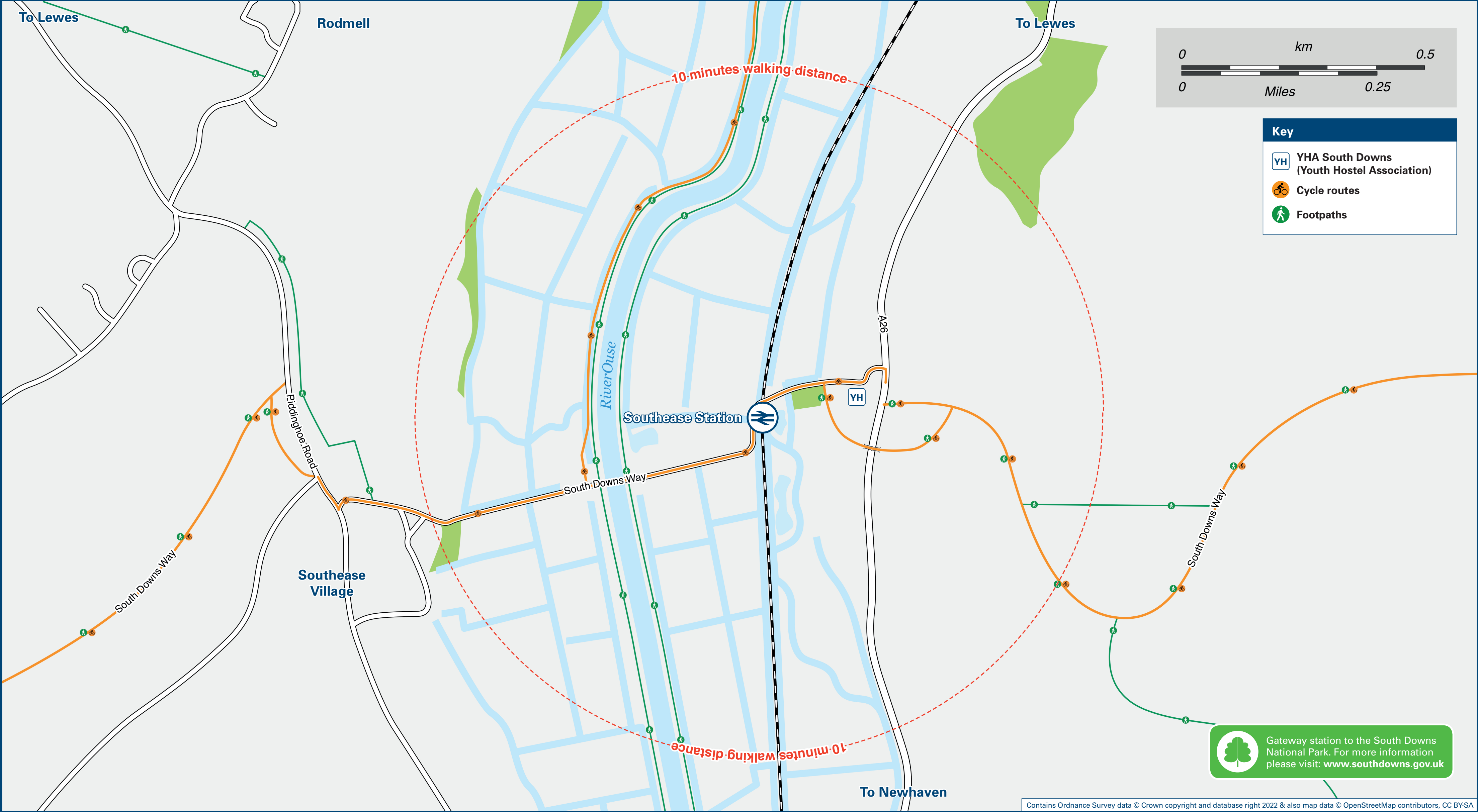

Rail replacement buses depart from the bus stop on the A26, 3 minutes walk from the station; towards Newhaven and Seaford buses depart from an unmarked stop on the A26, 3 minutes walk from the station.

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING SOUTHEASE RAILWAY STATION

The nearest bus stops for local buses are in Southease Village (Swanborough Hollow/Piddinghoe Road), a 15 minutes walk from this station, please see Local area map for bus stop location:

Bus route 123 operates Mondays to Saturdays (except Bank Holidays) from stop **A** to Piddinghoe and Newhaven (some journeys extended to Denton as bus route 145).

Bus route 123 operates Mondays to Saturdays (except Bank Holidays) from stop **B** to Rodmell, Iford, Kingston and Lewes

Bus route 132 operates Sundays and Bank Holidays only from stop **B** at 09:51 to Rodmell, Iford, Kingston and Lewes.

Bus route 132 operates Sundays and Bank Holidays from stop **A** at 14:27 to Piddinghoe & Newhaven.
