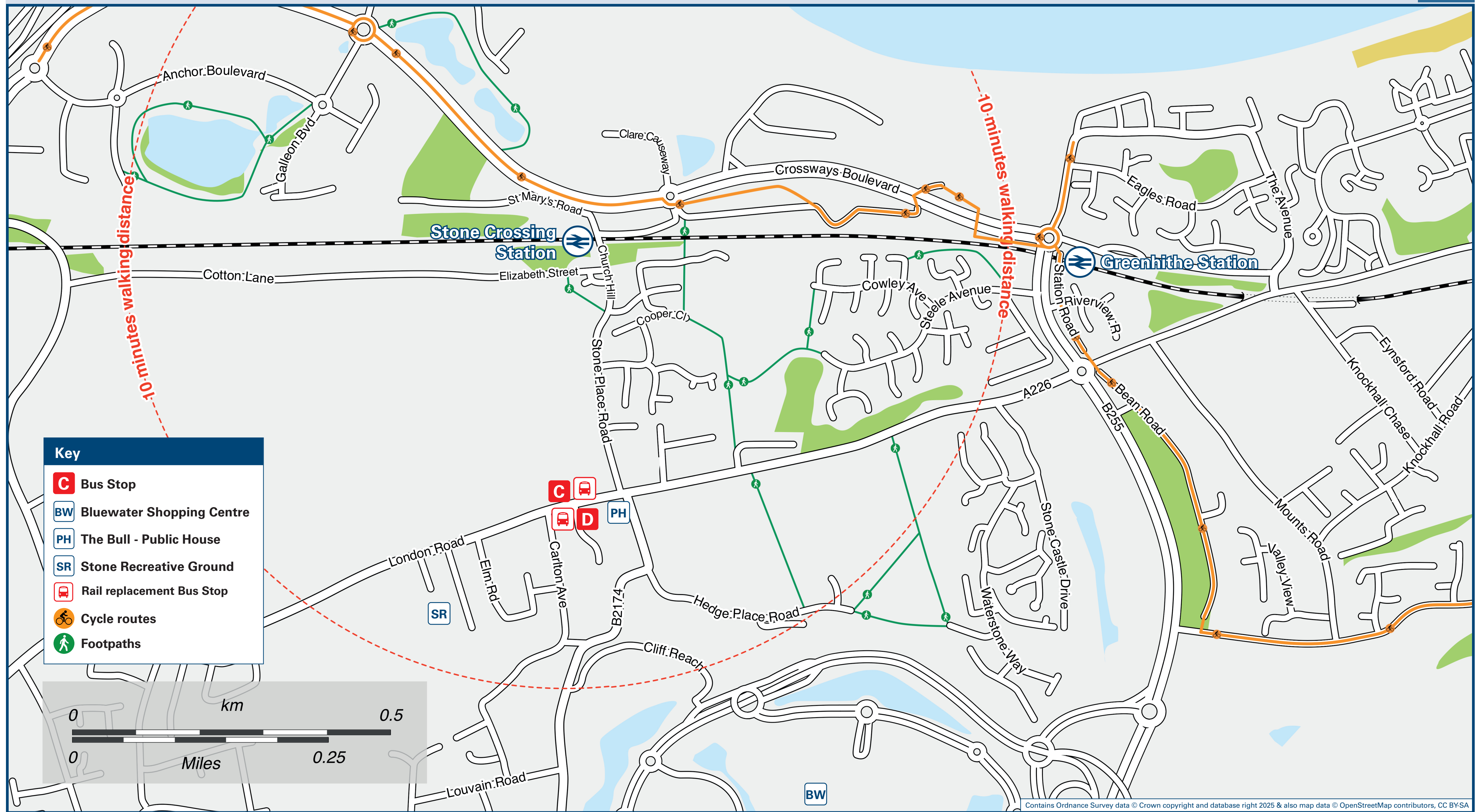




