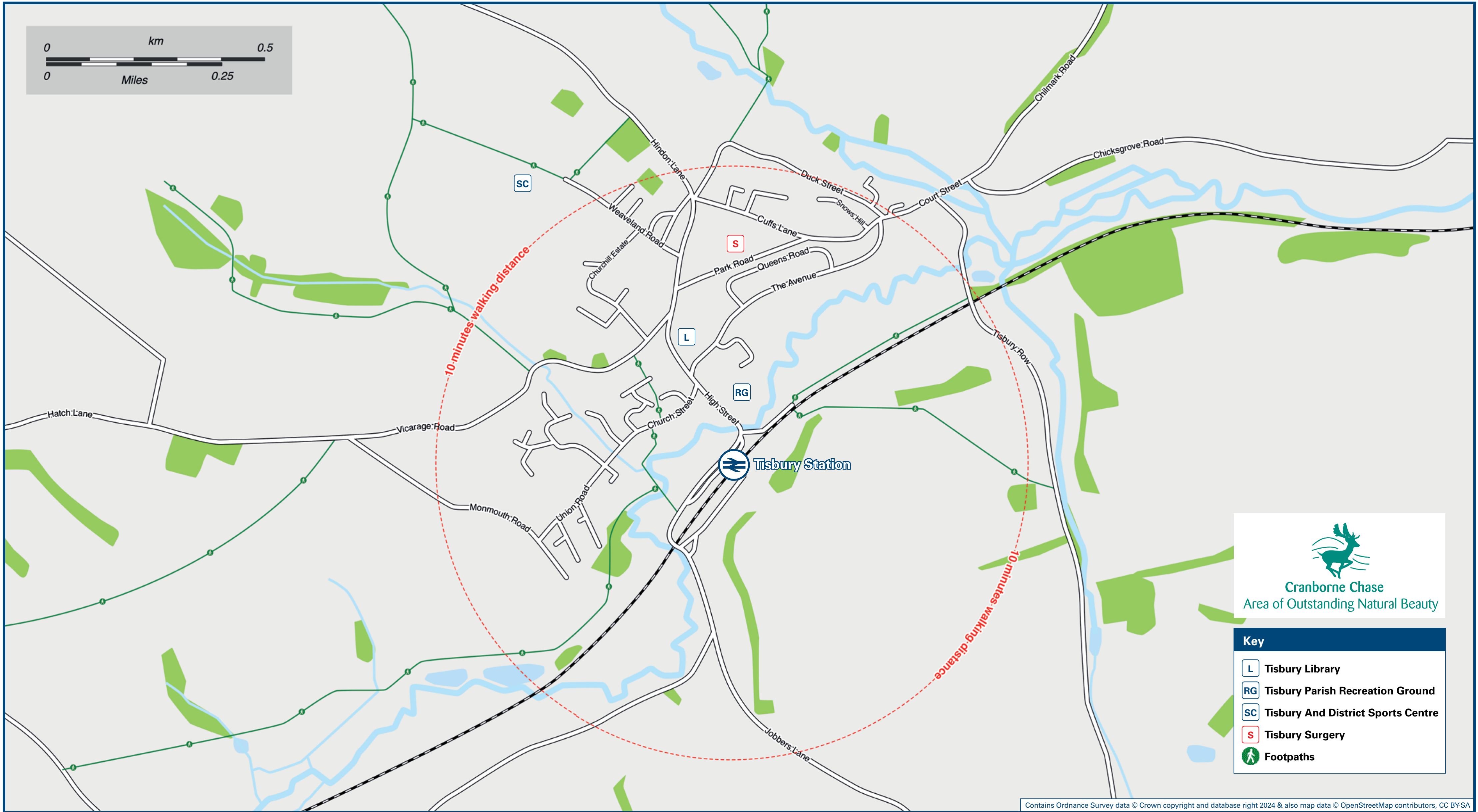




