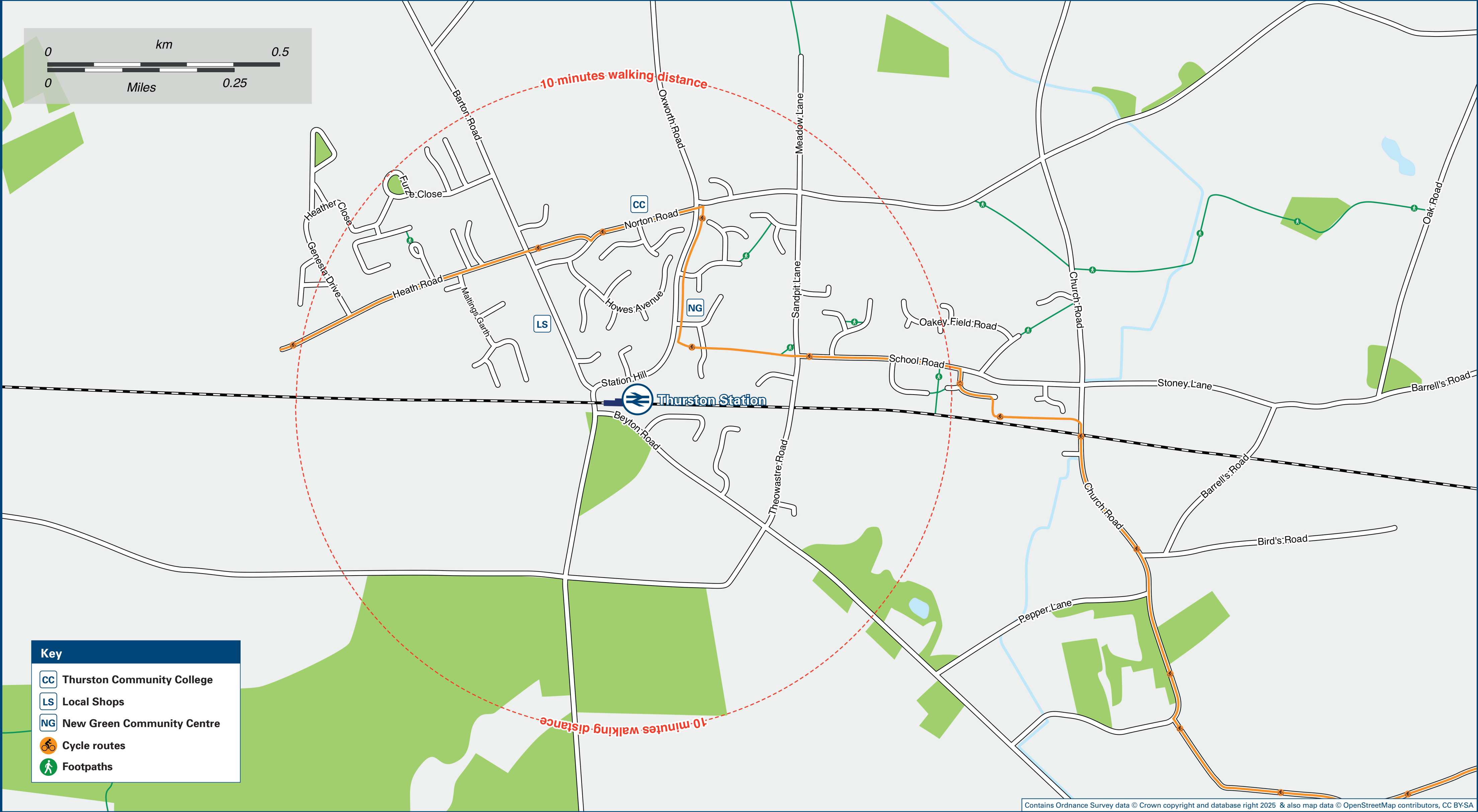




Thurston Station
