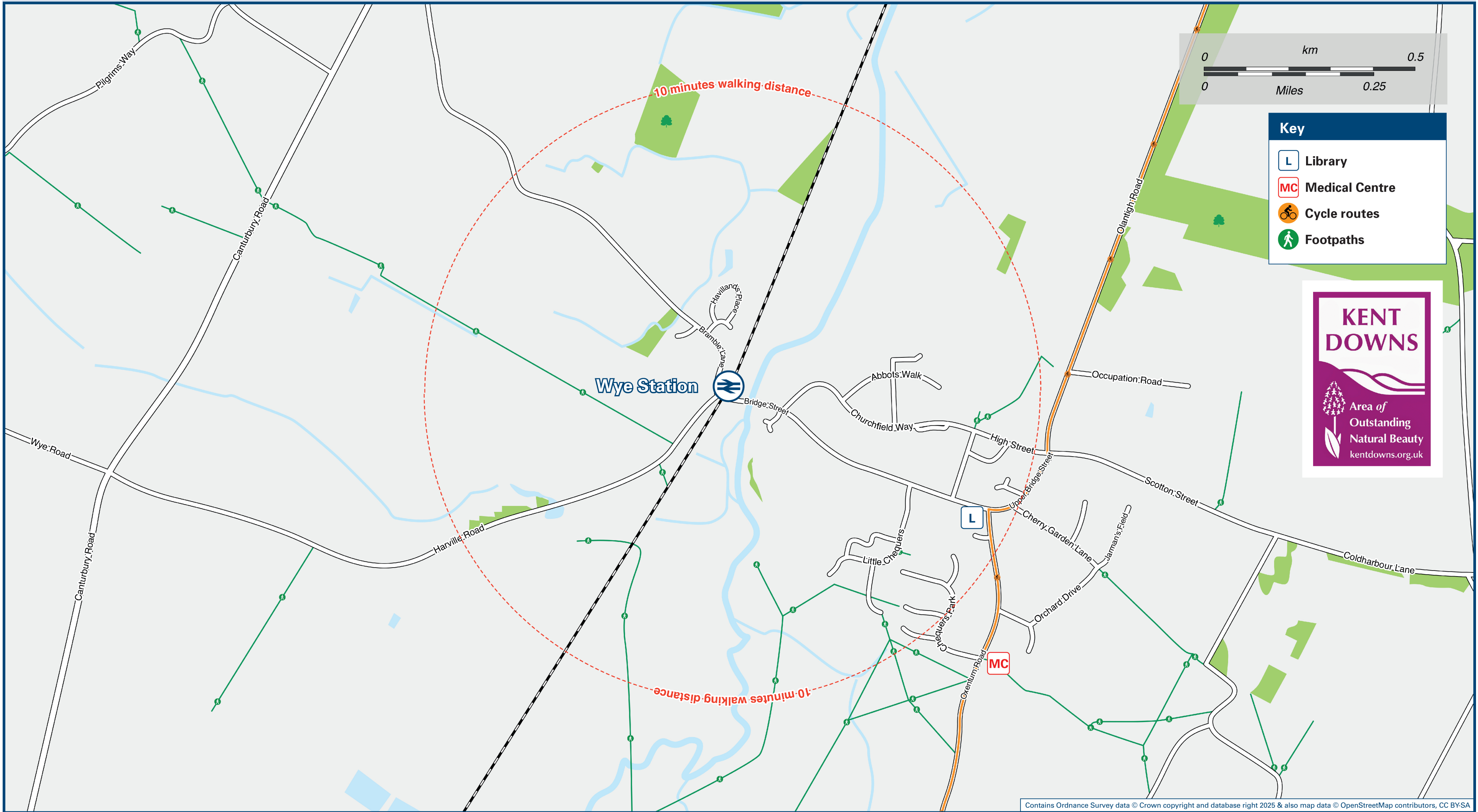




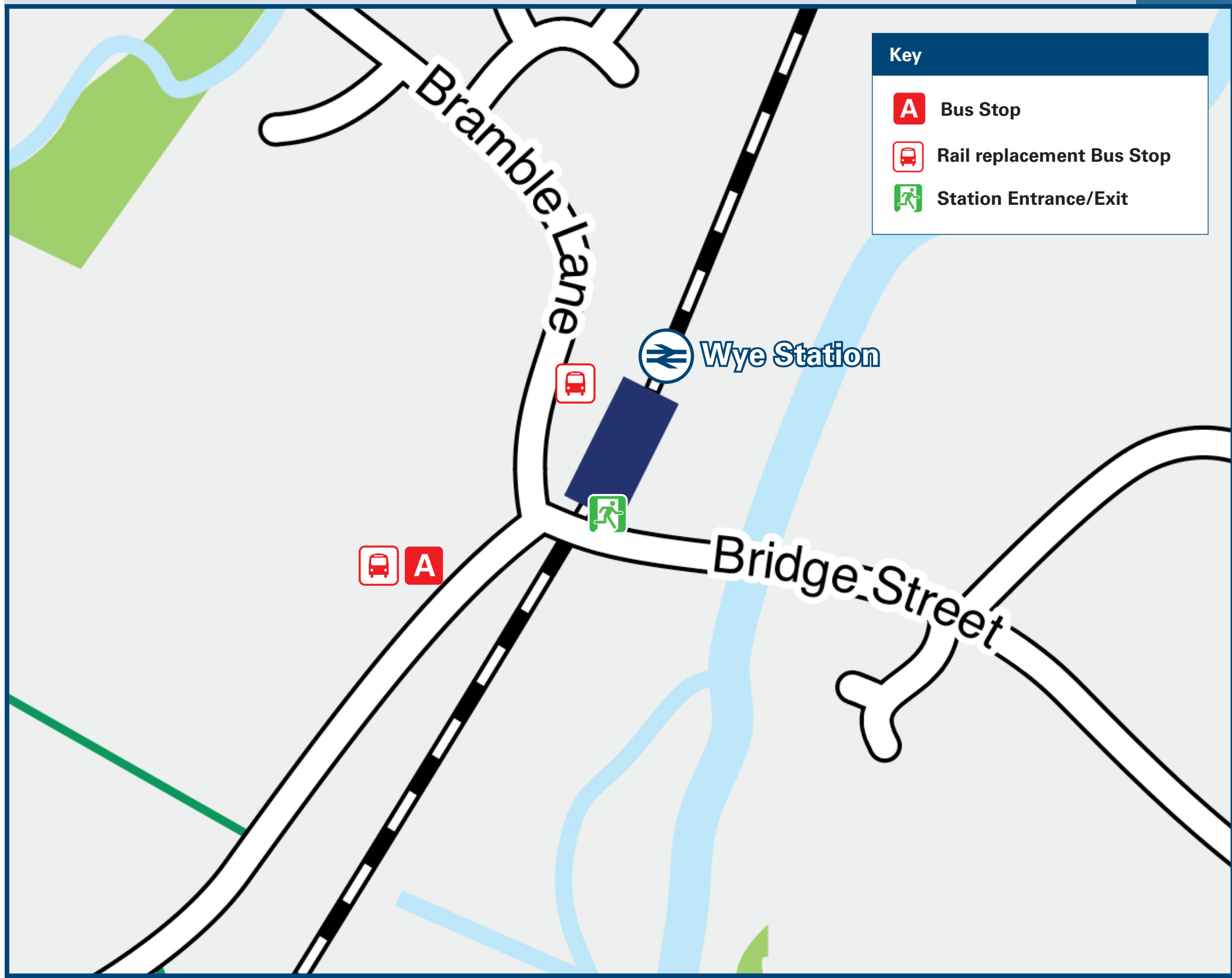
# Wye Station

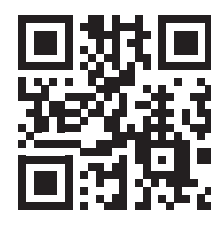
