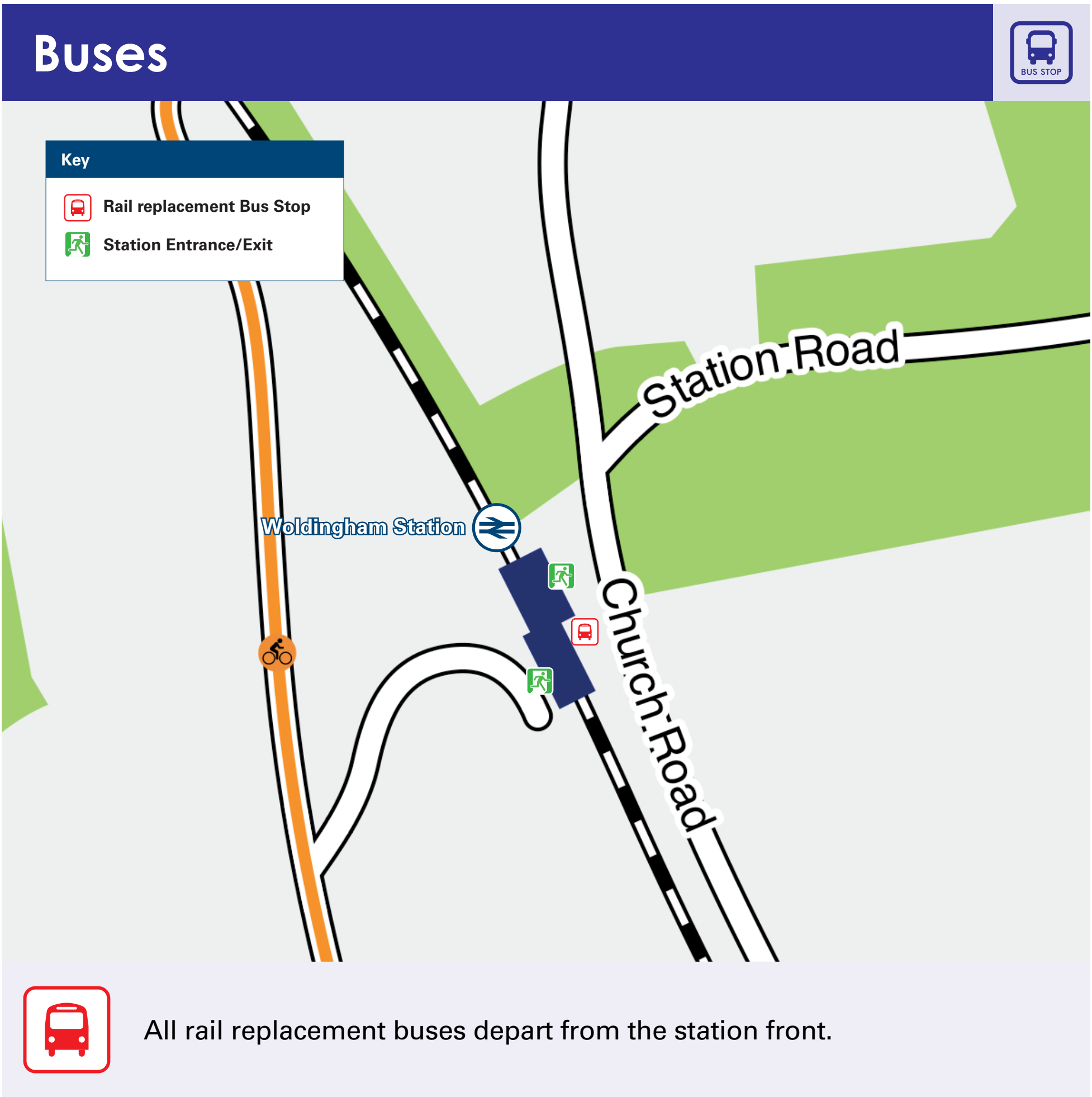
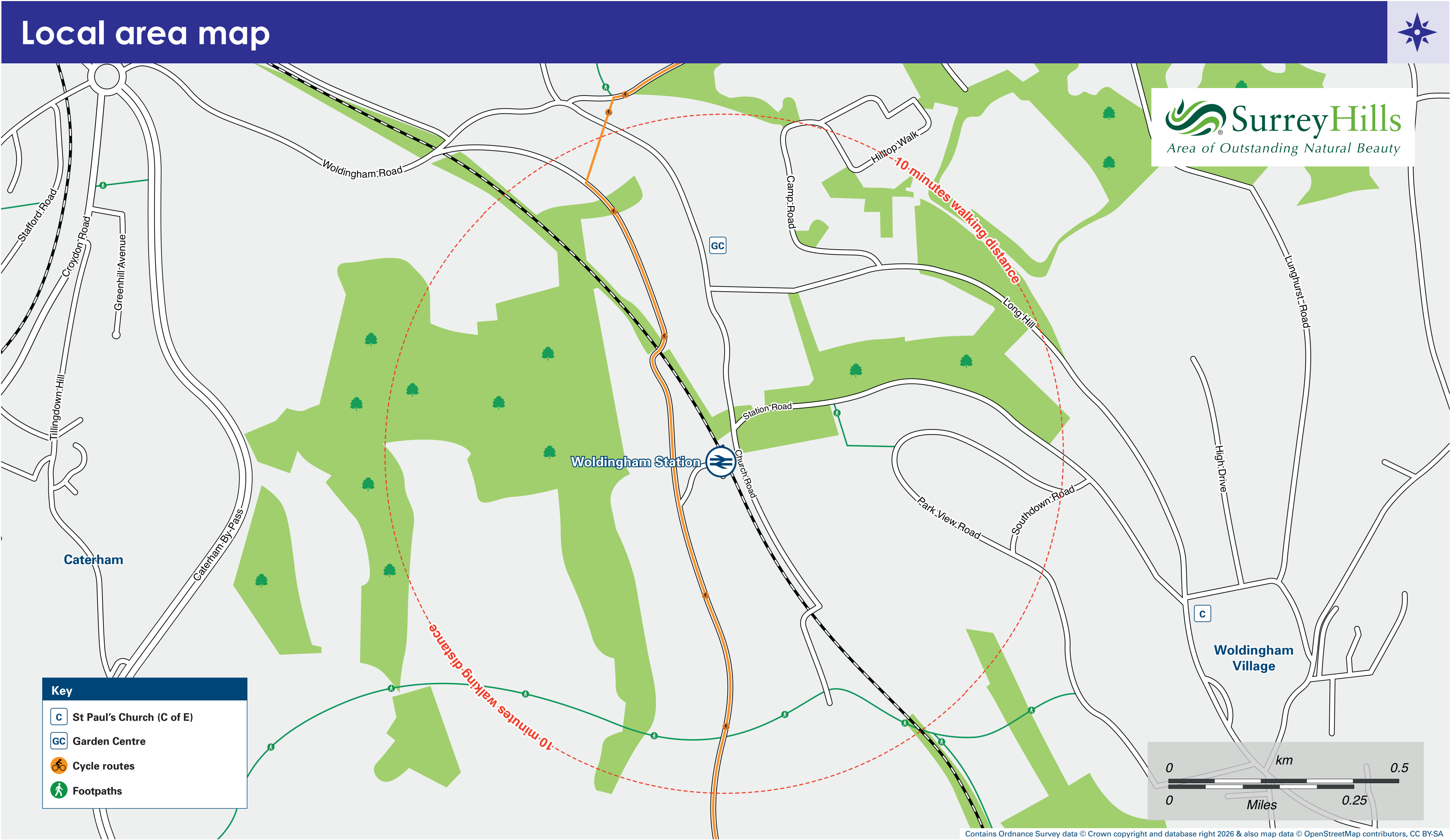




Onward Travel Information

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING WOLDINGHAM STATION

It's a 25 to 30 minutes walk from this station to Woldingham village centre, or phone for a taxi, or pre-book a journey with Surrey Connect (see below):

Surrey Connect is an On Demand bus service for Tandridge. To register and book you simply need an email address or phone number. To book online go to www.surreyconnect.org.uk via the App "Surrey Connect" available from App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android). To book by phone call 01883 701 278 (Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm). The travel times are: Monday to Friday 7am to 7pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm (no service on Sundays or Bank Holidays).