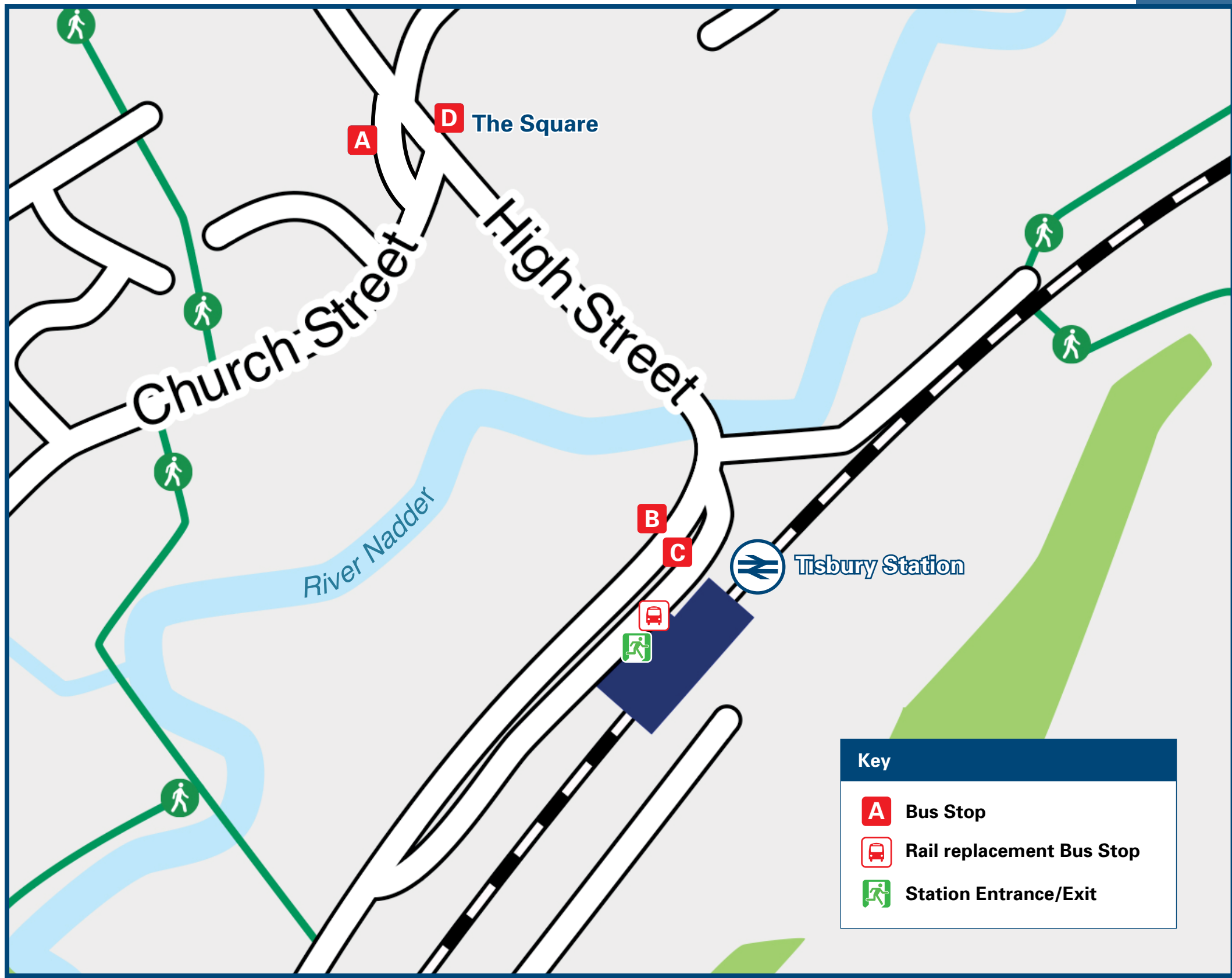
Tisbury Station
