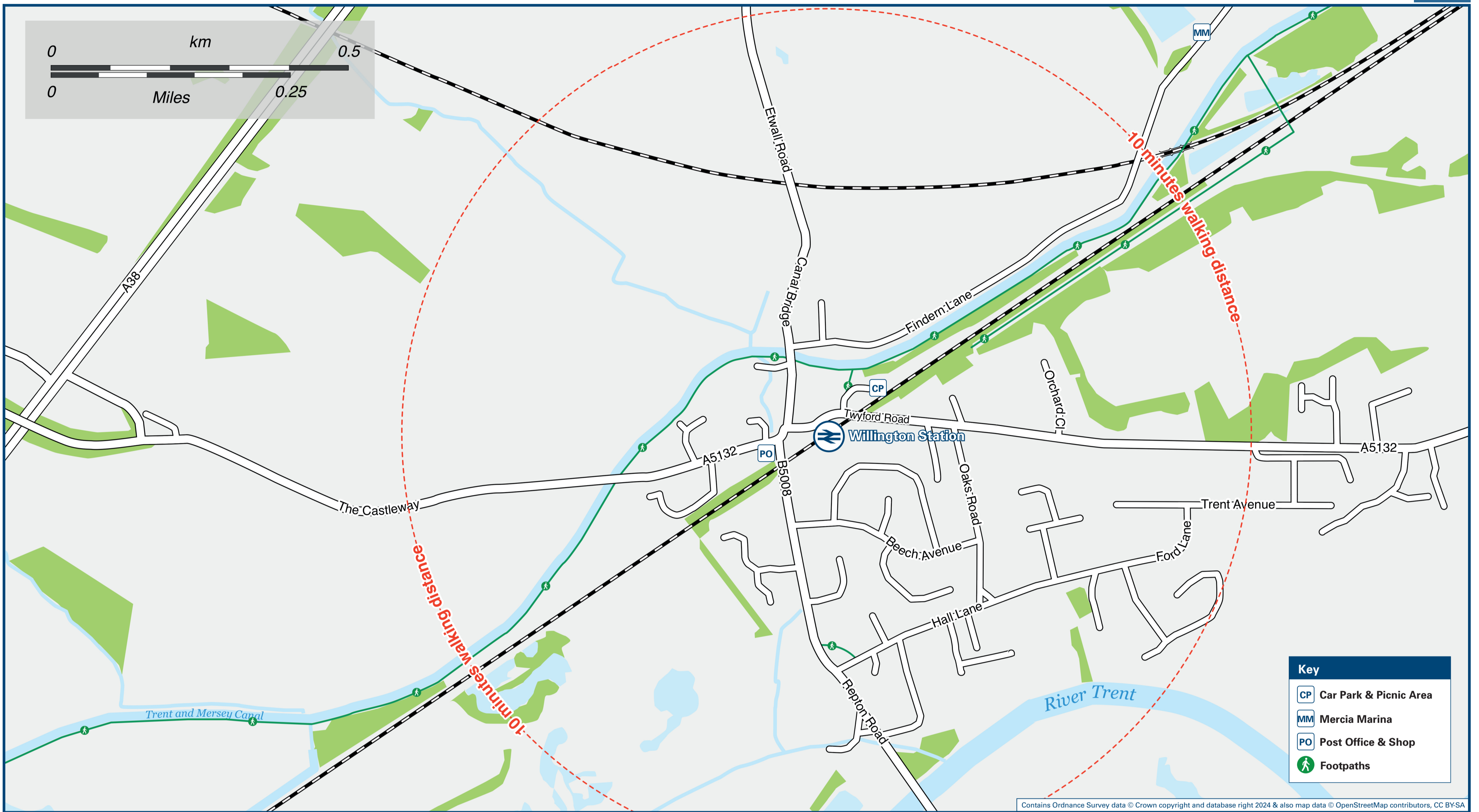




Willington Station
