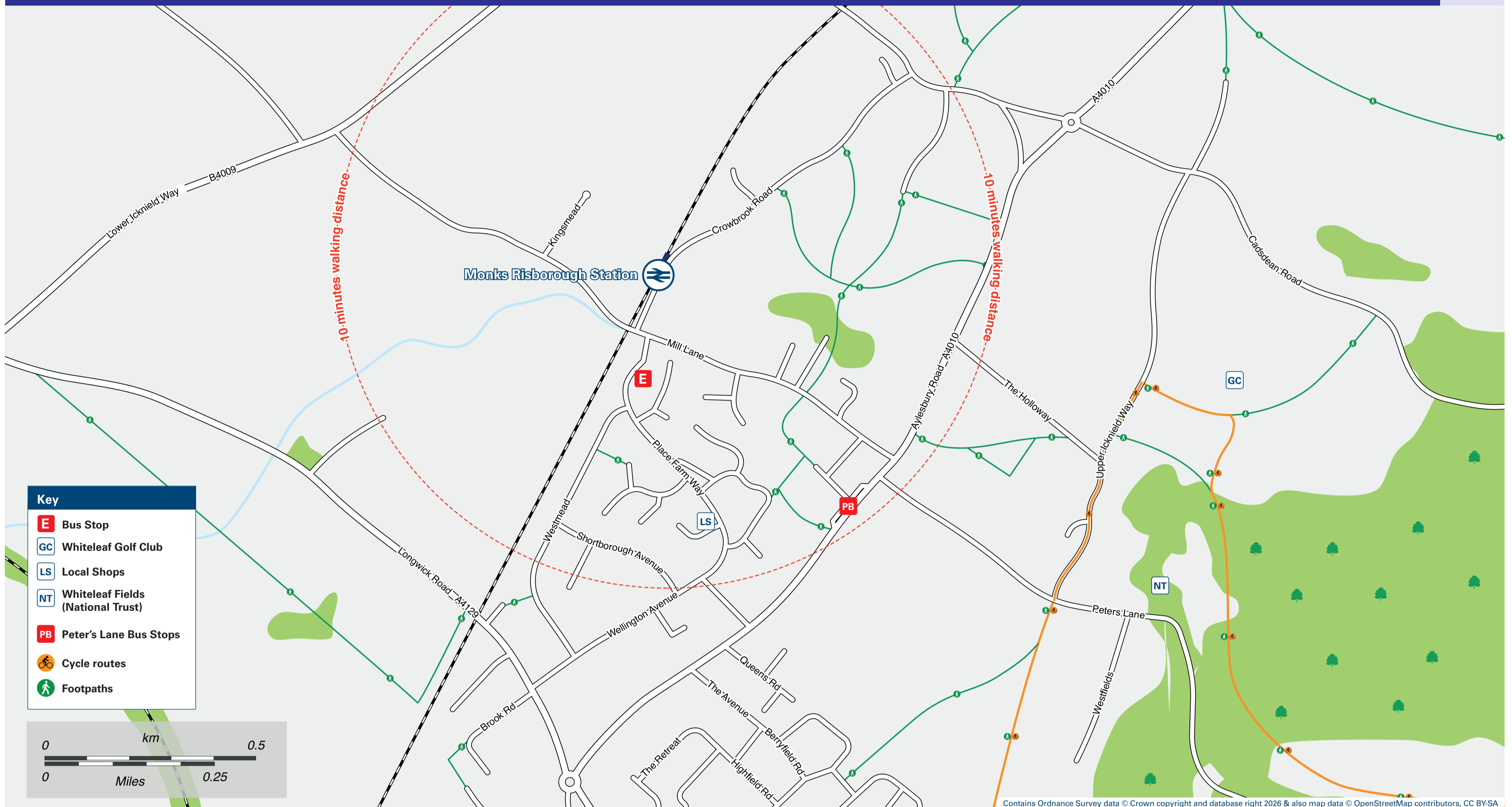




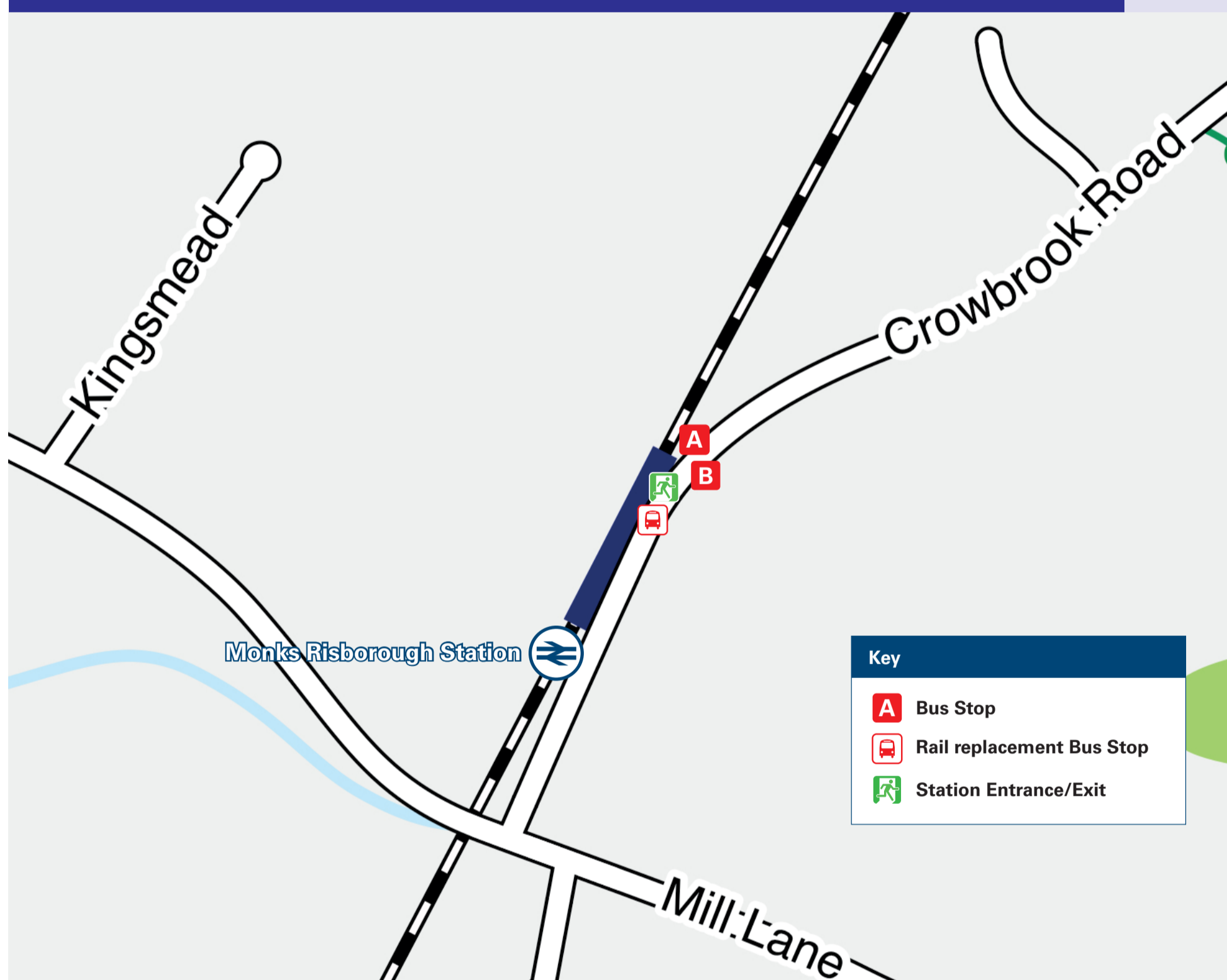

Princes Risborough (Market Square) 1

There are no regular buses from stops **A** and **B**. They are served by the Risborough Area Community Bus services route 6 on Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays, only.

Risborough Area Community Bus route 1 operates on Mondays to Saturdays service, only, from stop **E** on Place Farm Way. No Sunday service.

Stops for regular buses to Aylesbury, Princes Risborough and High Wycombe can be found on the Aylesbury Road near Peters Lane, please see the local area map. These are served by a regular bus service 130 and 300.
