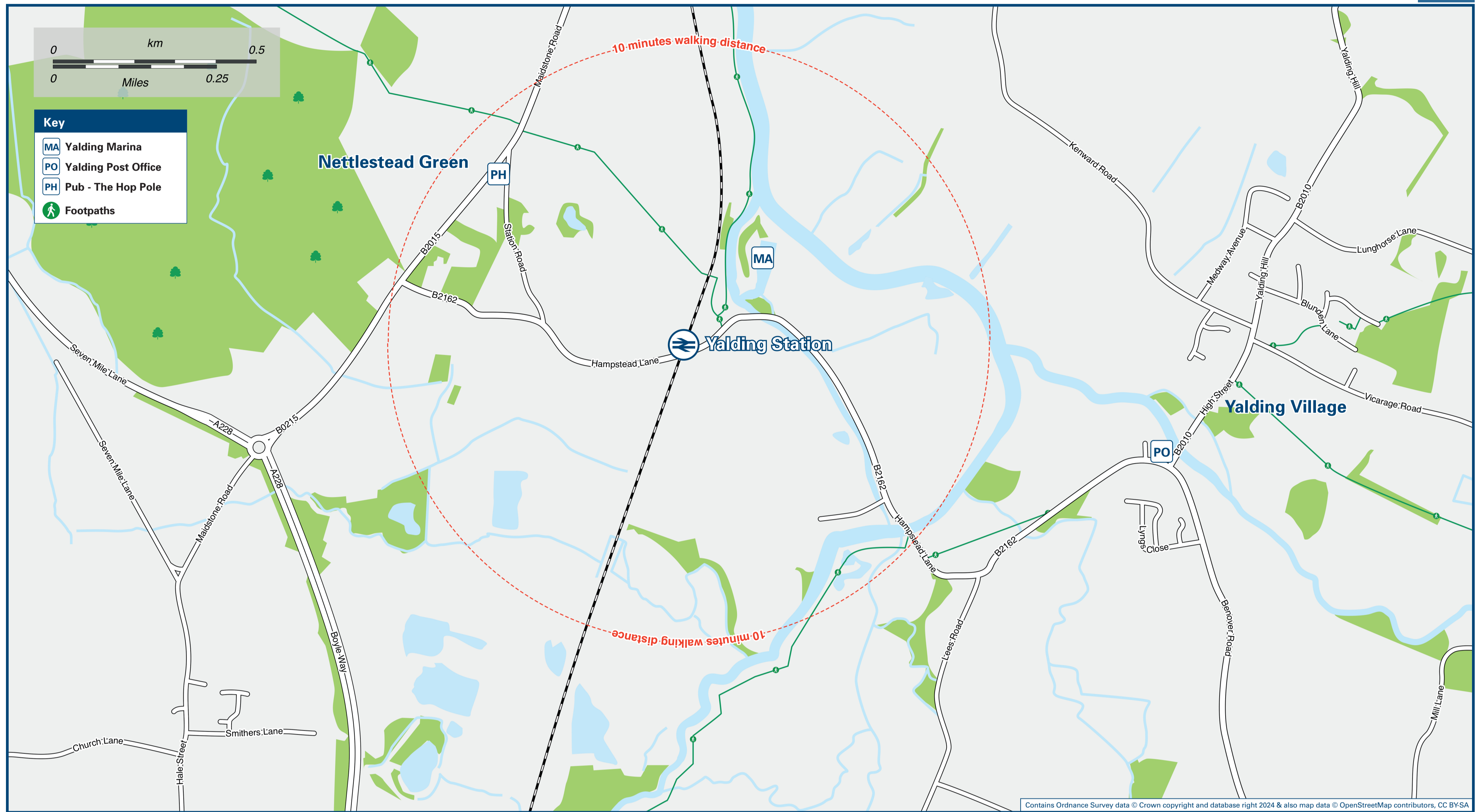




Yalding Station
