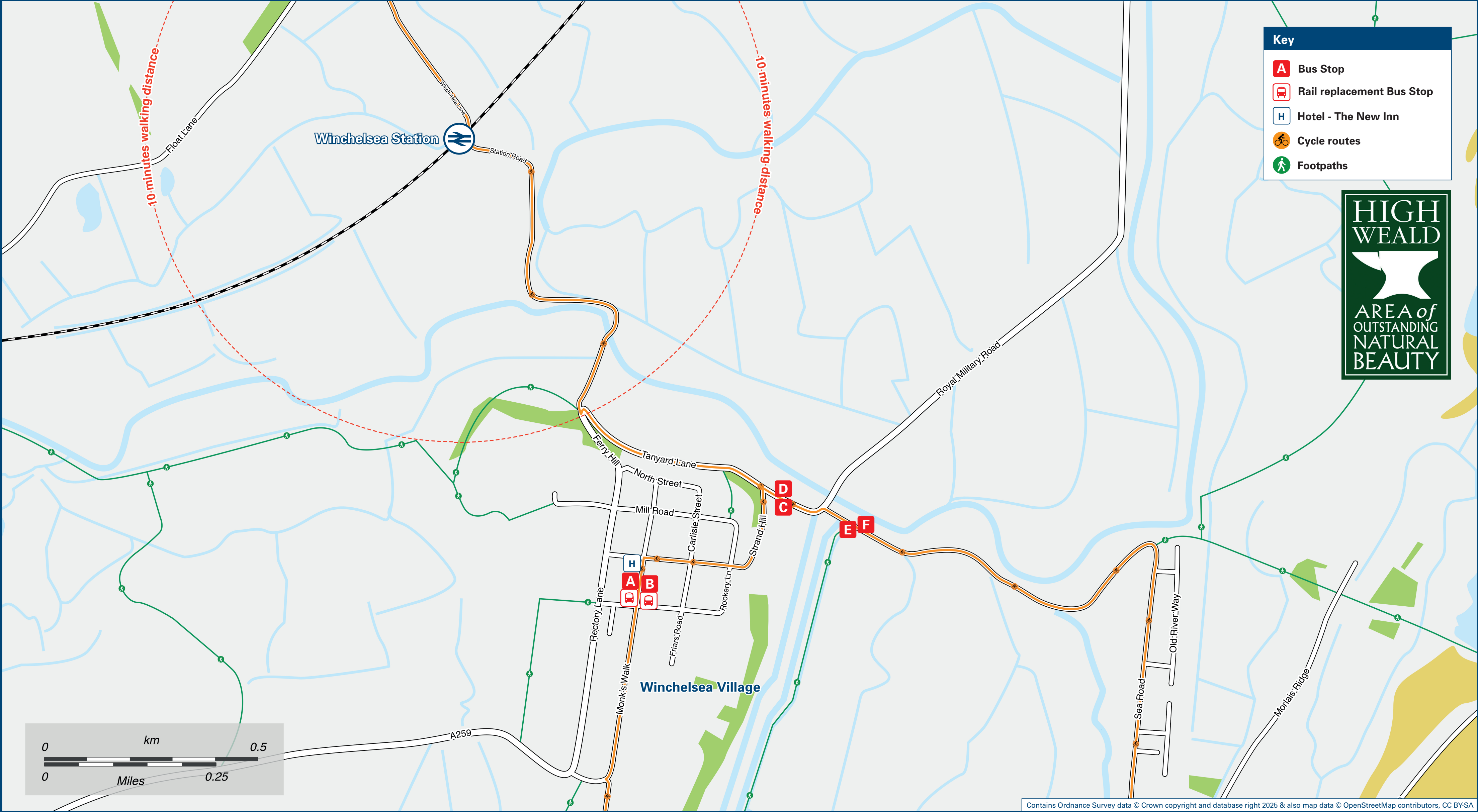




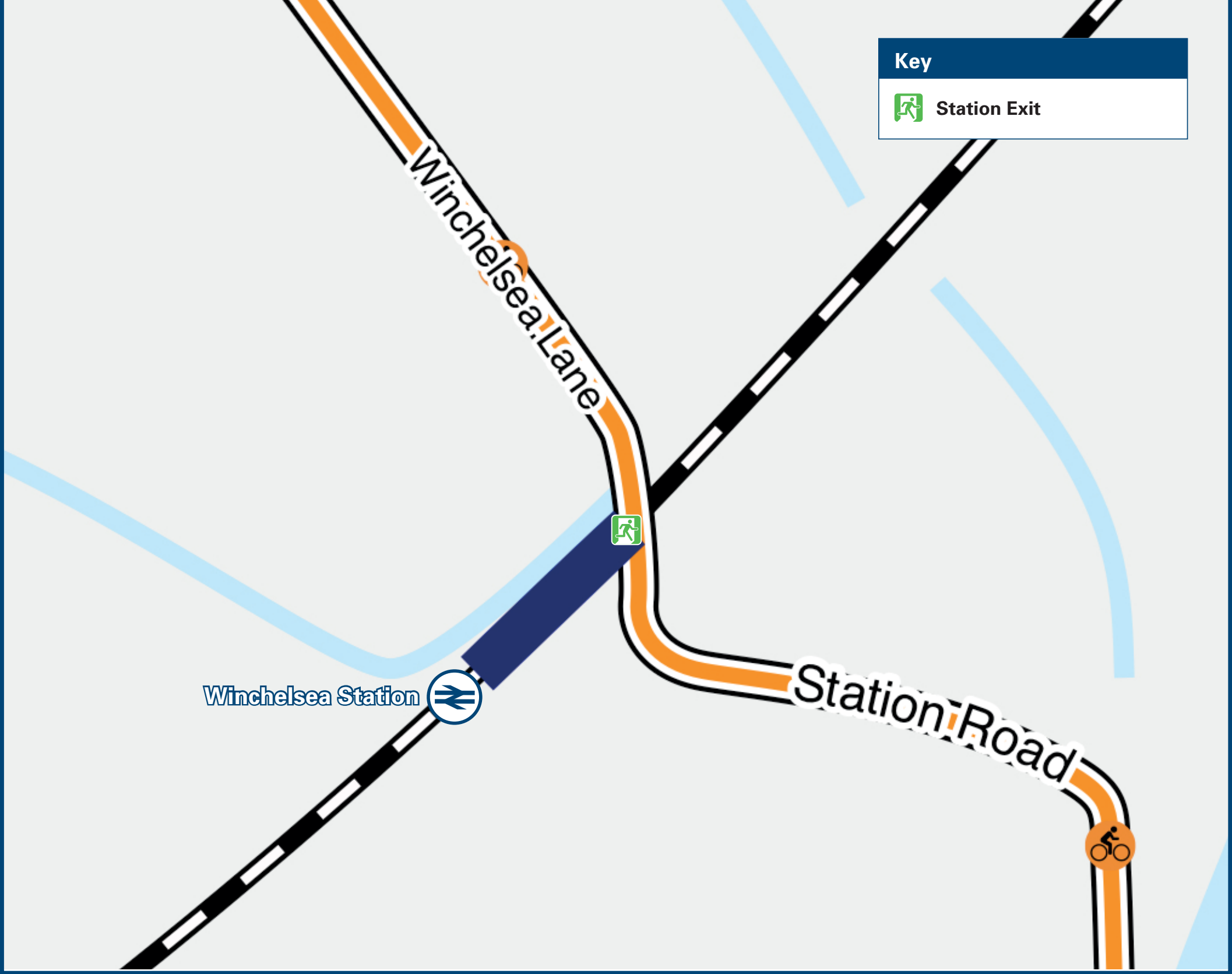

THERE ARE NO REGULAR BUS SERVICES SERVING WINCHELSEA RAILWAY STATION

The nearest bus stops for regular bus services are in Winchelsea village, a 20 to 25 minutes walk from this station, see Local area map for walking routes and bus stops:

Bus route 100 runs daily from stops **A** and **D** to Rye, Camber, Lydd and New Romney.

Bus route 100 runs daily from stops **B** and **C** to Icklesham, Guestling Green, Ore Village, Hastings and Conquest Hospital.

Bus route 101 runs daily from stop **E** to Rye, Camber, Lydd and New Romney.

Bus route 101 runs daily from stop **F** to Winchelsea Beach, Pett Levell, Fairlight, Ore Village, Hastings (and to Conquest Hospital on Sundays only).

Please note bus stop **E** does not have a bus stop pole/flag, please wait for the bus opposite stop **F** and signal clearly for the bus to stop.
