Bus route 124 runs Saturdays from stop A at 14:07 to Offham and Lewes. Bus route 166 runs Mondays to Fridays from stop A at 09:07, 11:19, 13:19, 16:02 & 18:17 to Offham and Lewes.

Bus route 166 runs Mondays to Fridays from stop **B** at 07:53, 10:20, 12:20, 14:45 & 17:29 to Wivelsfield Green, Wivelsfield & Haywards Heath.

Bus route 167 runs Mondays to Fridays (not Wednesdays) from stop A at 08:54 & 14:29 to Offham and Lewes.

Bus route 167 runs Mondays to Fridays from stop **B** at 07:40 & 15:08 to Wivelsfield Green, Wivelsfield & Burgess Hill.

Bus route 168 runs Tuesdays and Fridays from stop **B** at 10:45 & 13:43 to Wivelsfield Green, Wivelsfield & Burgess Hill.

Bus route 168 runs Mondays to Fridays from stop **B** at 16:36 to Wivelsfield
