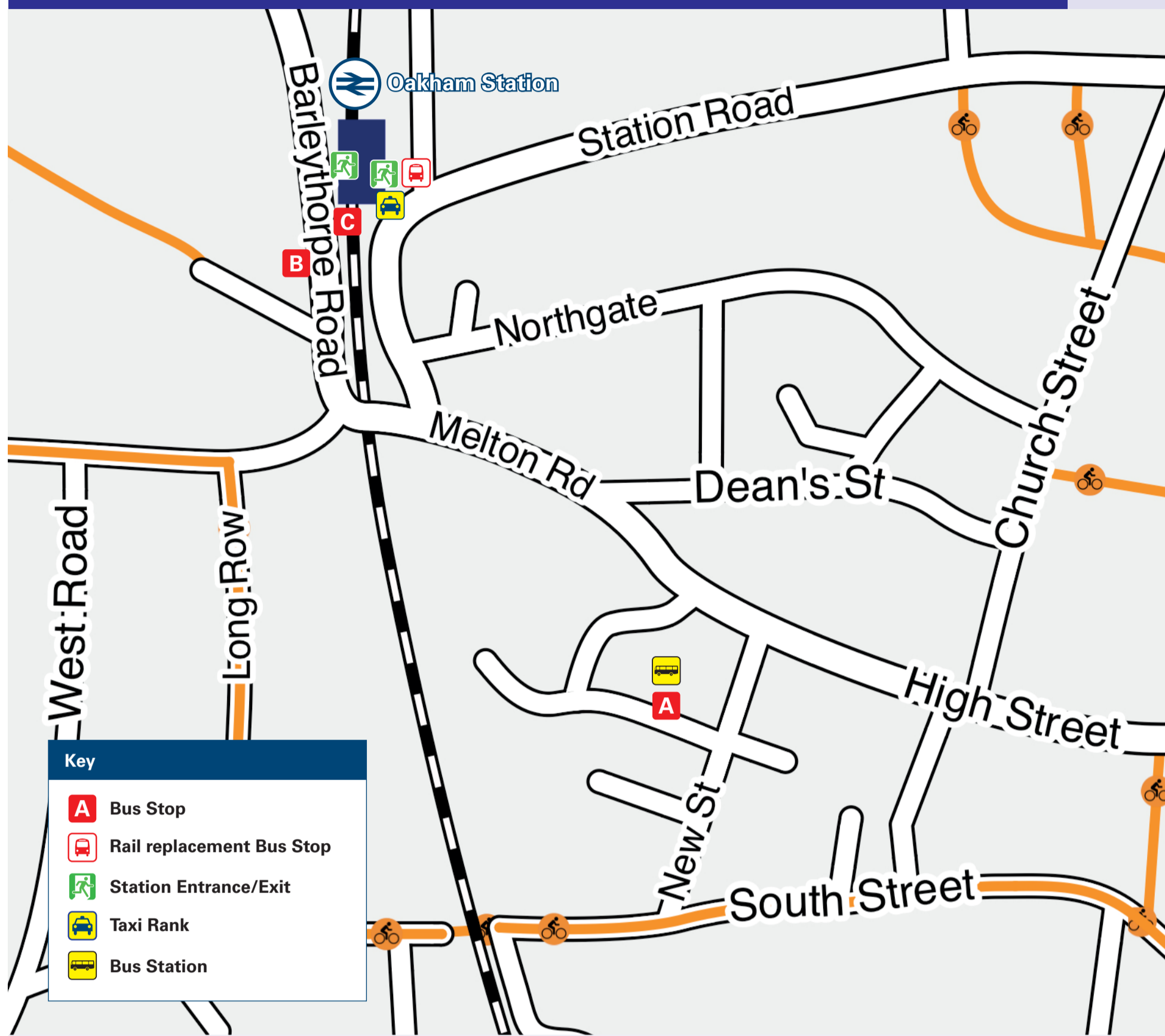

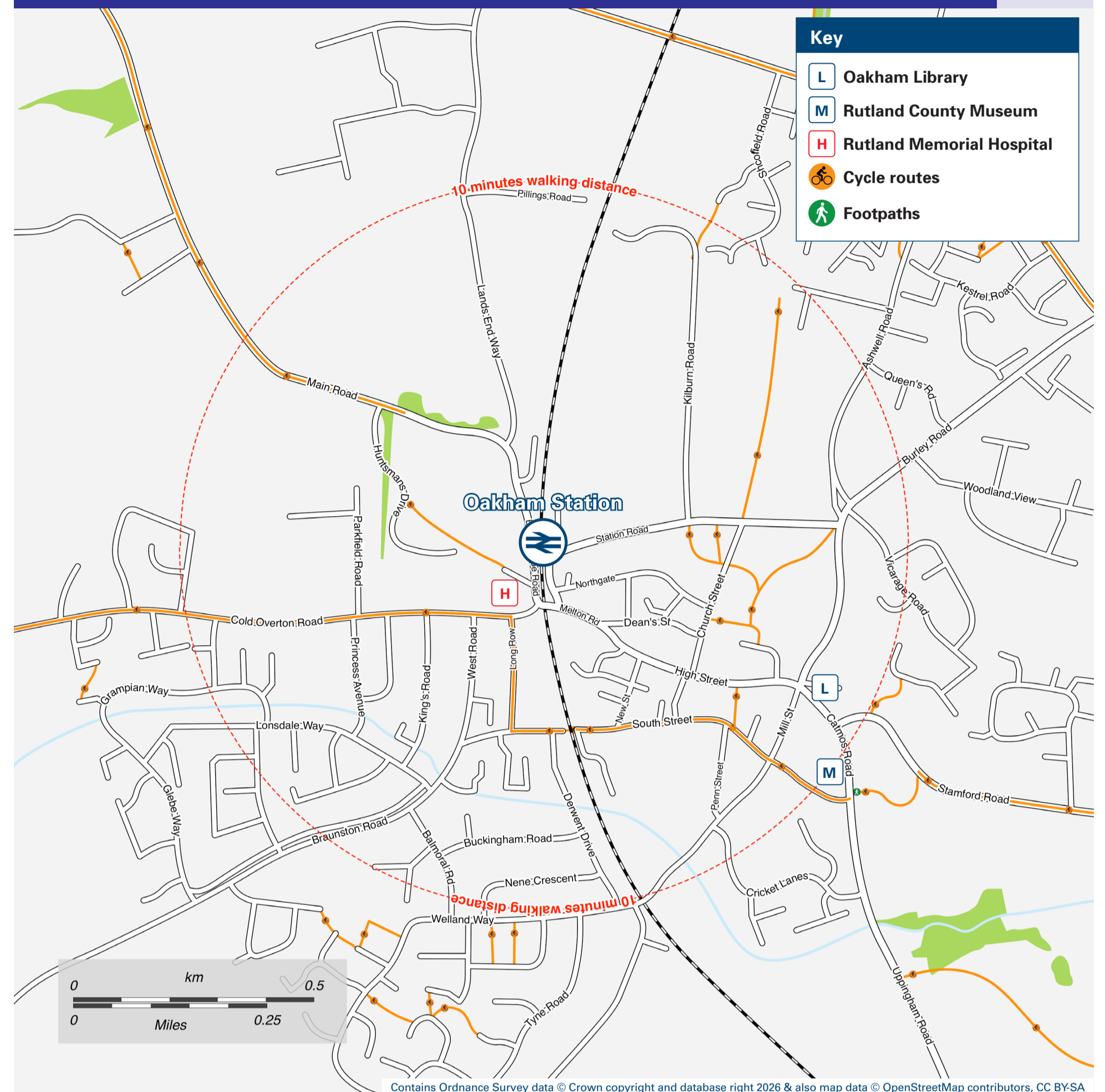
Oakham Station

* Bus stops B and C are request stops with no physical bus stop poles or flags. Passengers may indicate to an approaching bus that they wish to catch it by putting out their arm to hail it. Drivers will stop if they deem it safe to do so.

Bus routes 185, LC1 and R1 operate limited daytime Mondays to Saturdays services, only. No evening or Sunday services.

~ Bus routes R9 & RZ1 operate limited daytime services on Mondays to Fridays, only (RZ1: 1 morning service, 1 late afternoon service; R9: 8 services in the daytime, from 7.30am hourly, until 3.45pm) No evenings, Saturdays or Sundays service. Please check timetables for running times.

Direct trains operate to this destination from Oakham station.

It's a 5 to 10 minutes walk from this station to Oakham Bus Station John Street, stop (A) on this poster. See maps for walking route.
