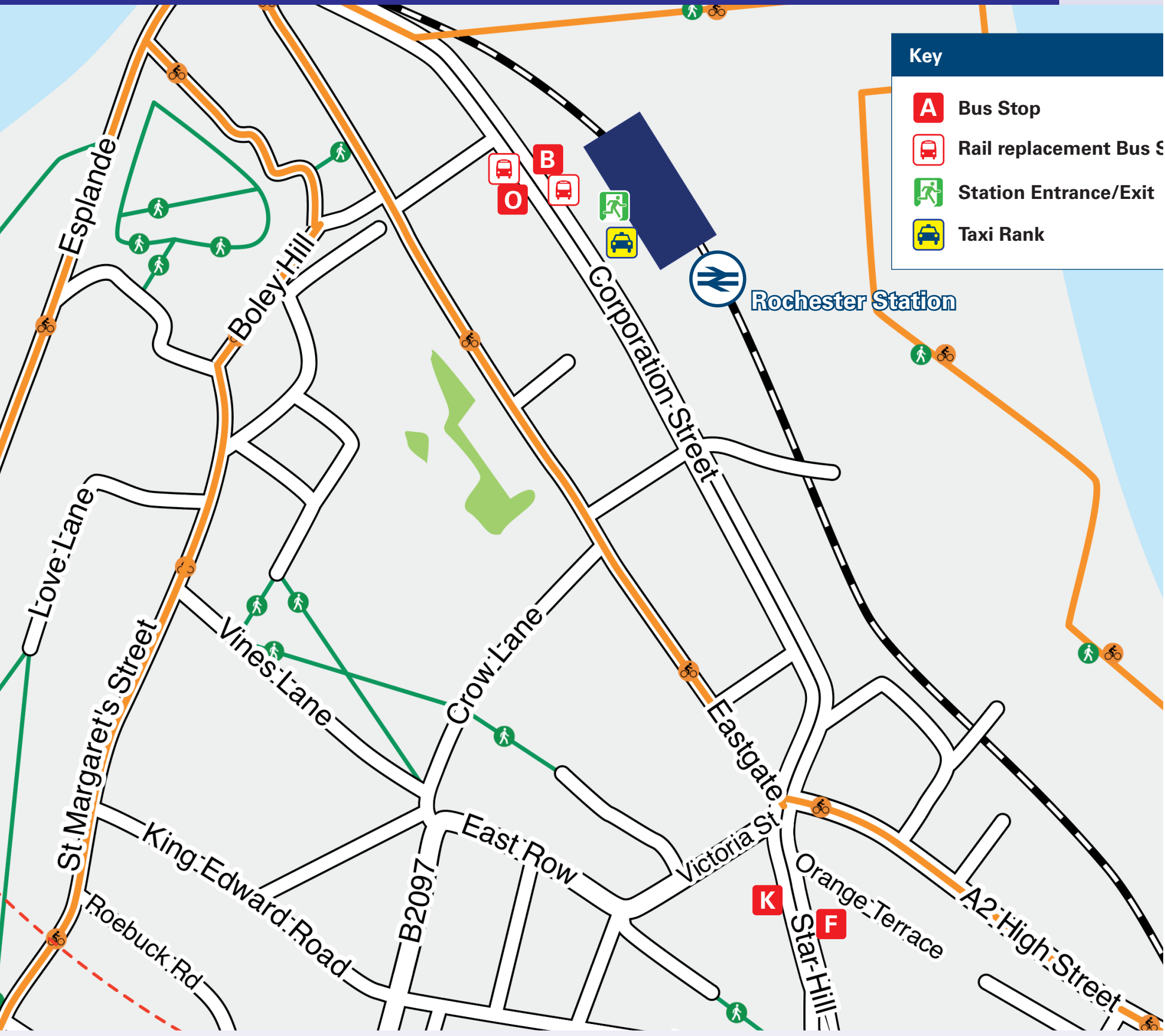

