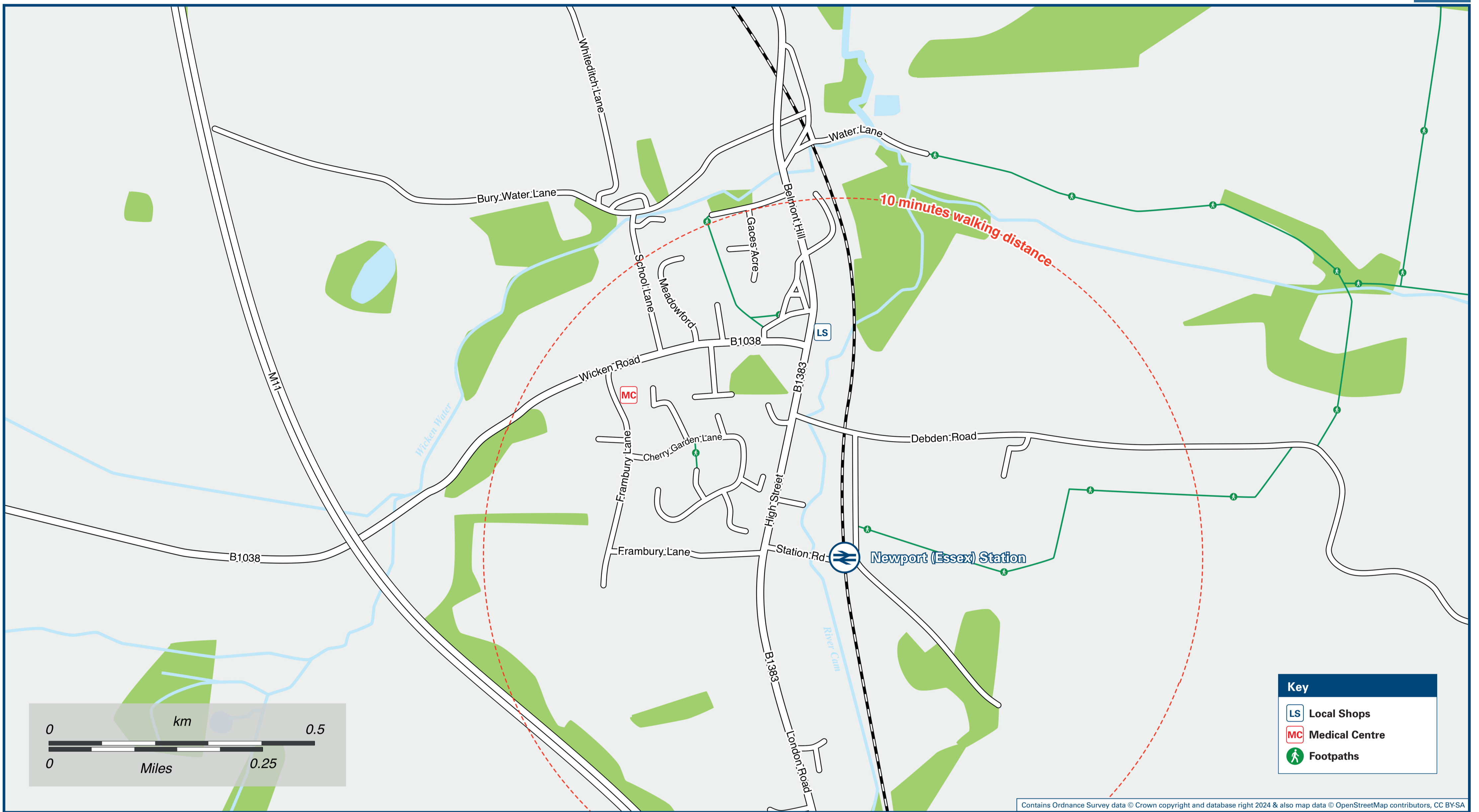




