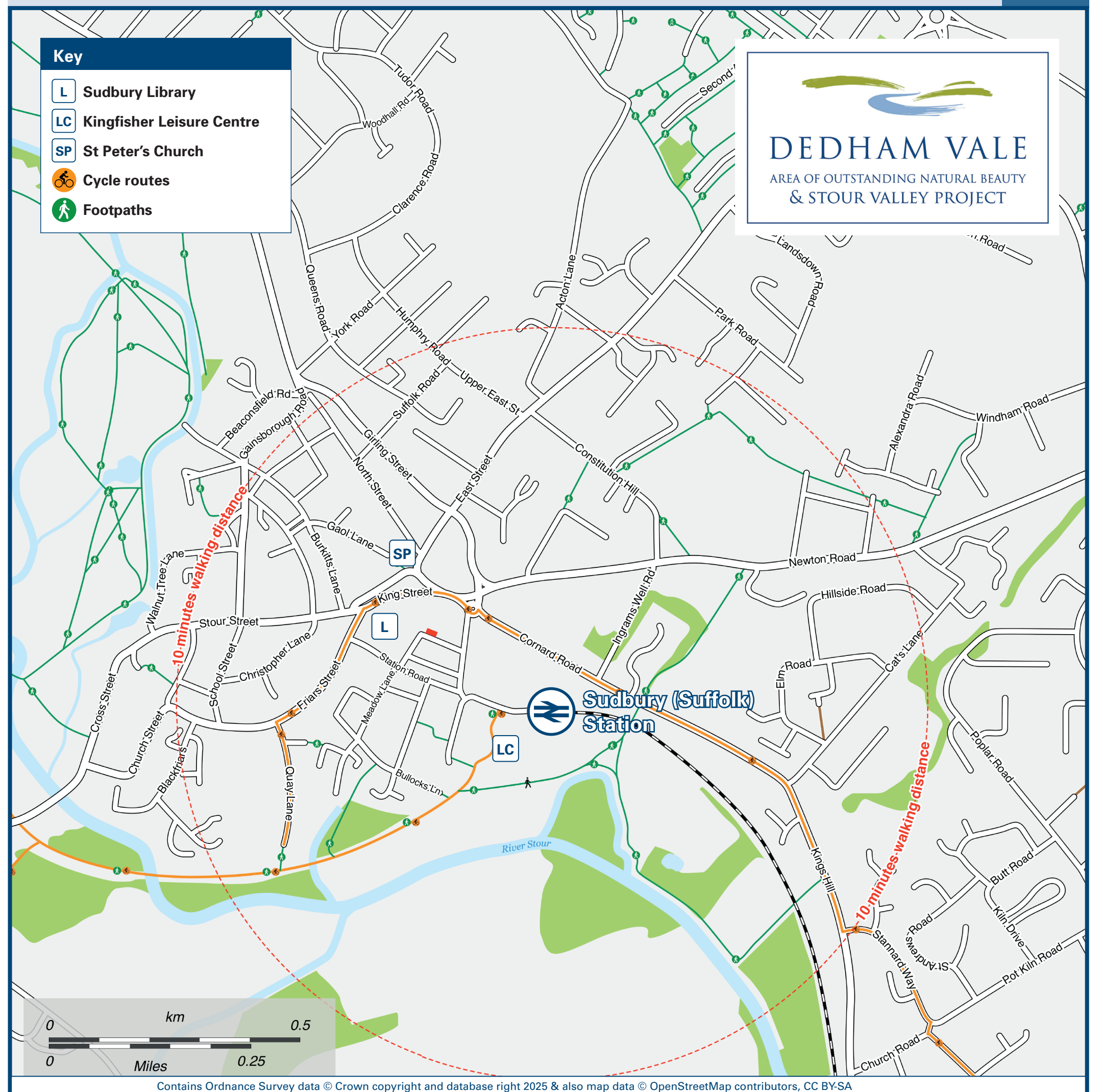




BUS STOP
