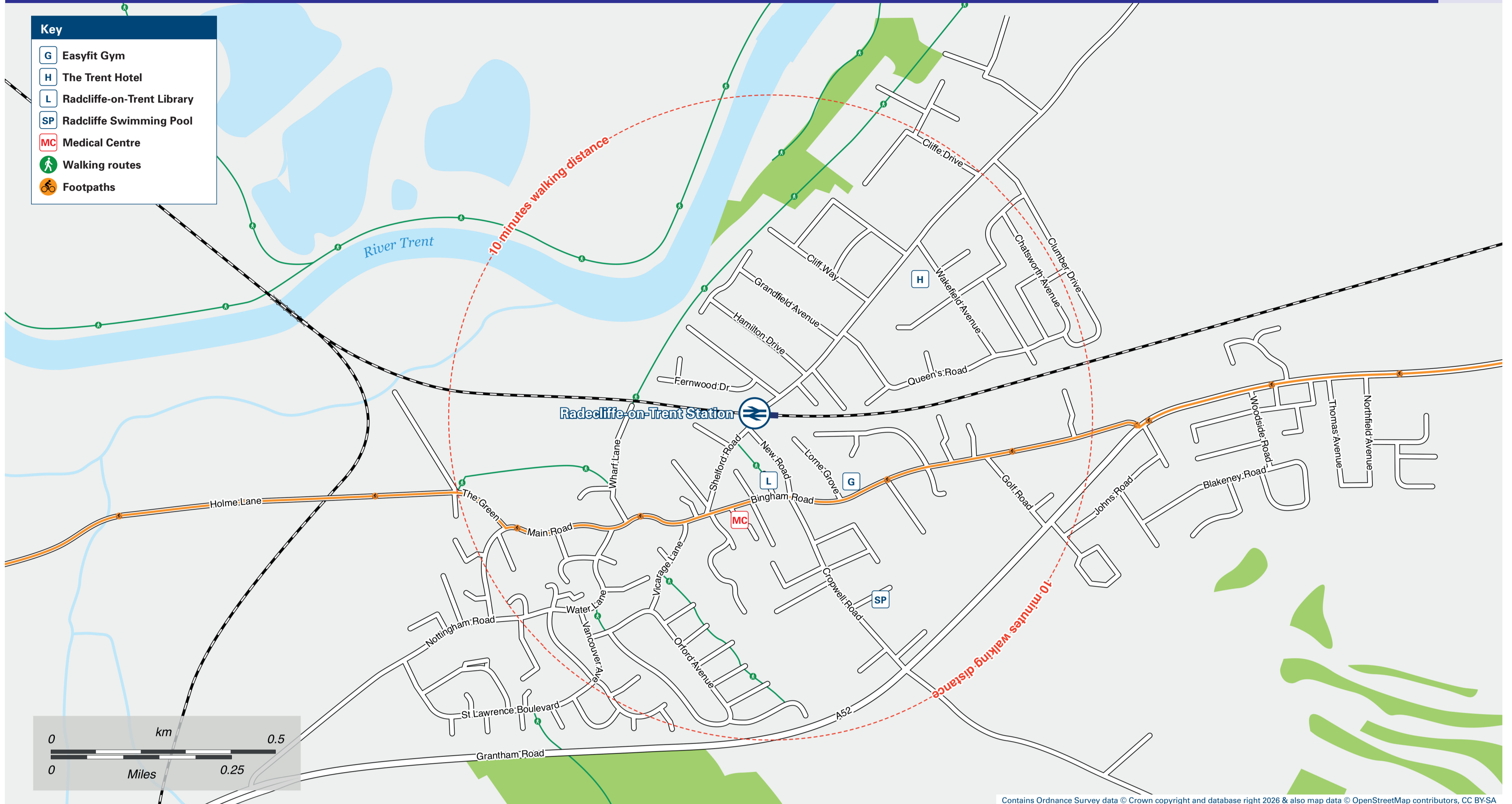

