Notes

Bus routes R9 operates Mondays to Fridays and CC9 operates on Saturdays.

Bus routes R1 and R2 operate Mondays to Saturdays.

Timetable changes are kept to a minimum where possible but passengers are advised to check directly with the bus operator in case of short notice changes due to exceptional circumstances.

* Bus stops B and C are request stops with no visible bus stop pole and flag, passengers may indicate to an approaching bus that they wish to catch it by putting out their arm to hail it, providing it is safe to do so.

** Bus stop R4A operates Mondays to Fridays only. This service will no longer operate from these stops after 17/07/23.

It's a 5 to 10 minutes walk from this station to Oakham Bus Station John Street, stop A. See maps for walking route.

Direct trains operate to this destination from Oakham station.
