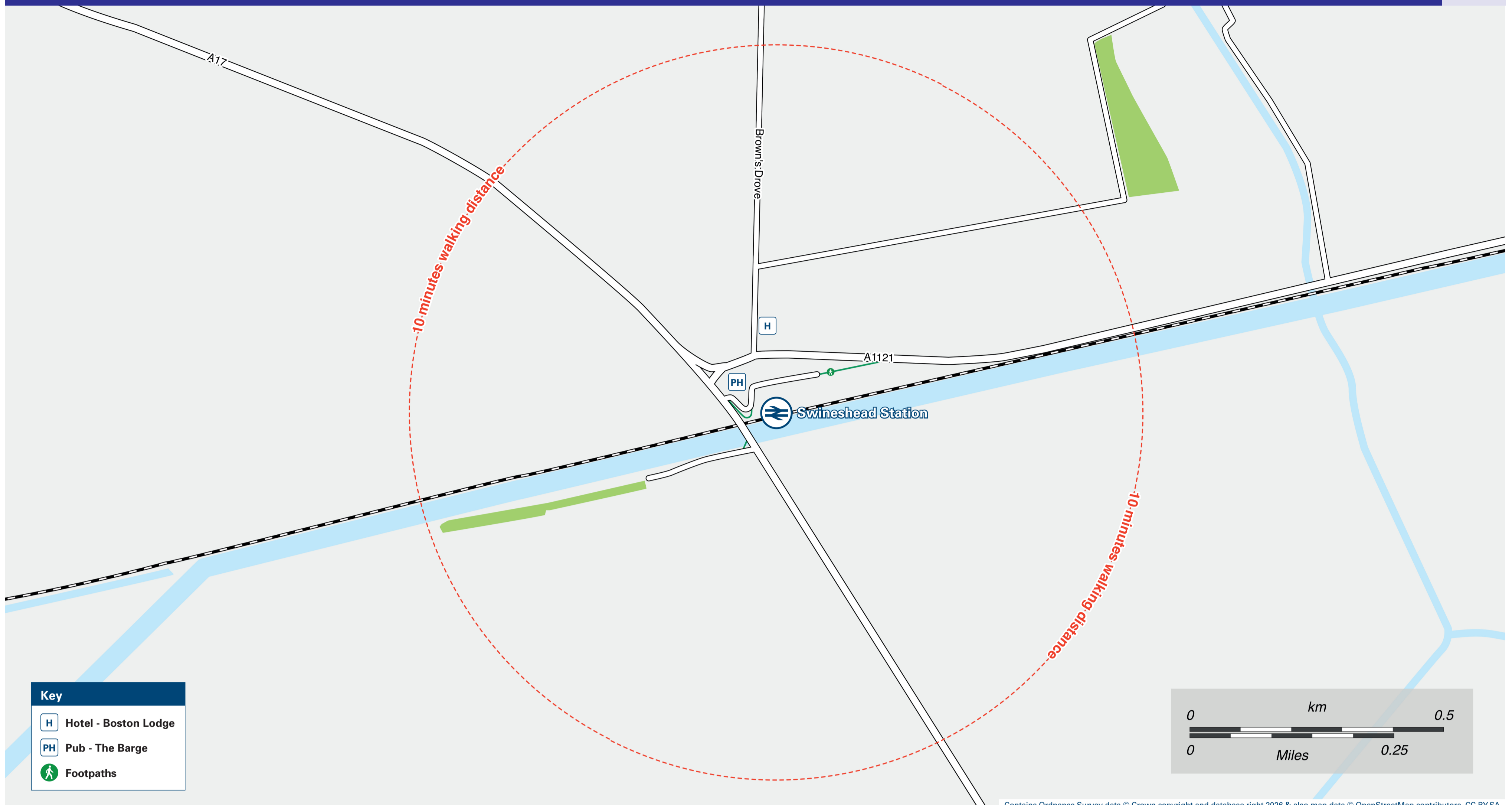

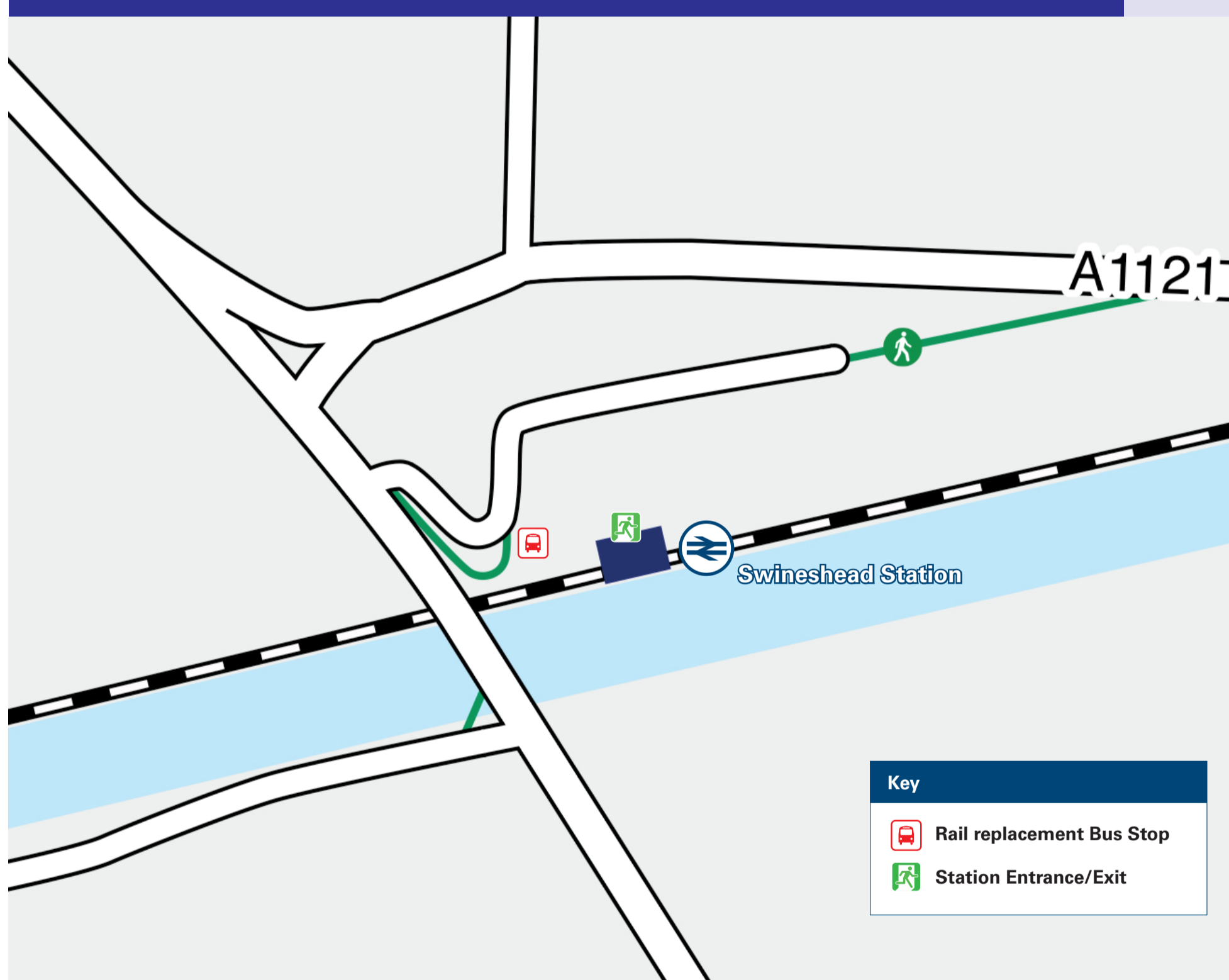
## Swineshead Station

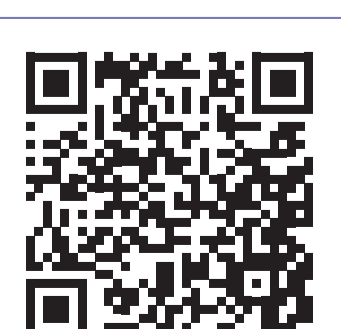
