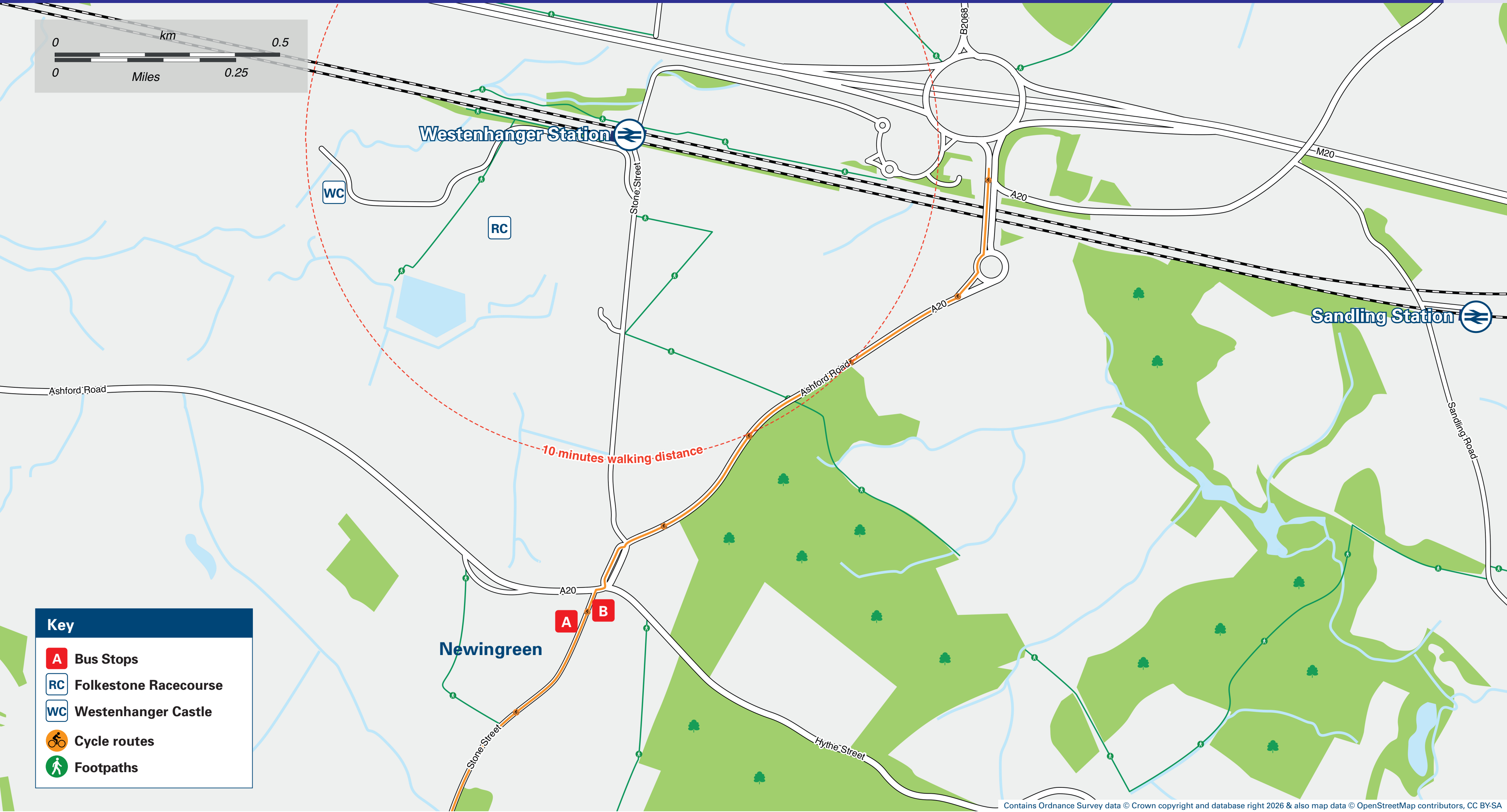




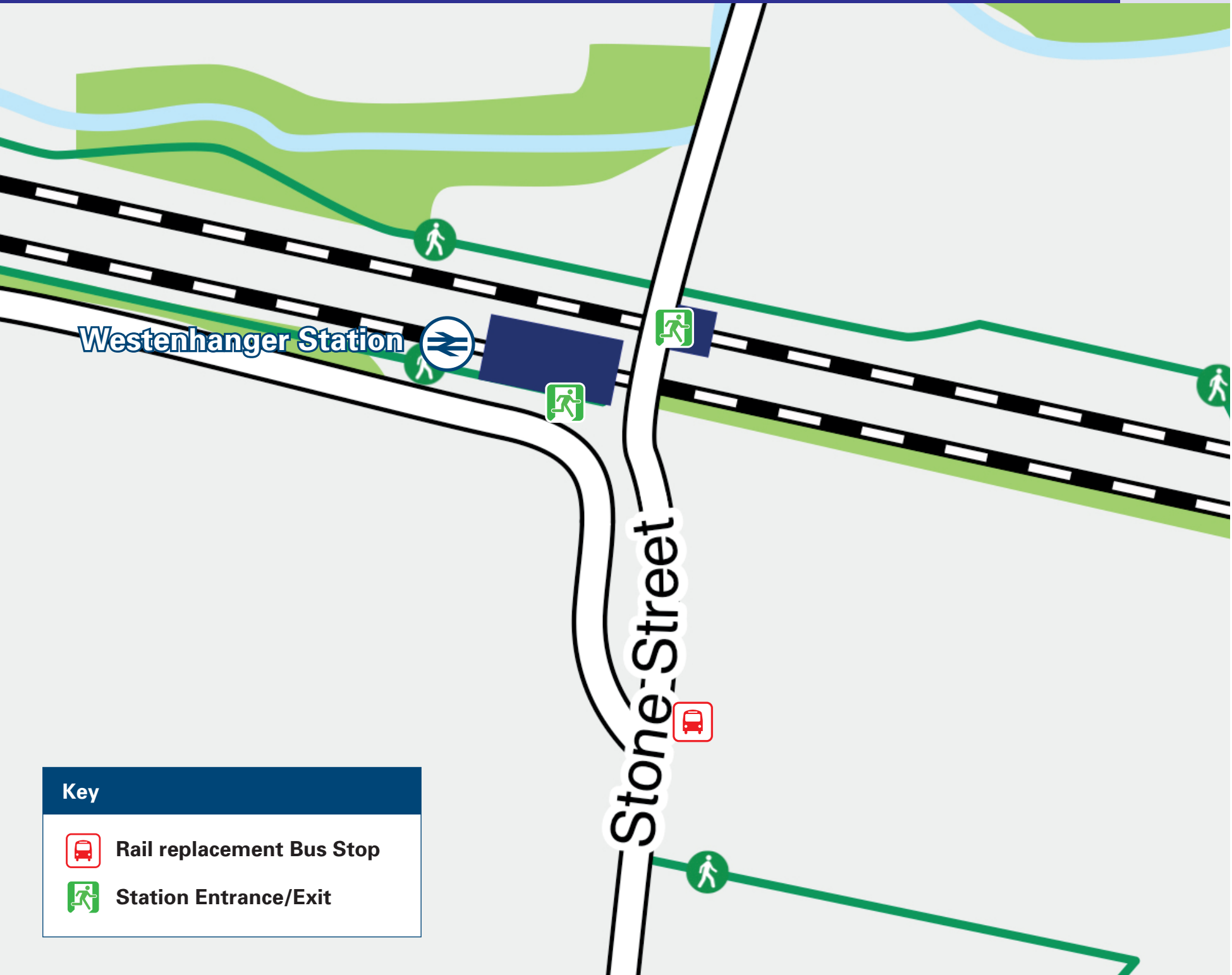

Rail replacement mini buses depart from outside the station. Westenhanger is usually served by a minibus between Sandling and Westenhanger. If a full size bus needs to stop at Westenhanger, these will stop at the top of Stone Street. A full size bus will be shown in the Journey Planner as having a destination of Ashford or Dover. THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING WESTENHANGER RAILWAY STATION

The nearest bus stops to Westenhanger station are located at Newingreen, a 16-20 minutes walk from this station, please see Local area map:

Bus route 10 runs Mondays to Saturdays, only, from bus stop **A** to Sandling station, Hythe and Folkestone. No Sundays services.

Bus route 10 runs on Mondays to Saturdays, only, from bus stop **B** to Lympne, Sellindge, Brabourne Lees and Ashford. No Sundays services.
