
Onward Travel Information

Notes

Bus services from Sevenoaks railway station:
Bus routes 1, 6 and 8 run Mondays to Saturdays.
Bus routes 3 and 308 run Mondays to Fridays only.
Bus route 401 runs Sundays and Bank Holidays only.

Additional bus services from Sevenoaks town centre bus station:
Bus route 2 runs Mondays to Saturdays to Otford, Shoreham, Eynsford, Farningham and Swanley.
Bus route 5 runs Mondays to Saturdays to Sevenoaks Weald, Hildenborough and Tonbridge.
Bus route 402 runs every 30 minutes Mondays to Saturdays to Hildenborough, Tonbridge, Southborough and Tunbridge Wells.

go2 is a On Demand Responsive bus service for Sevenoaks District and operates Mondays to Saturdays from 6:00am to 7:00pm and MUST be booked. To book a journey with go2 get the go2 App download with the App Store or Google Play for your phone or make bookings Mondays to Fridays between 9:00am and 5:00pm by calling 01732 463 964 (outside these hours bookings must be made via the App).
