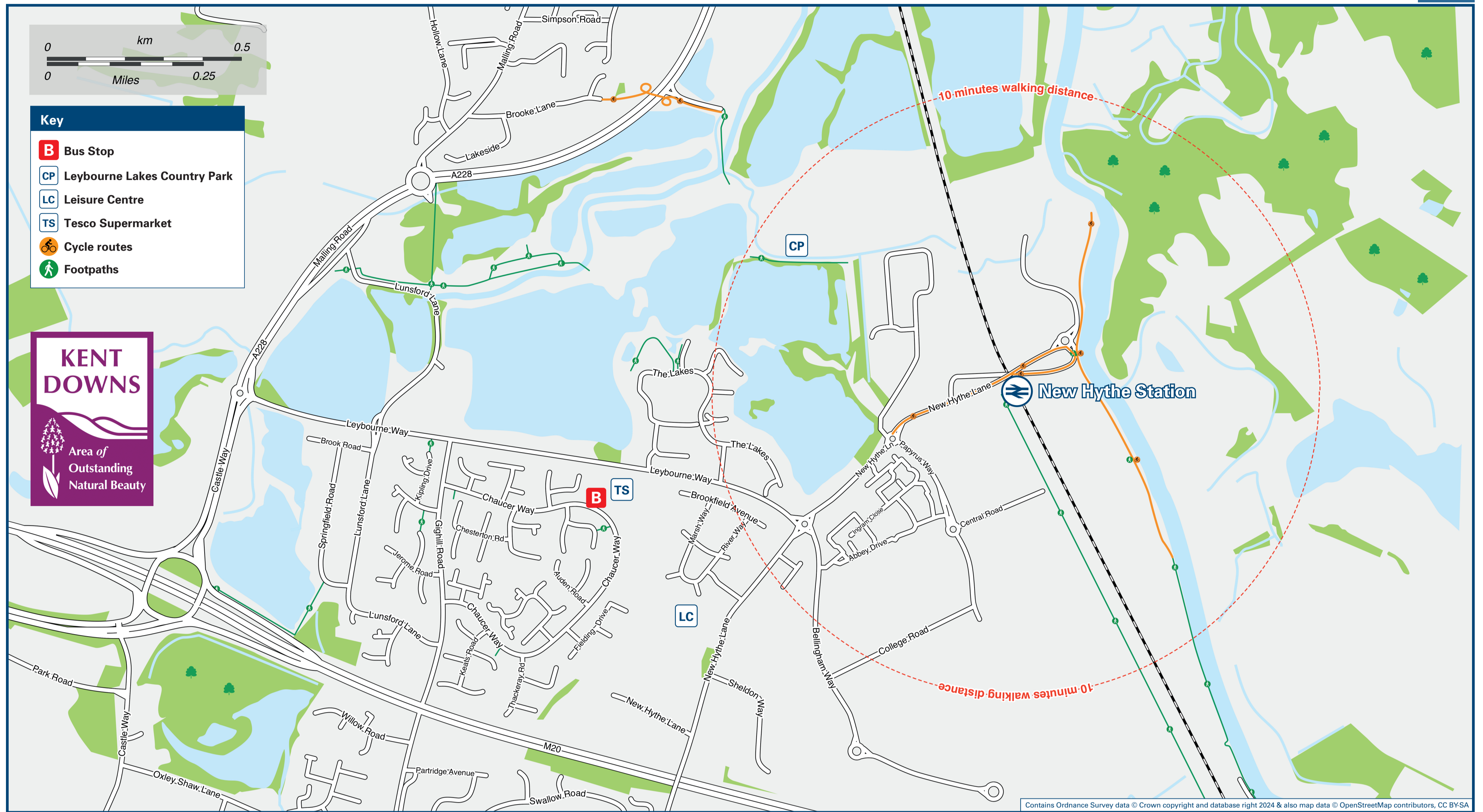




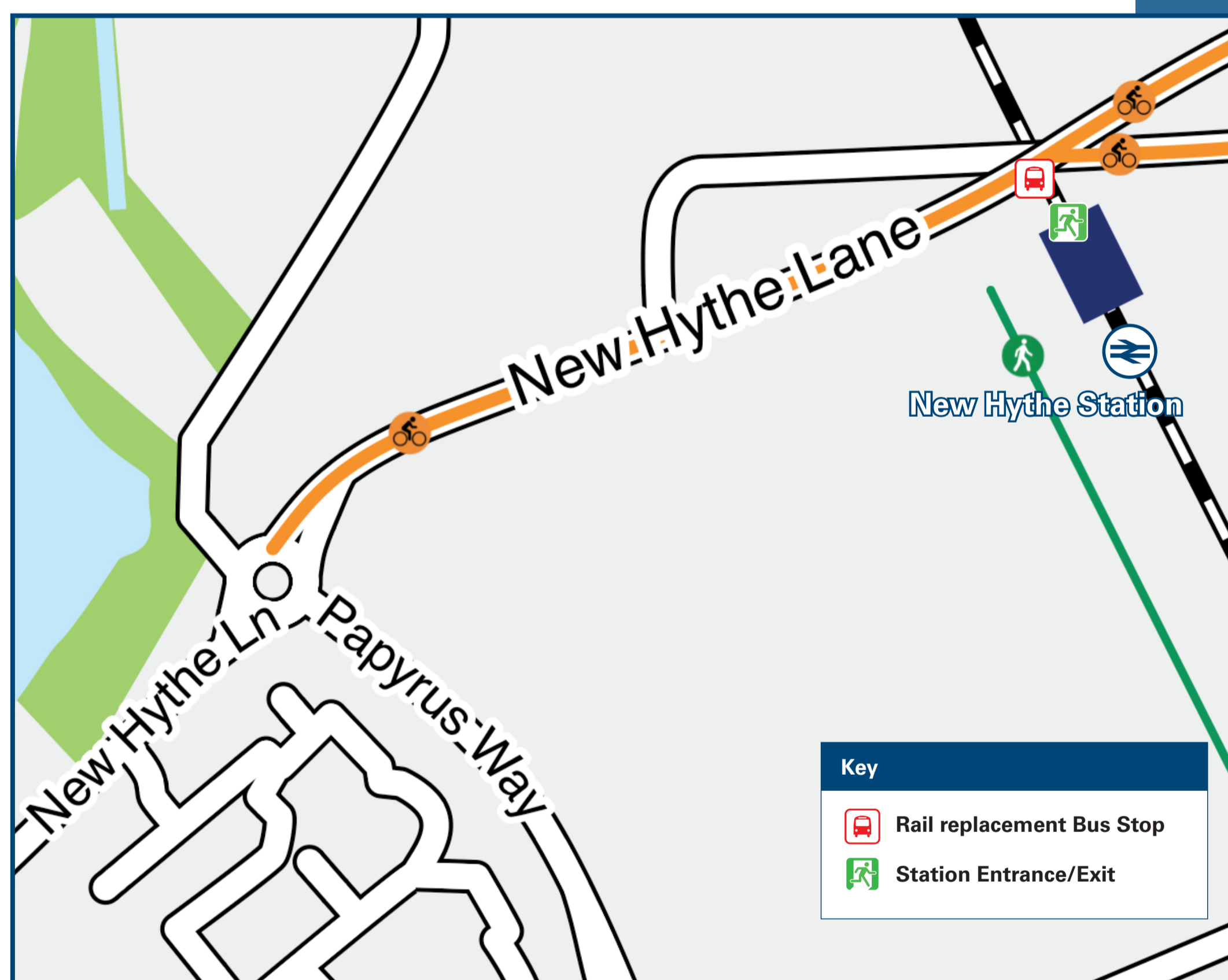

**THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING NEW HYTHE RAILWAY STATION**

The nearest bus stop for regular bus services is at Lunsford Park Tesco on Chaucer Way, a 20 to 25 minutes walk from this station. See Local area map for walking route.

Bus routes from Lunsford Park Tesco bus stop **B** are:

Bus route 70 operates a limited service Mondays only to Leybourne, West Malling, Offham, Wrotham Heath and Borough Green.

Bus route 71 operates a frequent daily service to Aylesford, Holborough, Larkfield, Maidstone and Snodland.
