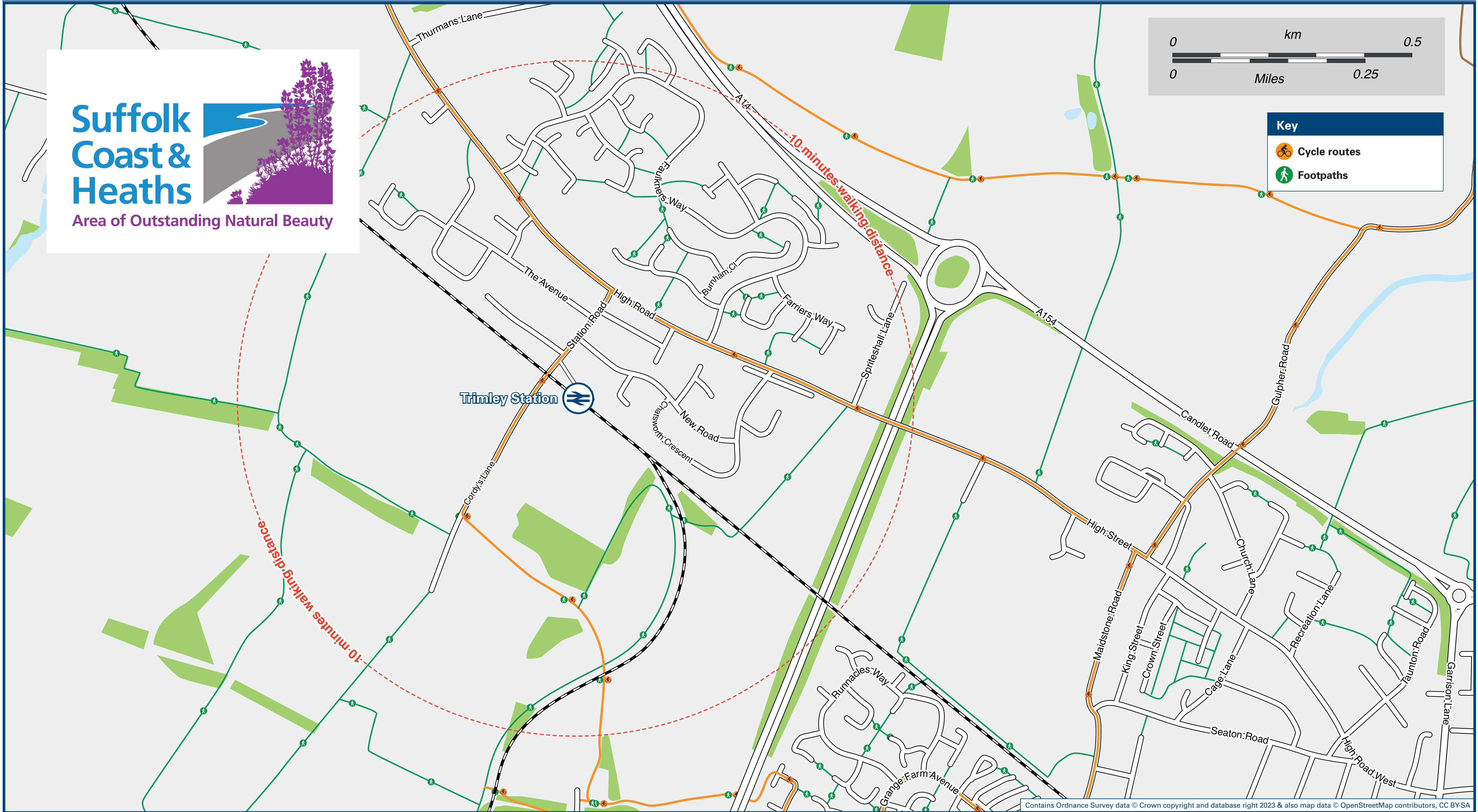




