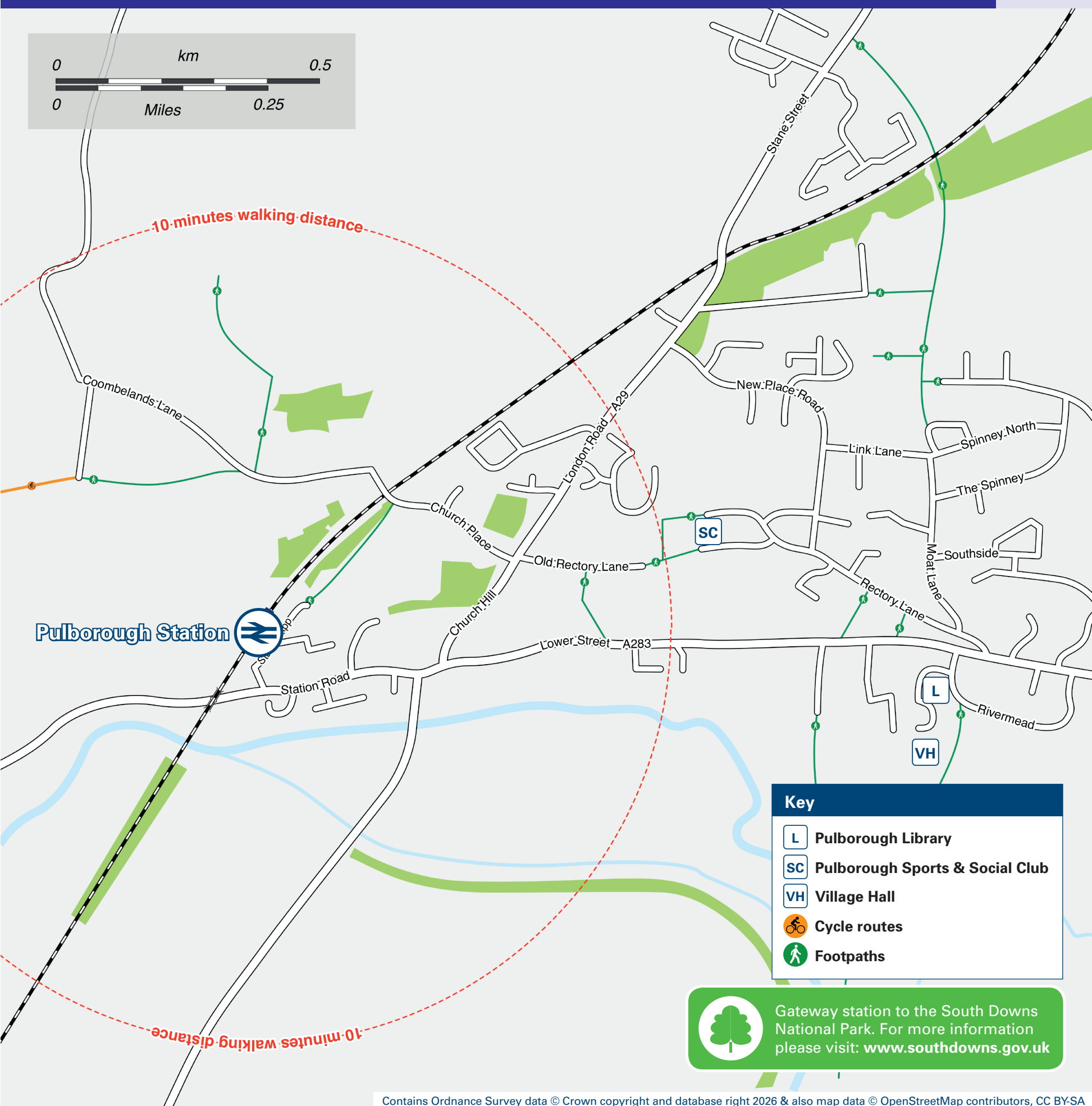
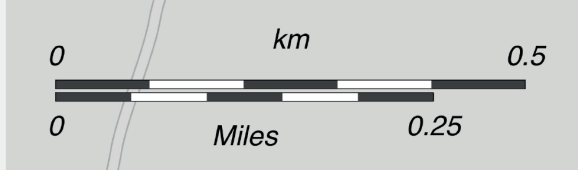




All rail replacement buses depart from the Station front.