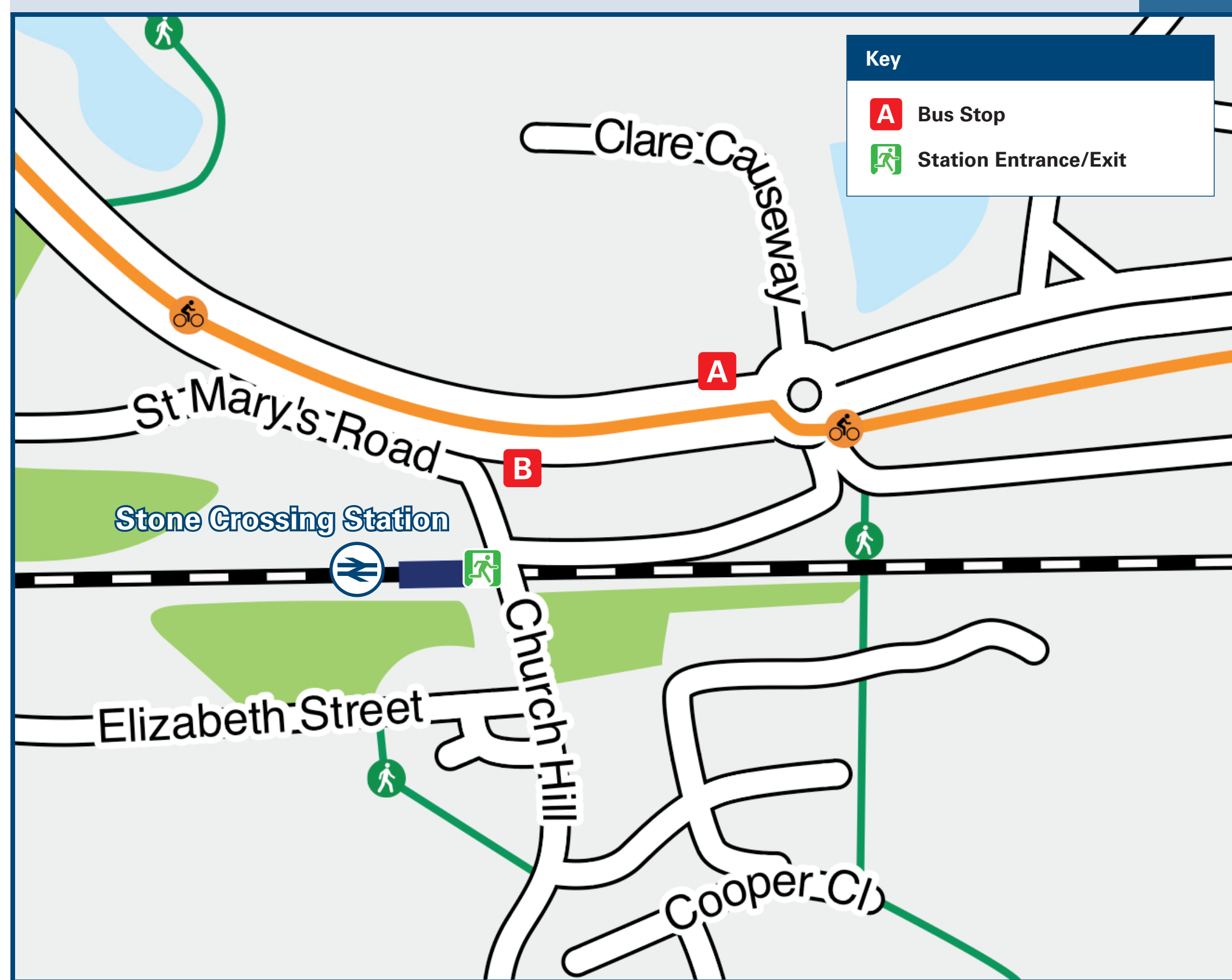
Stone Crossing Station
