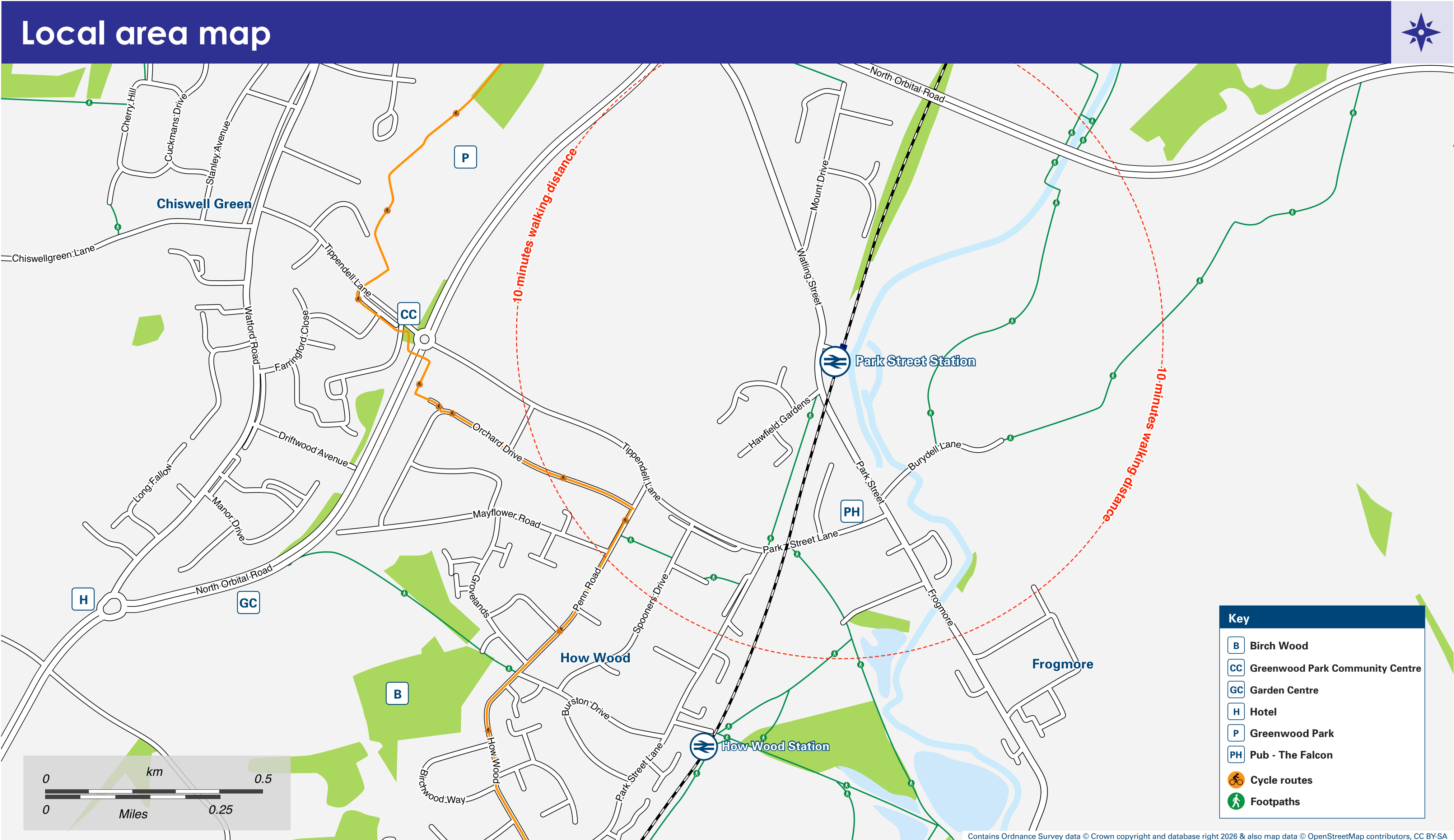