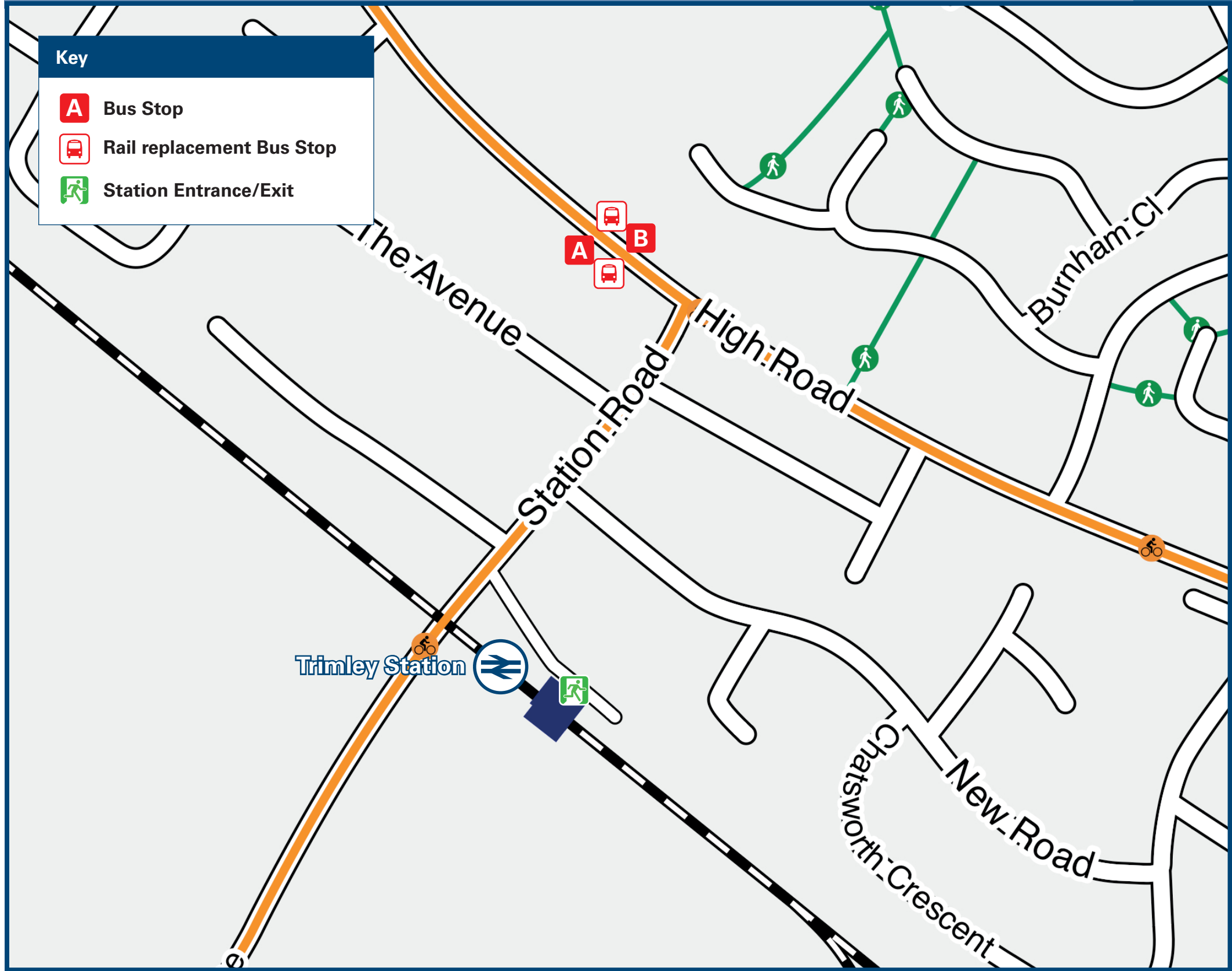
Trimley Station
