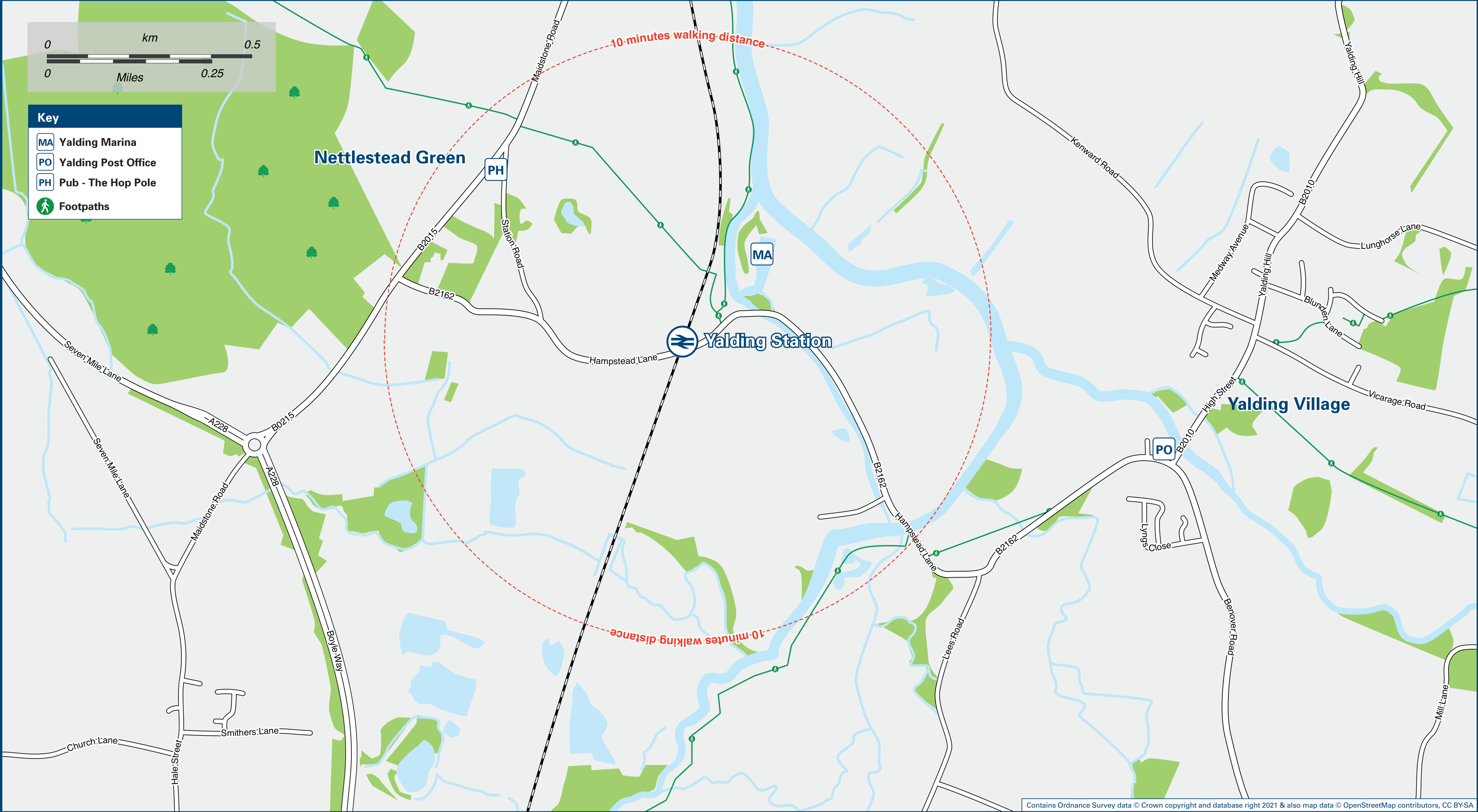

The nearest bus stops are located at Nettlestead Green (The Hop Pole Public House), a 10 minutes walk from this station, see Local area map.
Bus route 6 operates Mondays to Saturdays only. No Sunday services.
Bus route 6X operates daily.
