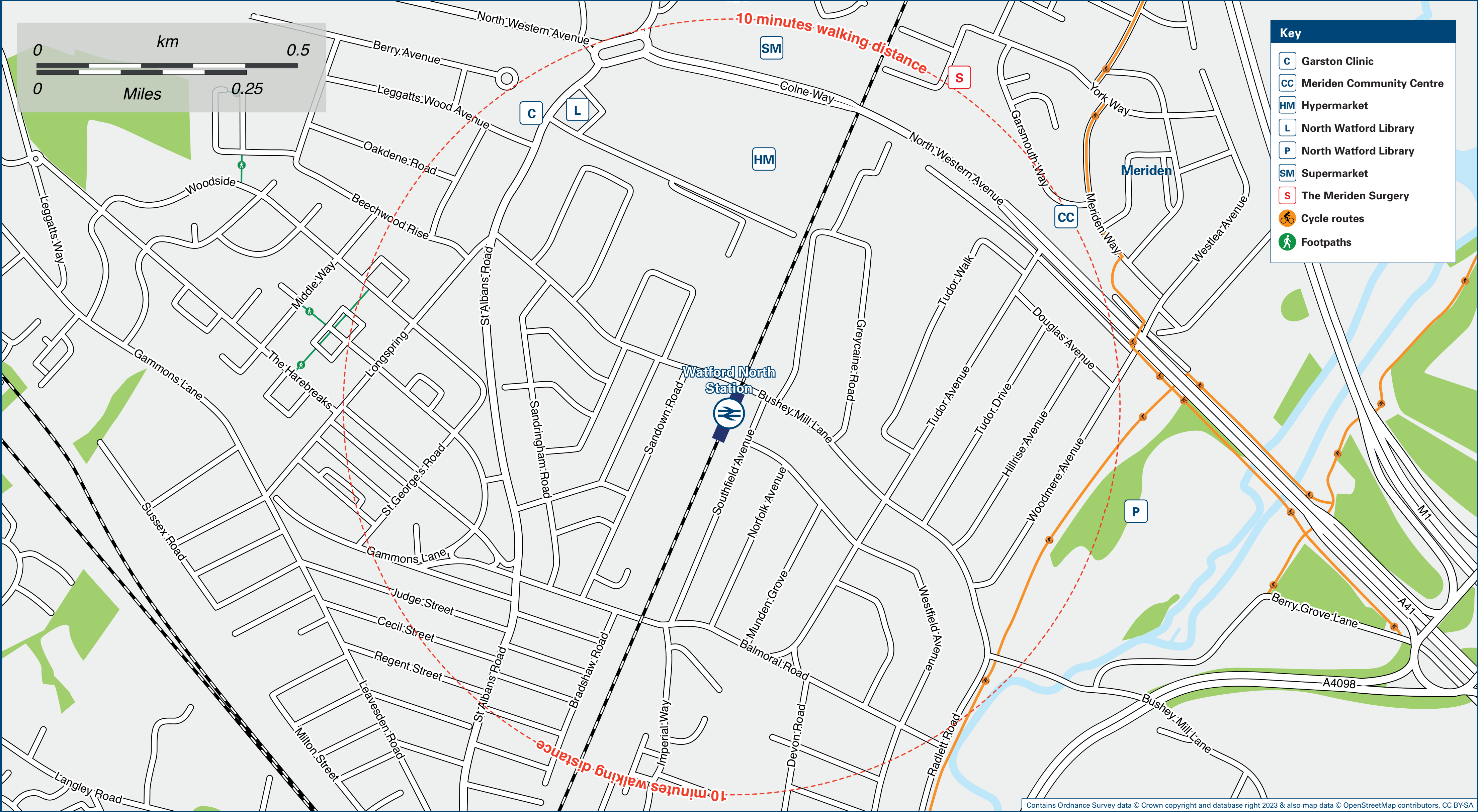




