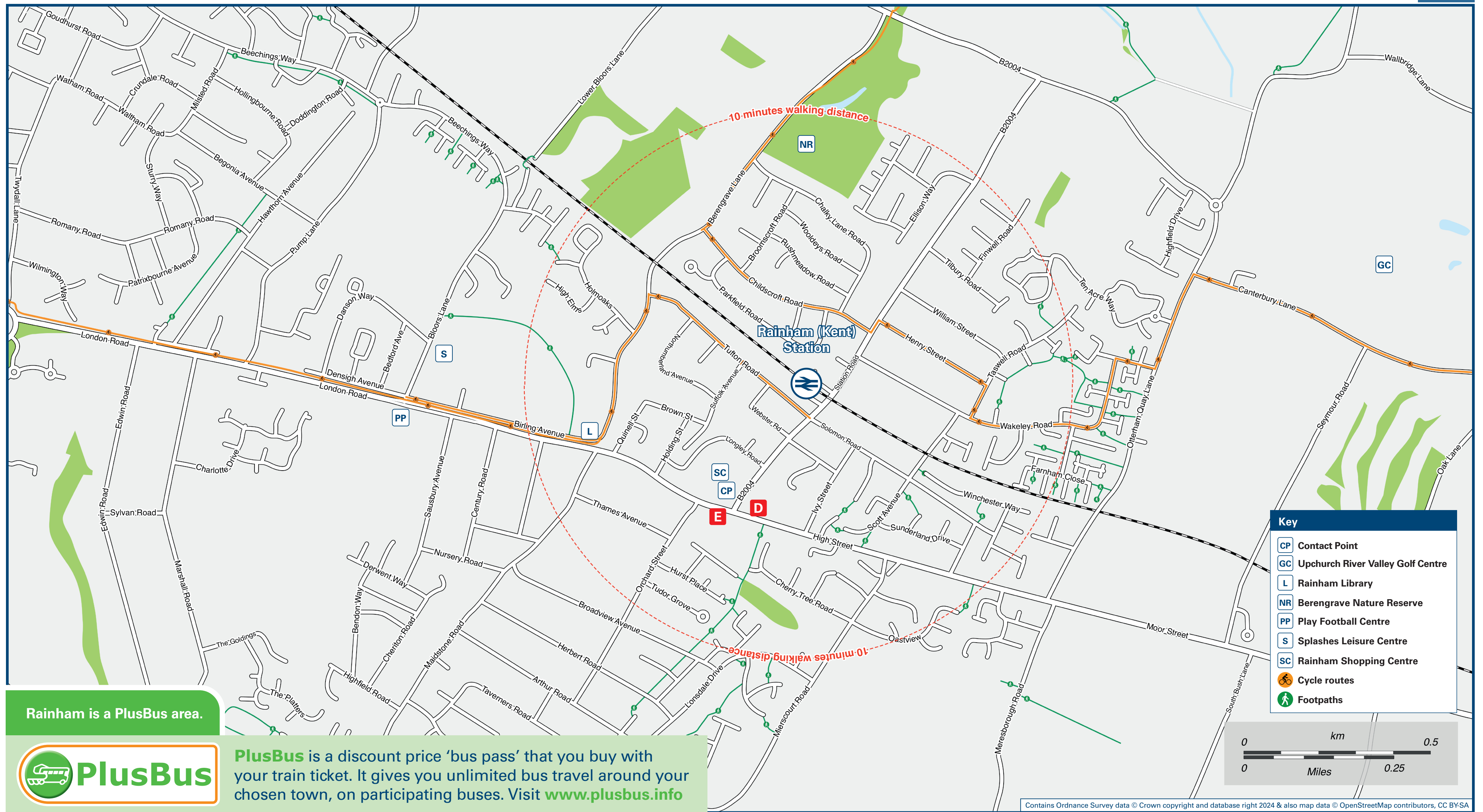




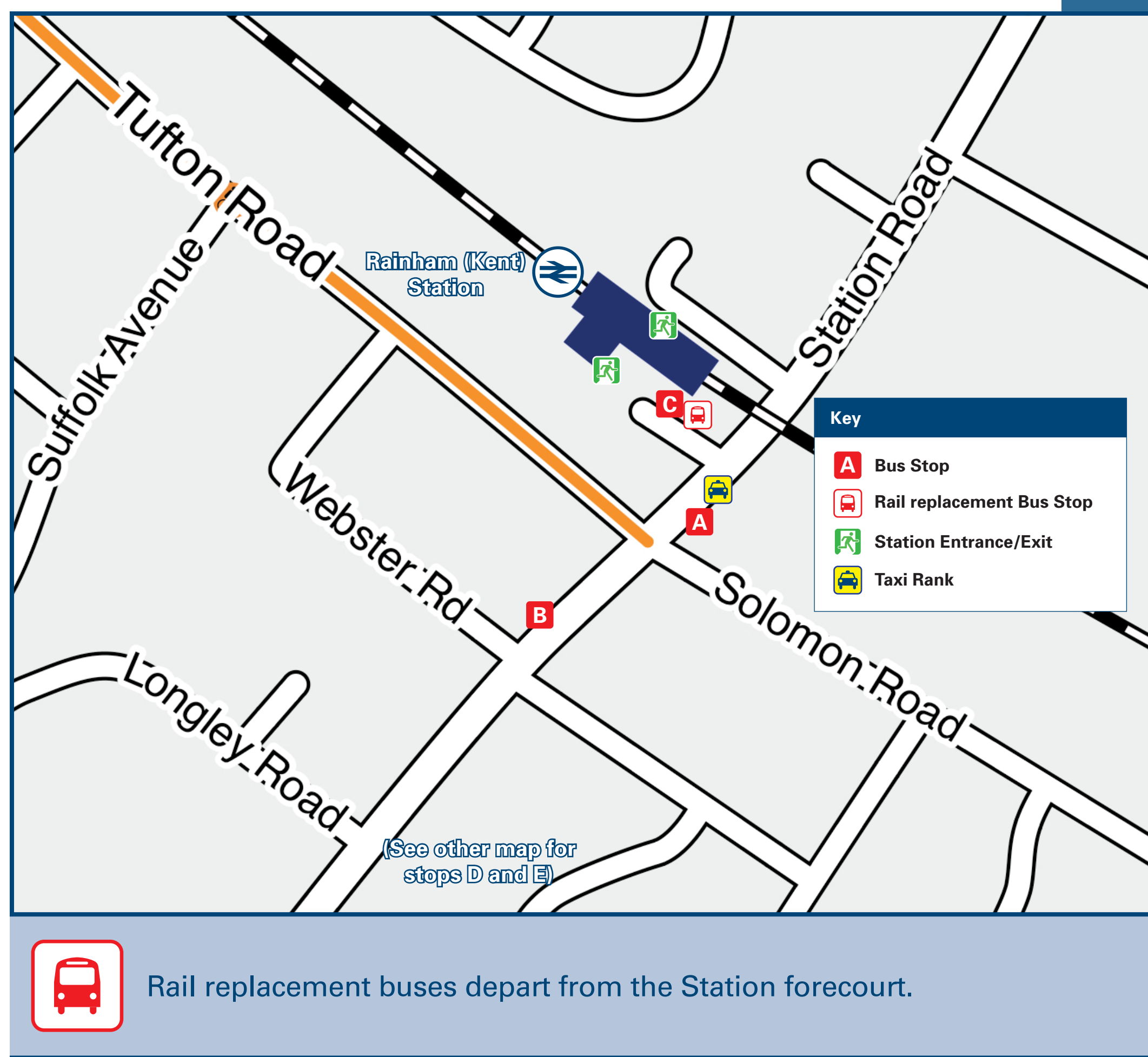

- Bus route 132 operates a high frequency bus service everyday, Mondays to Sundays.
- Direct trains operate to this destination from this station.
- # Bus routes 121 & 783 operate limited Mondays to Fridays service, only. No Saturday or Sunday services.