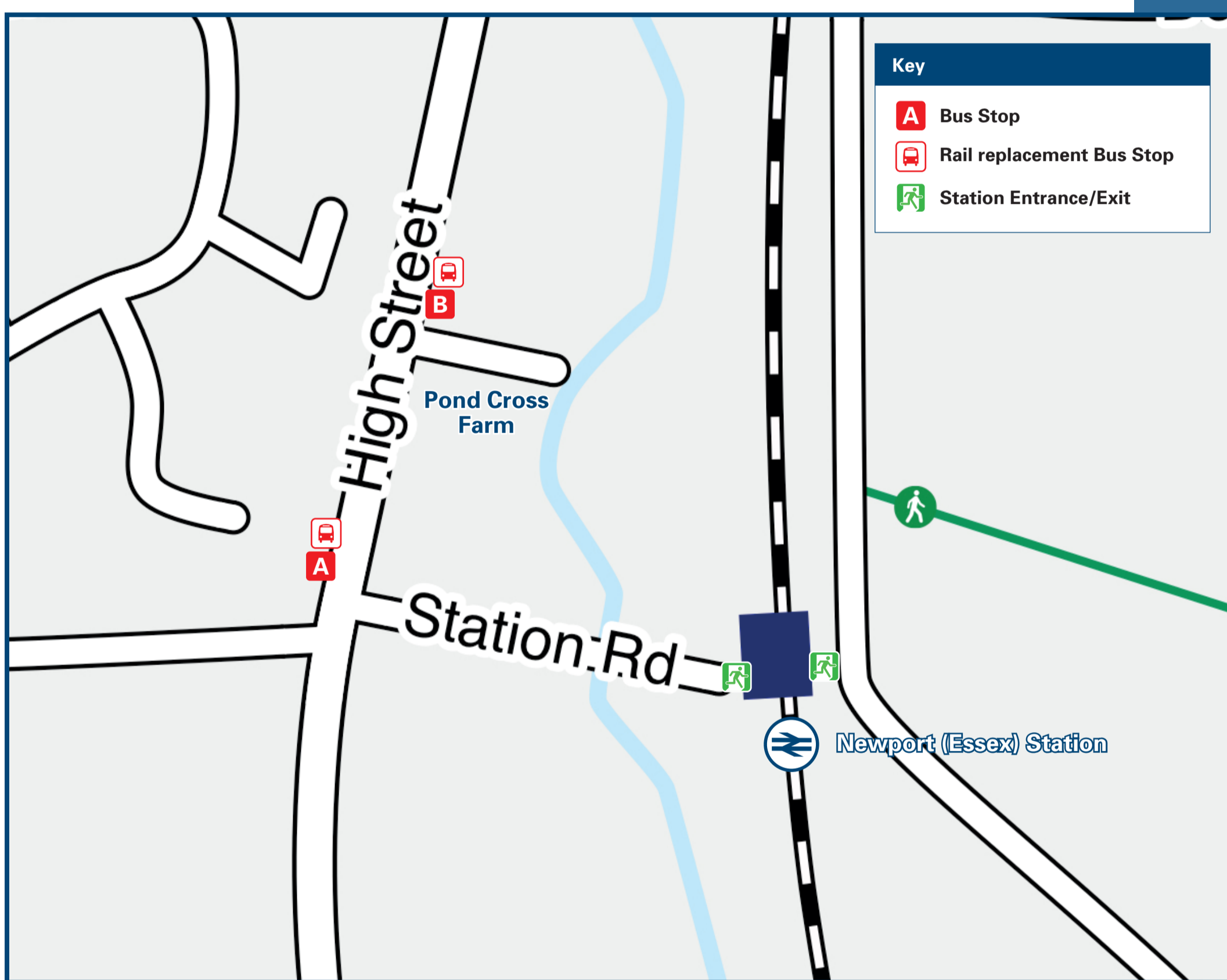
Newport (Essex) Station
