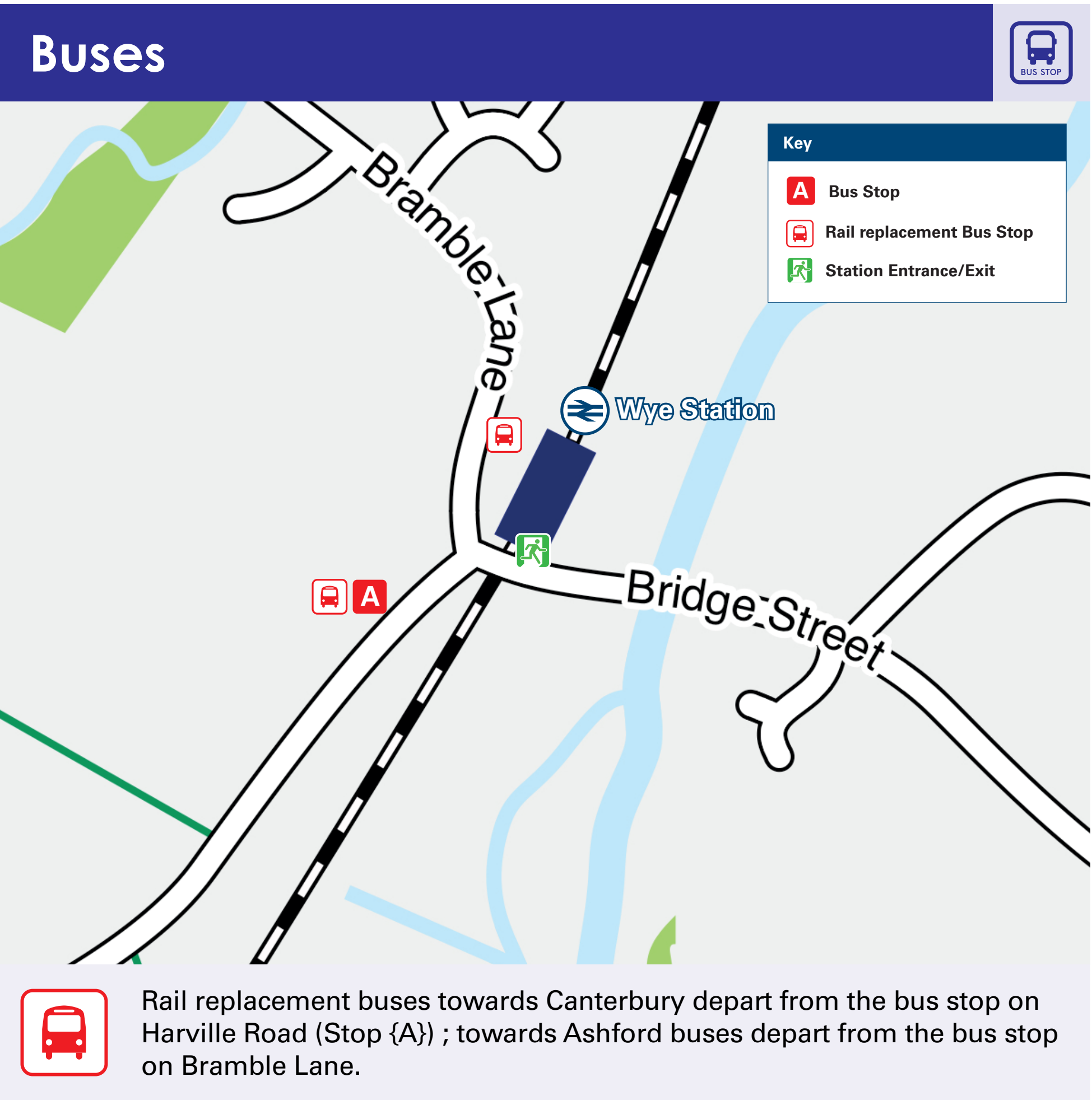
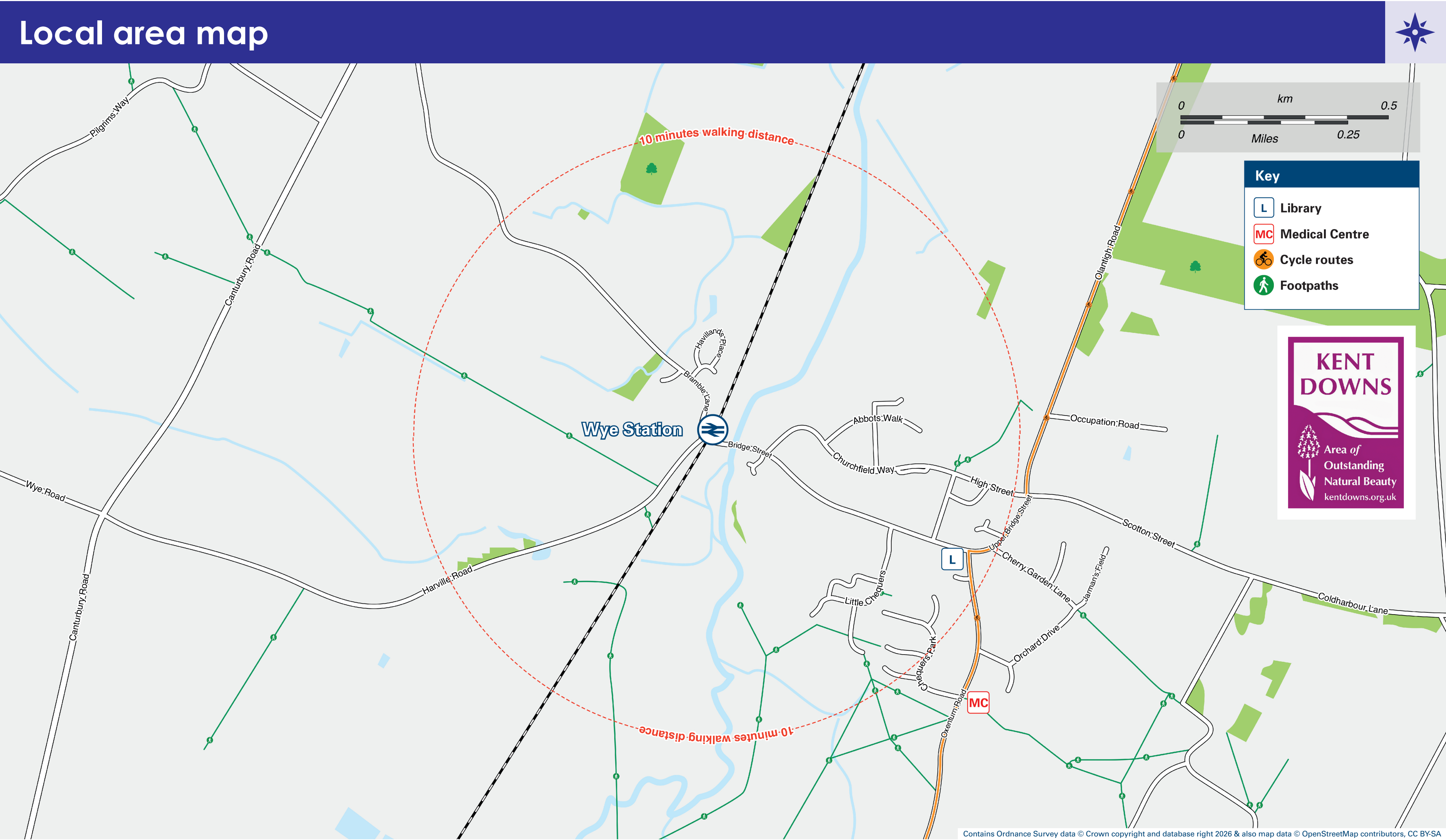

Direct trains operate to Ashford International station from Wye station.