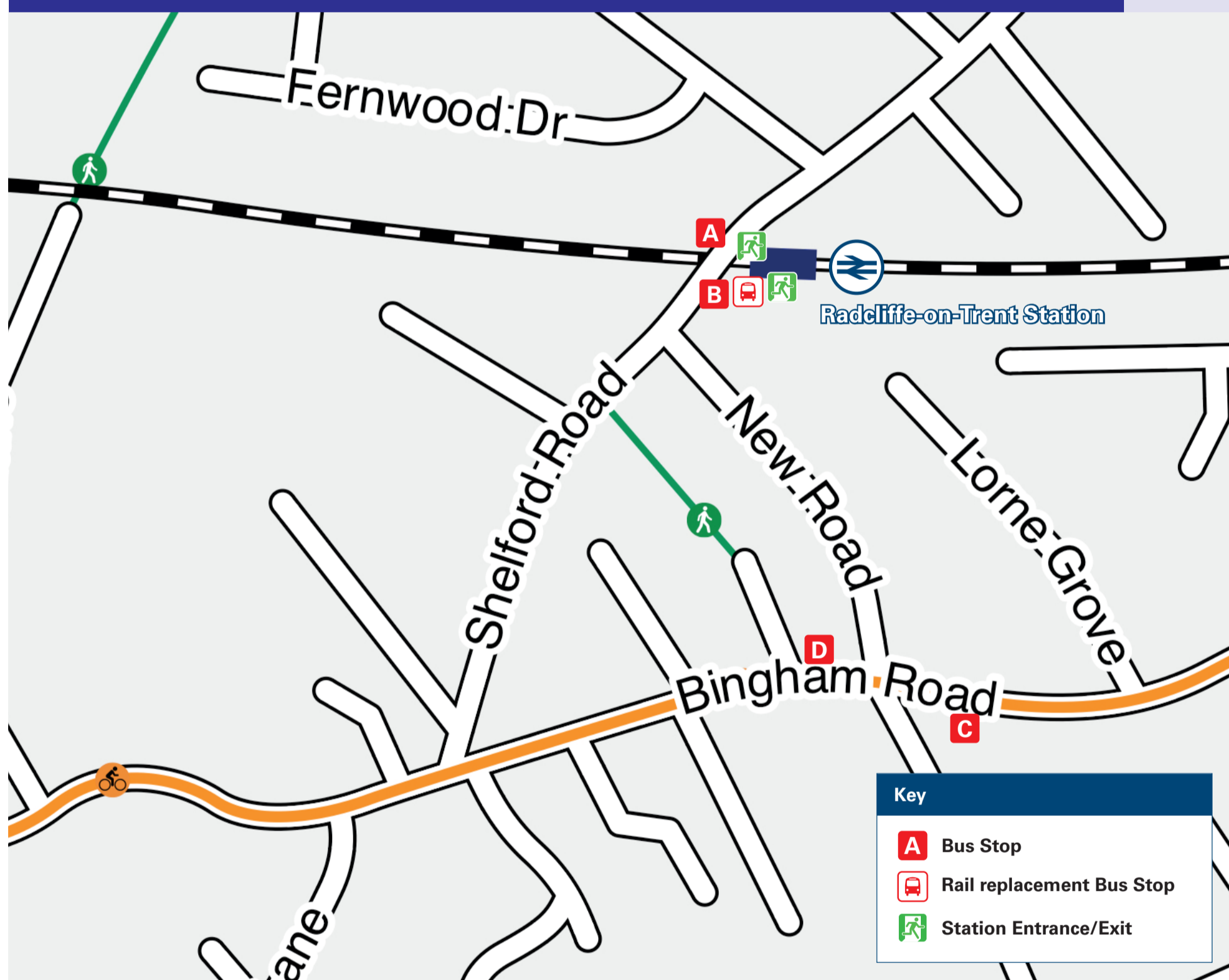
Radcliffe (Notts) Station