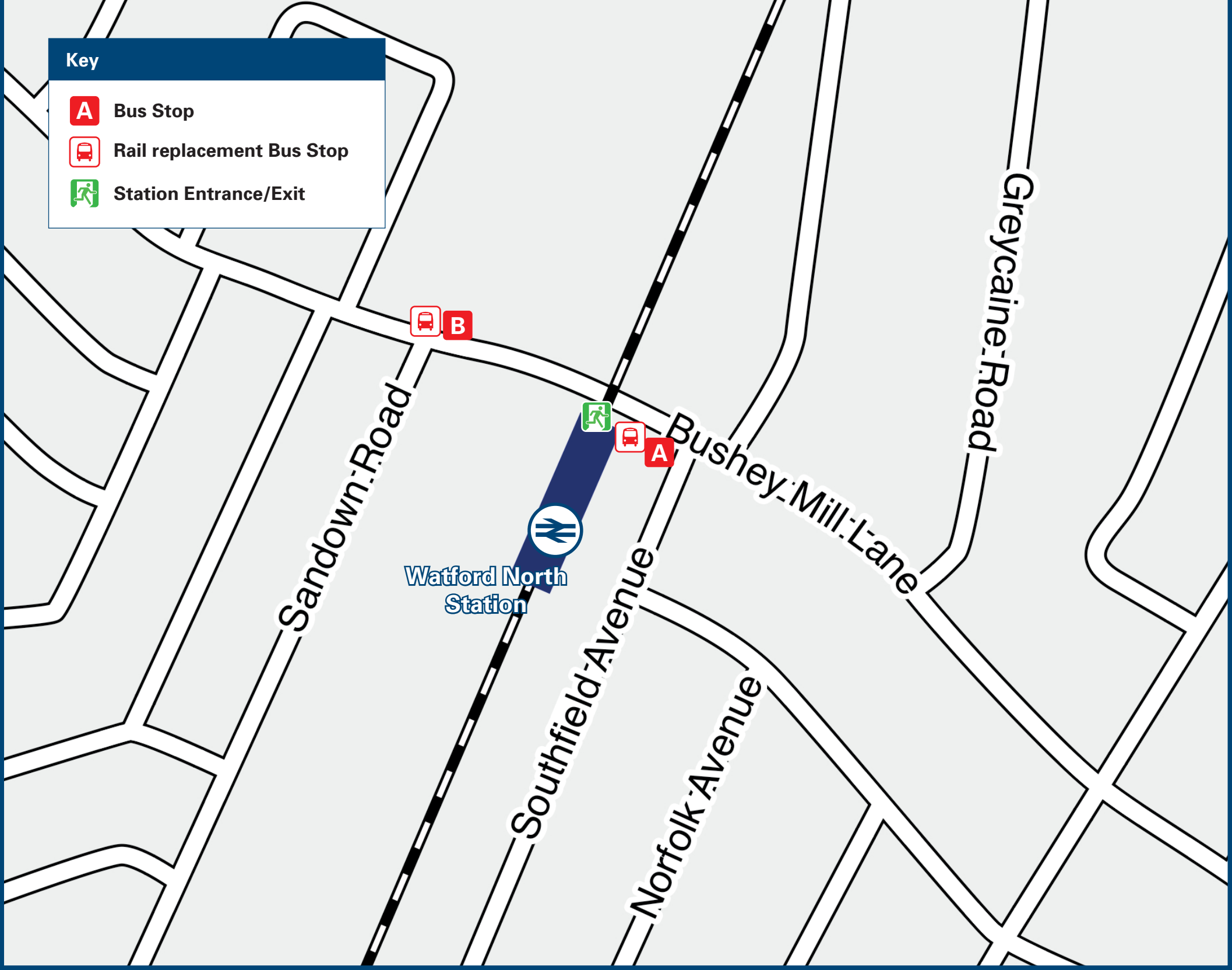
Watford North Station