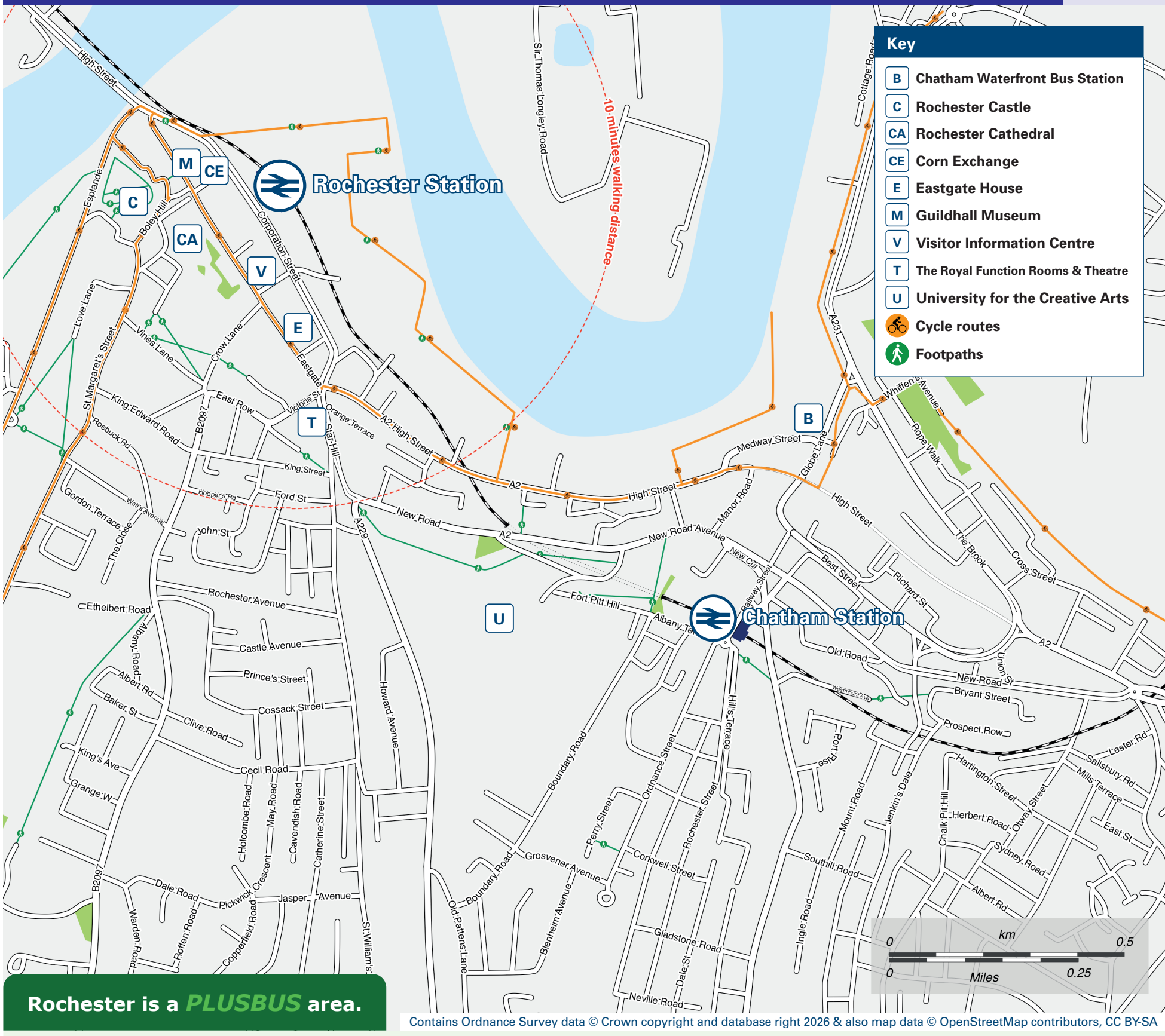


Key
