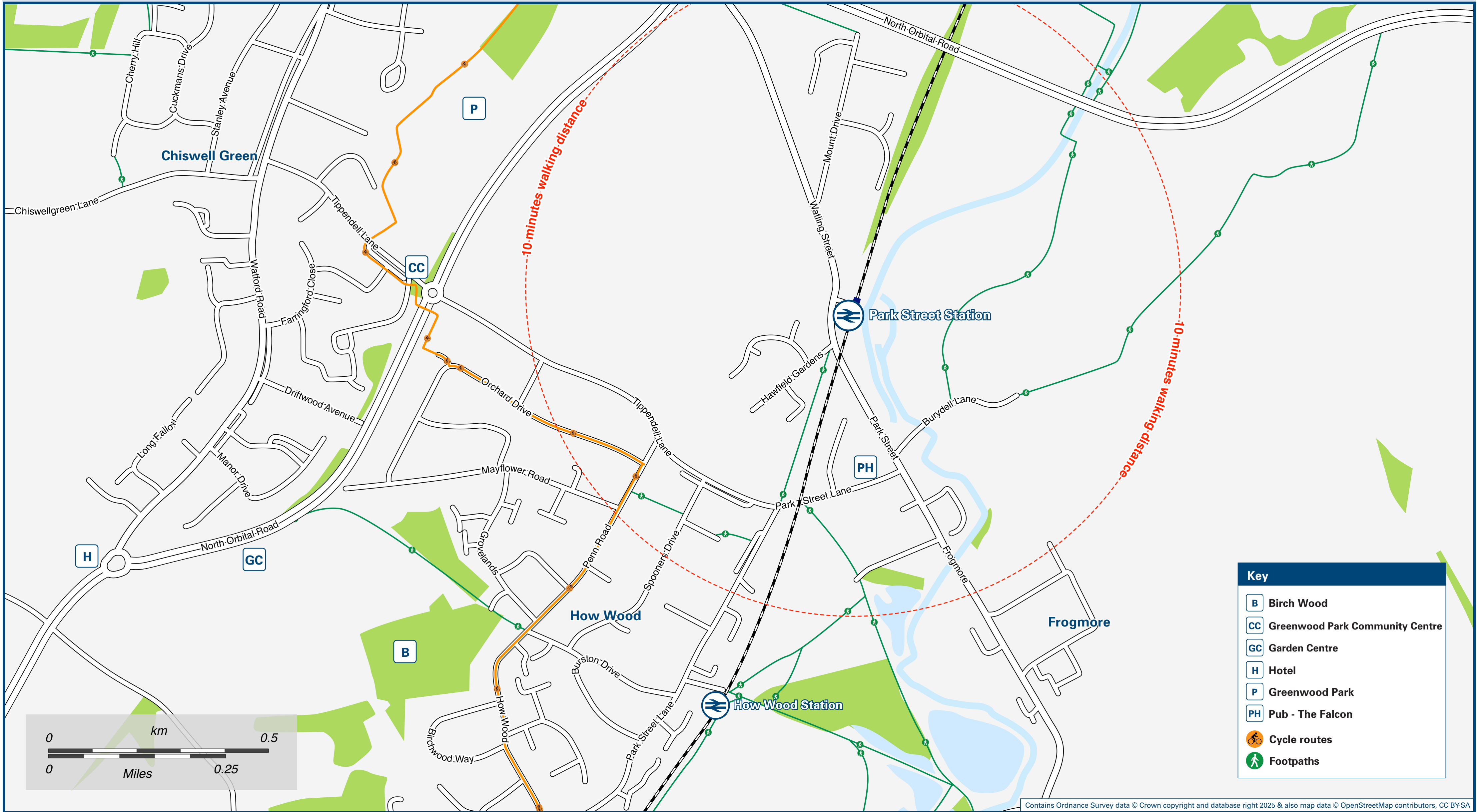




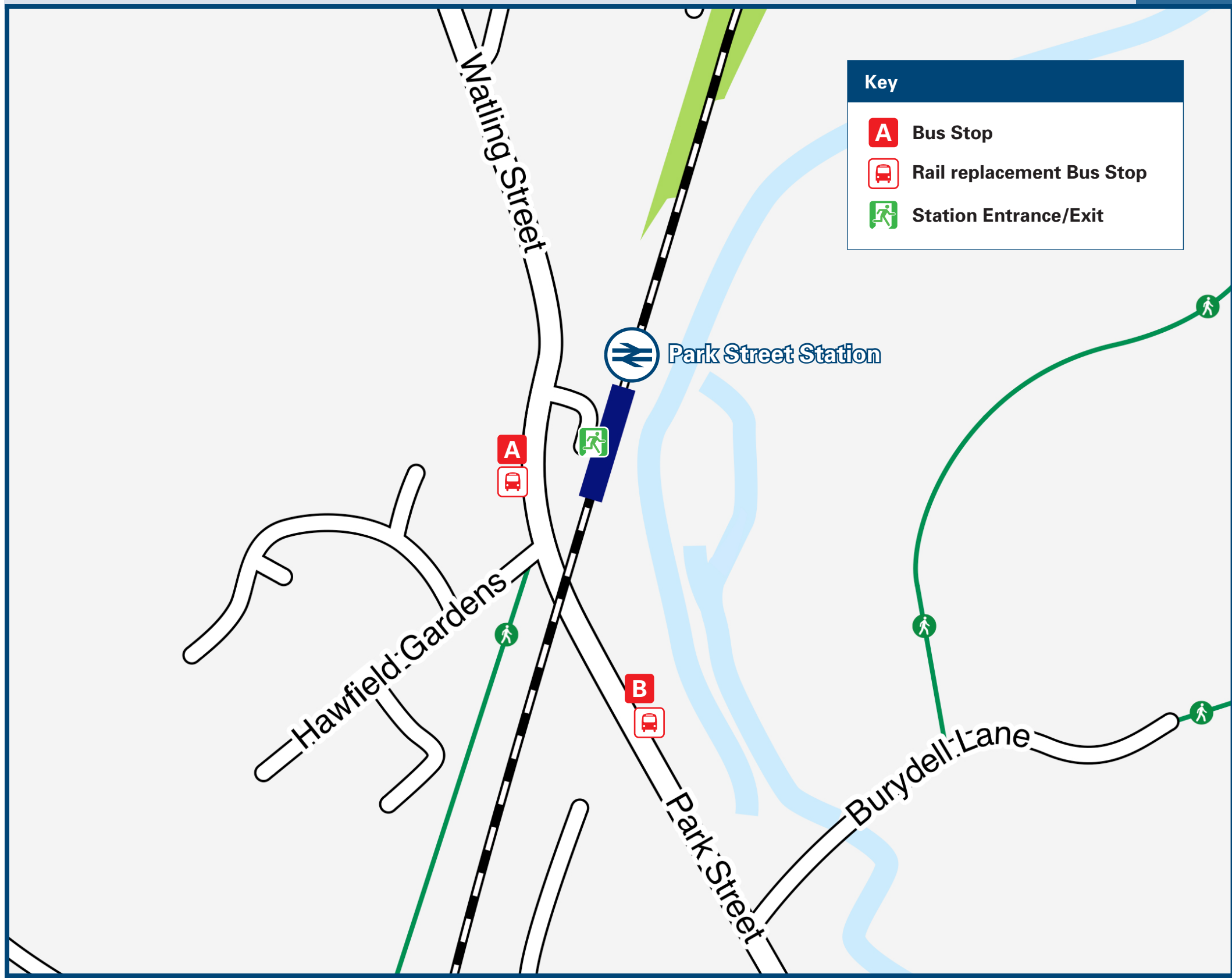
Park Street Station

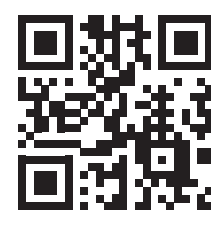
