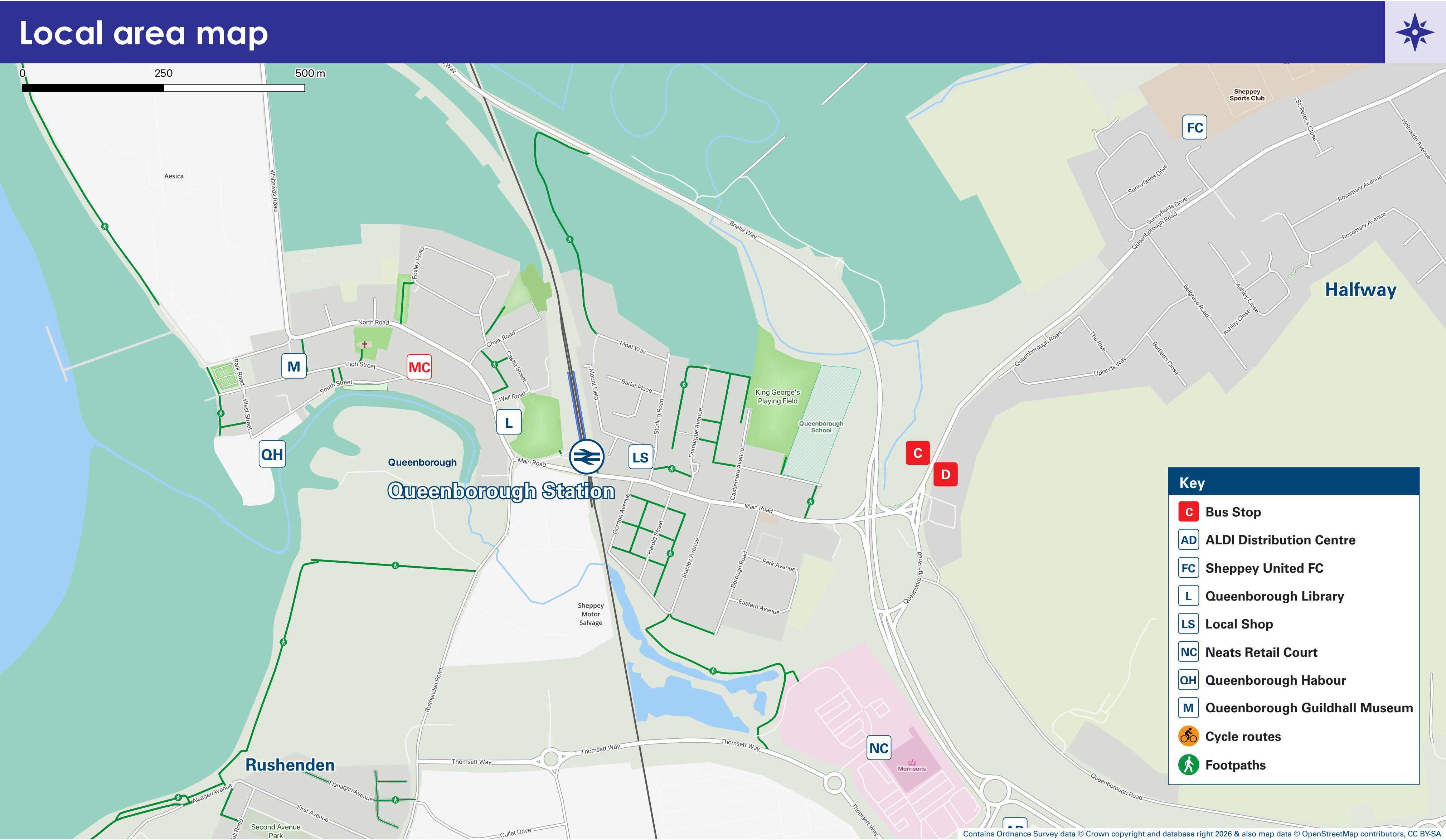


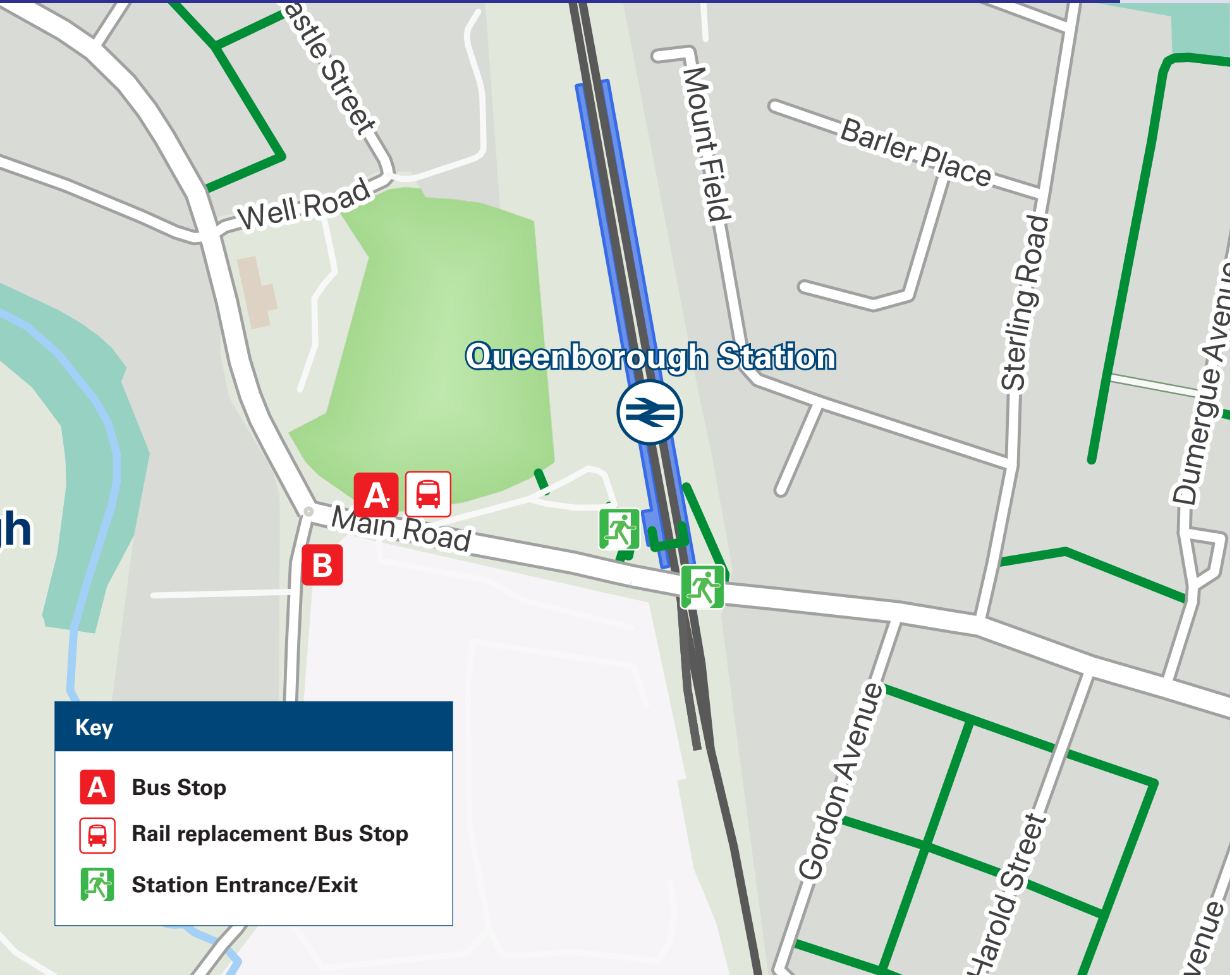


Onward Travel Information

Queenborough Station



Buses



Rail replacement buses towards Sittingbourne depart from the bus stop **A** at the end of Station Approach; towards Sheerness buses depart from opposite the bus stop **B** at the end of Station Approach.