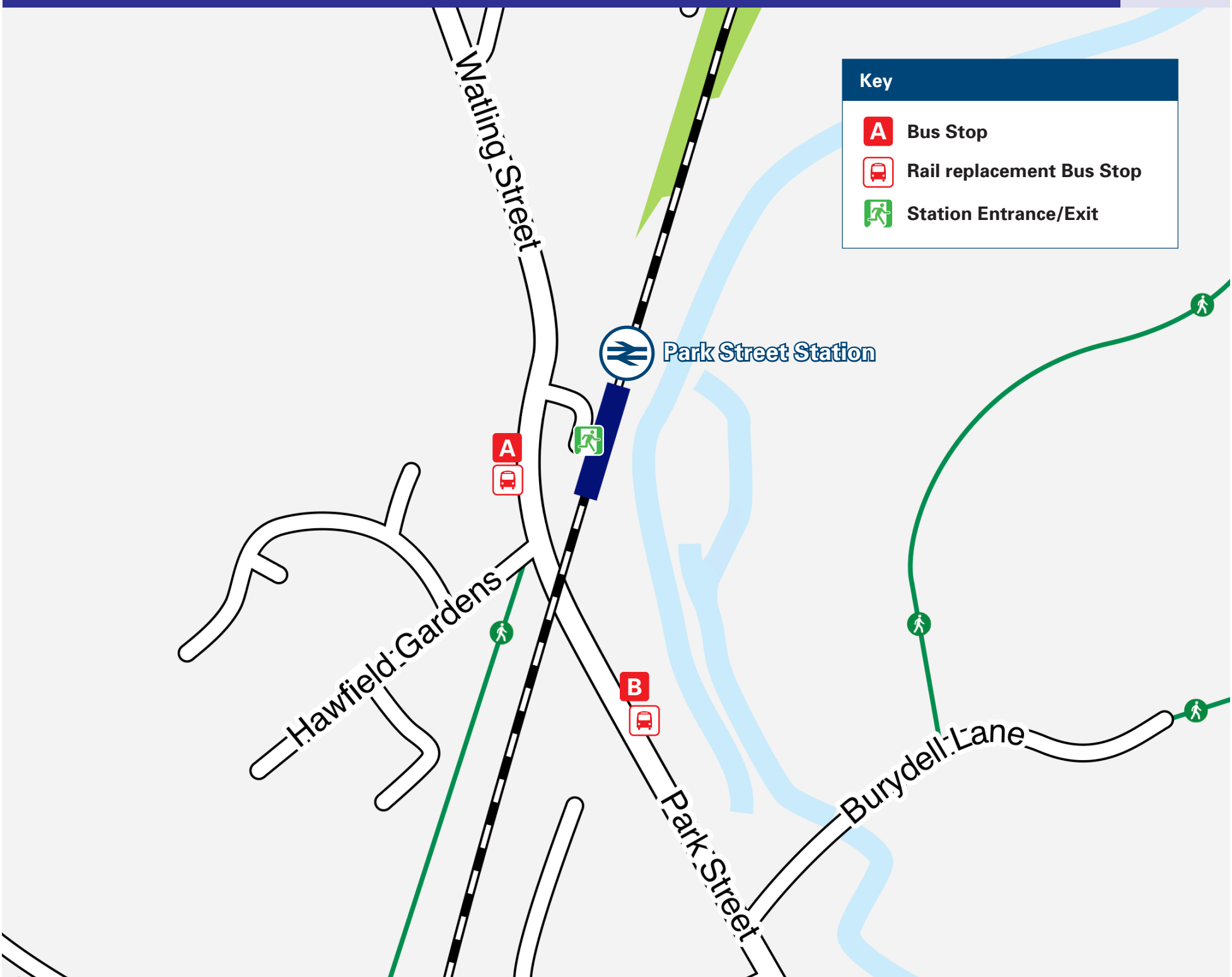


Onward Travel Information
